JOHN MAYNARD of Sudbury, Massachusetts

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It has come to our attention that there are two manuscripts in the collection at New England Historic Genealoical Society relating to JOHN¹ of Sudbury although we have not had a chance to read them. References at the end of this manuscript are to Davis (n.d.) and Gould (1914). When we set out to prepare this account of JOHN¹ it was for the purpose of trying to identify Maynards who had married into our own ancestral families and we offer it as an addition to what is currently available.

Before providing the descendants of John¹ Maynard of Sudbury, it is important to take note of the family of John¹ Maynard of Duxbury and Boston since there has been confusion between some of the children of these two different and presumably unrelated Johns. Fortunately for those of Maynard ancestry, John¹ of Duxbury had only daughters. According to Pope (p. 308) he was a carpenter and contracted to build a prison at Plymouth on 4 March 1638/9. He had a land grant at Duxbury in 1640, was a town officer in 1645, and removed to Boston having sold his Duxbury land on 20 August 1647. He married on 16 May 1640, Mary Starr, sister of Comfort¹ Starr. His second wife, according to Savage (3:186) was Elizabeth Pell, widow of Nathaniel Heaton, whom he married in 1649 although Torrey does not have this marriage.

References to John in the Register provide the information that: 1) he was witness to the will of John Cole in 1637 (4:35); 2) he was declared Able to Bear Arms at Duxbury in 1643 (4:256); 3) he was owed money from the estate of James Astwood 25 October 1653, he then of Boston (8:275); 4) he took inventory of the Boston estate of Richard Norton on 8 Aug 1657 (9:229); 5) his wife was not the daughter of Comfort Starr as some, including Pope, have thought as in the article titled "Dr. Comfort Starr, and Cranbrook, Kent" the author, Hosea Starr Ballow, states: "His sister Mary, who in 1640 [sic] married John Maynard, was baptized 16 April 1620" (64:73) (presumably as an infant); 6) he and Mary had five daughters among whom were Lydia who in 1668 married Samuel Hale of Charlestown and her twin Hannah who in 1669 married John Hayden, other possible daughters being Mary who married John Pell and Elizabeth who married an Edmonds or Emmons, possibly Joseph Emmons of Boston (94:170-172). One should note that Lyida also married William Marshall and Samuel Ballat (Wyman, 1879/1982, p. 662). John did not leave a will, but his inventory was filed 7 (9) 1658 O.S. and a list of debts owed from his estate appears in the Register (9:347 & 31:175). He died 4 October 1658.

And as if this John Maynard were not enough of a distraction, there was another, in addition to our JOHN1, contemporary with him, namely John of Hartford, Connecticut. The ancestry of Edward Holyoke (NEHGR, 147:21) comments on Eliezer Holyoke of Springfield who first married Mary Pynchon and secondly, Editha (Stebbins) (Day) Maynard, daughter of Deacon Edward Stebbins of Hartford. Conn., and widow of Robert Day and of John Maynard, both of Hartford. Barbour (1982, p. 390) tells us that this John was a founder of Hartford where he was among the original proprietors. He is said to be the John who was early of Cambridge and at Hartford was surveyor of highways in 1641 and 1648. He left a will dated 23 January 1657/8 naming his wife Editha, her eldest son Thomas Day and youngest son John Day as well as her daughters Sarah and Mary. He left his property to his wife with the stipulation that it was to go to her son John who in his honor named a son Maynard Day, but John 1 d.s.p.

Having dispensed with the other two John Maynards, we can now proceed to delineate some of the descendants JOHN¹ MAYNARD of Sudbury. JOHN¹ was an original proprietor in 1638 and freeman in 1644 at Sudbury and was one of the petitioners for what became Marlborough in May of 1656, this petition being for an eight square mile plantation (NEHGR, 62:220). He was later given 23 acres at Marlborough (NEHGR 62:227) and participated in the first division of meadow lands on 26 Sept. 1660 (NEHGR 62:228). He had a home lot of four acres on North Street. It should be noted that although some descendants resided at Framingham, the genealogical register in the history of that town makes the mistake of stating that his second wife was the daughter of Comfort Starr whereas she was of no relation to him. This confusion of John of Duxbury and Boston with this JOHN1 is exemplified in the Framingham account.

JOHN's first wife is unknown although it has been said by a number of descendants that he married 28 July 1627 at Cambridge, England, ELIZABETH ASTON who was born there in 1600 and died before 1638. He is said in these accounts to have been born in 1598 at Bassingbournricamond, St. Edwards, England. Cutter (1908, 3:1626) says that he was first at Cambridge, but as seen, that John was the John of Hartford. He was a selectman of Sudbury in 1646 and held other town offices. It is not known whether or not his first wife came with him to America. but he married second, June 14, 1646, MARY (----) AXTELL, widow of Thomas Axtell. His son John was certainly by his first wife (see John² below). He died 10 December 1672 (given by some as 1673) at Sudbury leaving a will dated 4 September 1672 and proved 1 April 1673. In it he left to wife Mary, children John, Zachary, Elizabeth

Graves, Lydia Moore, and Mary Maynard. He made wife and son Zachary executors. The births of most of his children by MARY are recorded in Sudbury vital records. He died there 10 December 1672.

On 1 Oct. 1675, he was chosen as one of those to defend the town of Marlborough against Indian attack (NEHGR, 8:240). On 18 March 1691/2 he and John, Jr. served under Ens. John Woods in the West Regt. garrison at Marlborough. He d. at Marlborough, Mass., 22 December 1711, reported in the Register (120:163) as about age 81 which has led some to think he was born in 1630, a supposition supported by a deposition he made in 1692 when he said he was 62 (NEHGR, 85:455). He married second, about 1679, SARAH (BLANDFORD) KEYES, widow of Elias Keyes and

daughter of $John^1$ Blandford of Sudbury. In Marlborough records he is "John, Sr."

We had questioned whether or not it was possible that ZACHARIAH³ (JOHN², JOHN¹) might also be the father of ELNATHAN MAYNARD of Windham, Connecticut. Since we are uncertain of his origin, we present his family, based on Connecticut Vital Records (Barbour), but we read only the reel which included "Maynard" and not those which included "Minard" pr "Munard."
