THE LOCKWOOD GENEALOGY.

First Gen.—Robert Lockwood came from England to America about 1630 and settled in Watertown, Mass., where six of his ten children were born. About 1646 he removed to Fairfield, Conn., where he died, 1658. He married Susannah , by whom he had Jonathan, born Sept. 10, 1634; Deborah, born Oct. 12, 1636; Joseph, born Aug. 6, 1638; Daniel, born March 21, 1640; Ephraim, born Dec. 1, 1641; Gershom, born Sept. 6, 1643; Abigail, who married John Barlow, of Fairfield, Conn.; Sarah; Mary, who married Jonathan Huested. From these sprang most of the Lockwoods of America, although many are descended from Edward Lockwood, a supposed brother of Robert.

Second Gen.—Ephram Lockwood, born Dec. 1, 1641, in Watertown, Mass.; resided in Norwalk, Conn., where he married, June 8, 1665, Mary Sention (now written St. John), daughter of Matthias Sention, Sr., of Norwalk, Conn. They had ten children—namely, Daniel, Sarah, Ephraim, Eliphalet, Joseph, James, Edmund, Mary, and Abigail, of whom:

Third Gen.—Joseph Lockwood was born in Norwalk, Conn., April 1, 1680. He became and was called Deacon Lockwood. He died in Norwalk, Nov. 23, 1760. He married, Aug. 14, 1707, Mary Wood, daughter of John Wood, of Stamford, Conn. They had eight children—viz., Ephraim, Joseph, Ruth, Daniel, Mary, Elizabeth, Sarah, and Isaac, of whom:

Fourth Gen.—Joseph Lockwoon, born at Norwalk, Nov. 23, 1710, where he resided all his life and died, July 20, 1773. He married Rebecca Royers. Family tradition locates her birthplace at Huntington, Long Island, N. Y. We have not been successful in identifying her parentage. Among the first settlers of Humpstead, L. I., was William Rogers, who died July 13, 1604. He married Anne . Of their children were probably Jonathan Rogers, of Huntington, L. I., Obadiah Rogers, of Southampton,
