

A SKETCH
OF THE "LITZENBURGER" OR "LITZENBERG" FAMILY.
BY URIAH S. LITZENBERG, ALLENTOWN, PENNA.

George and Adam Litzenburger (or Litzenburg) brothers, immigrated to this country from Alsace-Lorraine in about 1770 or probably earlier.

Adam was a weaver and settled in the lower end of Lancaster County, Pennsylvania. He has left numerous descendants, residing in Chester, Delaware, and Montgomery Counties in Pennsylvania as well as in Ohio and Indiana. This branch of the family all spell their name "Litzenberg".

George Litzenberger, our common ancestor, who was the first of the family in this country, settled in Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and as early as March 15, 1773 took up land by warrant from the Commonwealth in Macungie, Lehigh County. I do not know whether he himself ever resided on the land in Macungie, but it has been in the possession of the family up to the present time. His wife was named Wilhelmena. As far as known, George had two sons, John Nicholas and Adam.

Adam remained in Bucks County and left numerous descendants in Bucks, Northampton, Luzerne and Philadelphia Counties. John Nicholas settled on his father's land in Macungie, Lehigh County, was married to Margaret Strauss, and had a family of four sons and six daughters. He died in 1830 at the age of about 70 years and is buried at the Jordan Lutheran Church, Lehigh County. The names of his sons were Adam, George, Jacob and Solomon. The names of his daughters were Magdalena, Maria, married to Joseph Miller; Elizabeth, married to Daniel O'Daniel; Susan, married to John Miller; Eva, married to Henry Bortz; the other daughter's name is not known, she having died prior to her father, but left 3 children named "Maury". Of the sons Solomon moved to Seneca County, Ohio. Adam and Jacob reared large families, mostly yet residing in this county.

George had five sons and five daughters. Of the sons Reuben was born on March 18, 1815; William was born on July 3, 1824; Levy was born December 8, 1825; Tillman was born December 29, 1830; and Charles was born January 2, 1833. Of the daughters Julia was born November 5, 1830 and was married to John Sanger; Sophia was born May 10, 1816 and was married to George Miller; Malinda was born December 21, 1818 and was married to Josiah Kuhns; Polly was born February 10, 1823 and was married to Jacob Santell; Leanna was born December 8, 1828 and was married to William Kemmerer. Of the sons, Reuben had six sons and two daughters. Three sons and one daughter now living, viz; Edwin B. Uriah S., and Sarah Henry living at Allentown, Pennsylvania, and Willoughby at Manheim, Pennsylvania, Julia Sanger had

two sons and two daughters. One son, John Sanger, now resides at Wilkes Barre, Pennsylvania. William had two sons and one daughter: Calvind I. residing at Allentown; Alfred residing at Slatington; and Hessina Heilman residing near Leather Corner Post, this county. Levy is deceased and Charles is now residing at Weescoesville, Lehigh County, and has no children.

John Nicholas Litzenberger served in the Revolutionary War in Captain John Trexier's Sixth Company, 1st Battalion, Northampton County militia, from November 1, 1761 to February 1782 and in Captain Serfass' Company of Militia on the frontiers.

George Litzenberger (father of Tillman) served with Captain Abraham Gangewer, First Brig., Second Division, in the War of 1812.

From what I have been able to gather, John Nicholas (Hanickle, as he wrote it) was a man of much force and business ability, above the average in intelligence and character. He died in 1830, leaving an estate valued at about twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000.), which sum for those times was equal to a large fortune now.

The older members of the family were all Lutheran. They took an active part in the church as well as in public affairs as evidenced by the participation of John Nicholas in the Revolutionary War, and of his son George in the War of 1812.
