Preface

This genealogy begins with the earliest known ancestor, Solomon McCULLEY, who is assigned the letter A. Each of his children is assigned the letter B, their children the letter C, and so on, followed by a number denoting the sequential order of their births within families. In succeeding generations each descendant is assigned a letter-number pair, the letter denoting the generation, the number that person's serial order within a family. Within a given generation, beginning with the third, there are several persons with the same letter-number designation; the sequence of letter-number pairs, however, that described the descent of a particular person from Solomon is unique.

The compiler has listed as much of the full baptismal name, dates and places of birth, death and marriage of each person as has been furnished or discovered. The same data for spouses, including names of spouses' parents, has also been listed. The latter information would be useful to those seeking data about other lines of descent. Surnames of blood relations are capitalized. Places are located mostly within counties; this information is useful for consulting census returns.

This family history is far from complete. Contact has not been established with several lines. Some lines have reached the ninth generation. Anyone having further information, photographs of the second or third generation, recollections of family traditions, maps, obituaries, Bible records, etc., is requested to communicate with the compiler.

- Section 1 -

General

Family origins and traditions.

According to tradition, the McCULLEY family originated in Scotland in the 12th or 13th century. The family was deeply religious, being Covenanters, but none was prominent in affairs of state. During the wars between church and state the family moved, or was driven, to Ireland. After one or more generations there, it is said that seven brothers migrated to America. Thus the McCULLEYS are Scots-Irish, and came probably from the Lowlands - that portion of Scotland jutting out toward Ireland, and comprising the counties of Ayr and Galloway. The latter today consists of Kirkcudbright and Wigton.

Black, in his Surnames of Scotland, states that the names MacCullie, MacCully and Macoulie are softened forms of the name MacCulloch.

From Scots Kith and Kin it appears that McCullie is from Mac^c Culloch, geographically from Banffshire, associated with Clan Gunn. MacCullochs were also found in Galloway, the Stewartry (of Kirkcudbright), as early as the 11th century.

On a Map of Scotland of Old, by Sir Iain Moncreiffe of that Ilk and Don Pottinger, "Showing the lands and spheres of influence of the main clans and names of Scotland including...those of Lowland and Border families about the time of King James VI..." appear four regions labeled McCulloch. One is in the Stewartry (or County) of Kirkcudbright (pronounced "Kirkobray") between Fleet Bay and Money-pool Bay, with the symbol of a castle denoting the family seat at Cardoness. This region contains the parishes of Anwoth and Kirkmabreck; adjoining regions are labeled with the family names Gordon, Muir and Lennox. Two other regions lie in the County of Wigton - Glasserton Parish, just east of Port William, where the map shows a castle labeled "Myreton", and Stoneykirk Parish, family seat at Ardwell, which is on the peninsula containing Portpatrick. The first of these adjoins spheres of influence of the families of Dunbar, Maxwell and Vaus; the second adjoins Adair and McDowall (MacDougall). An atlas map shows McCulloch's Point, located about two miles northwest of Stranraer, on Loch Ryan. The fourth region lies in the northern part of the County of Ross, on the Dornoch Firth, consisting of the parish of Tain and surrounded by Clan Ross.

Mackerlie, in History of the lands and their owners in Galloway, vol. 1, p. 335, states, "In March 1622, Wm McCulle and his son had sasine of the Barony of Wigtown." In Scots law, "sasine" is the act of giving legal possession of feudal property, or the instrument by which the possession is acquired.

If tradition is sound, we may suppose that the move to Ireland took place during the "Killing Time", about 1685-90. Reckoning a generation at 25 years, the brothers may have come to these shores as early as 1715. Two generations might be as late as 1750-5. Thus Solomon's father or grandfather was born in Ireland.

- Section 2 -

Solomon and Sarah McCulley and their issue.

A. Solomon McCULLEY was born ca. 1759, died 10 Jan 1834 in Xenia Township, Greene, Ohio. He was married ca. 1786 to Sarah _____, who was born ca. 1763, died 3 Apr 1846 in Xenia Township, Greene, Ohio. They had issue:(first five probably born in Tennessee.)

Solomon was old enough to have fought in the Revolutionary War, but no records of such service have been discovered in National Archives. Since his oldest son, James, was born 10 Aug 1787 in Blount County, it seems likely that Solomon and Sarah married in 1786 and

migrated to Blount County, Tenn., where the earliest settlement is said to have occurred in that year.

The Parham papers, relating to families in Blount County, contain the item, dated 1790, that a plot of land on Clويد's Creek (in Loudon County since 1870)"...adjoins Solomon McCulley..." His name appears on Blount County tax rolls of 1800, in Captain Caldwell's Company, and of 1801, in Captain Aleson's Company, where he is listed as owning 300 acres.

The location of the family between 1801 and 1807 is uncertain. Solomon purchased Section 34, Township 4, Range 7 (just north of Oldtown on the map) as shown in Deeds, Greene County, Ohio, vol. 7, p. 524, Patent from United States to Solomon, 1807. This was signed by Thomas Jefferson, and was issued through the Cincinnati land office. Robinson's History of Greene Co., O.(S. J. Clarke, Chicago, 1902) dates Solomon's arrival in Greene County in 1810, when his name appears on a tax roll.

Solomon and Sarah were members of Old Massie's Creek church, which was Reformed Presbyterian, or Covenanter. According to Robinson,"In 1824 a new house of worship was built on the bank of Massie's Creek 6 miles from Xenia, it being a stone building 36'x40'.. The cemetery here was also known as Stevenson's, from the man who gave the land. Robert Armstrong, who married James and Rebecca, was the first pastor of this church.

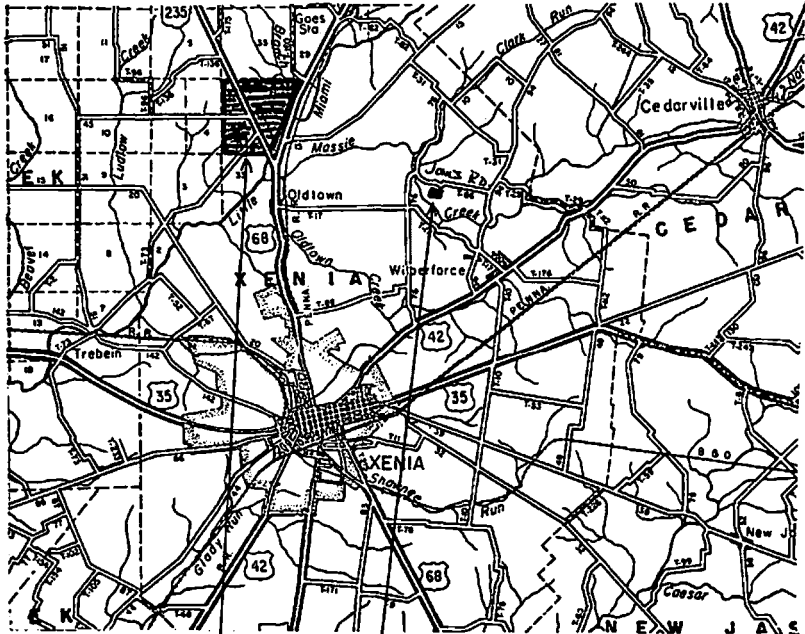
In 1829 Solomon and Sarah McCULLY deeded 100 acres James McCULLY, their son, this to be his share of their estate, as noted in Solomon's will. This land was in the northwest corner of Section 34, Township 4, Range 7, as described in Deeds, Greene County, Ohio, 1829, vol. 11, p. 349.

In his will made 18 Sep 1833, Solomon names his wife Sarah and their children, except John who died in 1817. Solomon also bequeaths to deceased son William's three daughters. Solomon died 10 Jan 1834, aged 75 years. There is no gravestone.

Sarah McCULLEY made her will 18 Mar 1844. All she had was personal property, which she gives to two daughters, Jane and Mary, wife of John B. WRIGHT. Sarah died 3 Apr 1846, aged 83 years. She was buried in Old Massie's Creek cemetery and has a gravestone.

When the 1880 census was taken, David McCULLEY, son of Solomon and Sarah, stated that his father and mother were born in Pennsylvania. It is tempting to suppose that they were born in Cumberland County, where the GALLOWAYS and the JUNKINS came from.

B1. James McCULLEY was born 10 Aug 1787 (gravestone) in Tennessee (1850 census), died 11 Mar 1858 (gravestone) near Winfield, Henry, Iowa. He was married (1st) 11 May 1809 in Greene County, Ohio, to Rebecca JUNKIN, who was born in 1783, perhaps in Pennsylvania, died in Aug 1818 near Xenia, Greene, Ohio. James and Rebecca had issue:

Following Rebecca's death in 1818, James was married (2nd) ca. 1819 to Isabelle POMEROY, who was born 9 Oct 1790 (gravestone) in Kentucky (1850 census), died 2 Oct 1857 (gravestone) near Winfield, Henry, Iowa. James and Isabelle had issue:

James McCULLEY served as private in Capt. James Morrow's Company, Ohio Militia, 10-19 May 1813. His name appears in Roster of Ohio Soldiers in the War of 1812 (A Gen of Ohio, 1916), and a marker bearing his name and service was placed in Solomon's lot in Old Massie's Creek cemetery.

In 1824 James bought 142 acres of land from Jacob Haines. In 1829 James was given 100 acres by his father Solomon. On 26 Mar 1830 James and wife Isabelle sold this land, apparently, to James Andrew. On 22 Apr 1830 James bought 20 acres from Jacob Haines. On 26 Dec 1836 James and wife, Isabel, sold 162 acres to Aaron Beal, and took mortgage on same. On 4 Jul 1839 James McCULLEY received the full amount of the note, which was attested by him.

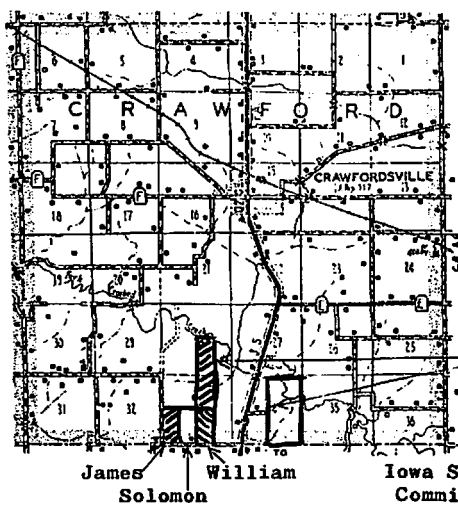
James and wife resigned, or were dismissed, from Massie's Creek church on 26 Mar 1827. They removed to Illinois about 1836, and from there to Iowa in 1838. They moved by ox team, crossing the Mississippi at Burlington, Iowa, and settled on the prairie in Hen-

ry County, Iowa, two miles north of what is now Winfield. The 1850 census shows them then living in Wayne Township.

James, Solomon and William each entered an 80-acre tract, probably near the south edge of Crawford Township in Washington County in 1838. Their holdings are shown on the map, as of 1840. The cost of land was \$1.25 per acre.

The roll of the Crooked Creek church, a U. P., or so-called "Old seceder" congregation, carries the names of James, Isabella, Rebecca, Mary and William McCULLEY, before 1841. The name of Solomon does not appear. James organized a U. P. church in Crawfordsville, Washington, Iowa, in 1846.

In his will dated 14 Oct 1847, and proved 6 Dec 1858 in Henry County, James names his children and given amount, and leaves to his son, James P., the remainder of the estate to take care of his mother and sister, Rebecca; and personal property equally to John, George, and James P., whom he appointed executors.

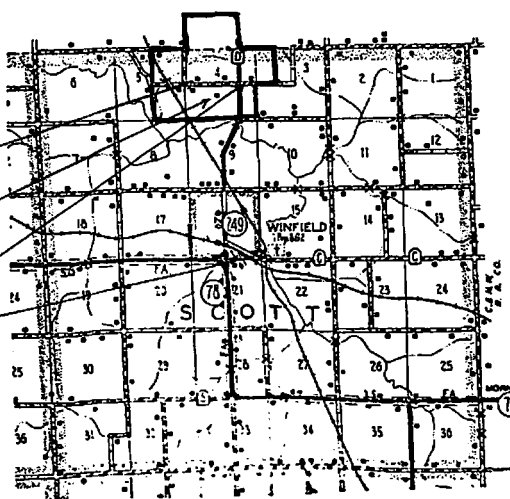

C 5. Solomon McCULLEY was born ca. 1820 near Xenia, Greene, Ohio, was married in 1844 to Sarah RITCHEY, who was born ca. 1822 in Indiana, daughter of Adam RITCHEY.

According to The History of Washington County, Iowa (Des Moines: Union Historical Company, 1880), "Solomon McCulley was born in Ohio in 1820; and lived there until 1836, and then removed to Ill., and remained there until he removed to Iowa in 1838; he 1st settled in Henry County, and thence to this (Washington) county, where he owns a farm of 57 acres. He was married in 1844 to Miss Sara Ritchey, the first white female and daughter of the 1st settler of Washington County, and who is the oldest resident on the county; she was born in Indiana, came to this county with her parents in 1836; they have three children: Belle, James and Mary."

"Sara was 13 years old, and a brother Matthew aged 15 came with their father Adam Ritchey in 1836. He staked out a claim on Crooked Creek. Adam built a cabin near the spot where the road running south from Crawfordville crosses the creek. The boy Matthew drove a team and Sara kept house. Little Sara in due time became Mrs. Solomon McCulley." Sarah is buried in the Washington, Iowa, cemetery. Solomon and Sarah had issue:

McCULLEY was born 2 Feb 1807 at Dayton, Montgomery, Ohio, died 17 May 1881 at Grandview, Louisa, Iowa, and was buried in Harrison cemetery, which is located $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of Wapello, Louisa, Iowa. The dates given are those that appear on his gravestone. He was married (1st), probably about 1839, to Ann WILLSON, who was born ca. 1815, probably near Elizabeth, Allegheny, Pennsylvania, died 1853, perhaps in Lee County, Iowa. 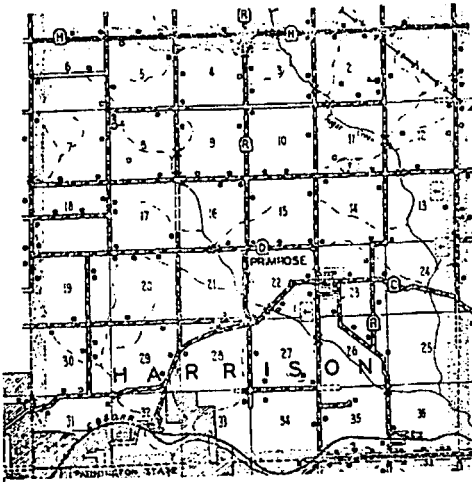

David Carson, Cora, Eva, and Albert B. are listed with David and Amy in the 1880 census from Granview Twp, Louisa County, Iowa. David is shown as suffering from Consumption, and states that his father and mother, i.e., Solomon and Sarah, were born in Pennsylvania. Amy stated that her parents were both born in Tennessee. It may have been the consumption that led to David's death the following spring.

We may suppose that David and family moved from Ohio to Indiana in the early spring of 1841, and from Indiana to Iowa in the spring of 1844. This is consistent with the birthdates and places of Sarah Isabelle and William Saul. It also parallels the travels of David's sister Elizabeth and brother-in-law William STERRETT.

C1. James D. McCULLEY was born 24 Jun 1840 in Greene County, Ohio, died 28 Oct 1913 at Grandview, Louisa, Iowa. He was married 4 Sep 1867 at Letts, Louisa, Iowa, to Martha Jane HUTCHISON, who was born 12 Jan 1846, died 23 Nov 1928 at Columbus Junction, Louisa, Iowa. One of his daughters-in-law, Mrs. Robert Willson McCULLEY, Sr., says that James's middle name was Dickinson.

The pension application of James D. McCULLEY shows that he was enrolled at Primrose, Lee, Iowa, mustered in as private at Keokuk, Lee, Iowa, on 23 Aug 1861 in Company B, 3rd Iowa Volunteer Cavalry Regiment. He was 5'10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " in height, of dark complexion, with black eyes and brown hair. His medical record shows no wounds received during his service. He was honorably discharged at Little Rock, Arkansas, on 31 Dec 1863, and re-enlisted as a veteran in the same organization on 1 Jan 1864, promoted thereafter to 7th, 6th and 5th corporal. He was mustered out 9 Aug 1865 at Atlanta, Ga.

According to his obituary, "James D. McCulley, a highly respected and long-time resident of this county, residing near Mt. Hope school house, died suddenly last Tuesday evening from heart failure. He had been ailing for a number of weeks, but the end had not been expected so soon by relatives, and the announcement of his death came as a shock to them.

"Deceased...was aged 73 years, 4 months and 4 days at the time of his death. He leaves an aged wife and four children to mourn his death, two children having preceded him. The living children are: Mrs. Jennie McGill, of Constance, Minn.; William H. of this county; Robert W. and Homer F., who are residents of Grangeville, Idaho. ...interment in the Mt. Hope cemetery."

According to William's obituary, "His parents moved to eastern Iowa when he was about one year old. He lived there until he enlisted in (Company A of) the 19th Iowa Volunteer Infantry Regiment at Primrose in (Aug) 1862, at the age of 19.

"He served through the remainder of the war and saw some very hard service. (His unit was involved in the decisive battle of Prairie Grove, Ark., in December 1862). Was at the siege of Vicksburg and on the Red River expedition. After the war he moved to southwestern Iowa, where he met and married Mary A. Monzingo, who was his wife until she passed on at the S. and S. Home in August of last year.

"He raised a family of ten children, nine of whom are still living. His only schooling consisted of two or three months in the winters before he enlisted, or when no other duties interfered. He realized the importance of an education and his uppermost thoughts were to make it possible for his children to enjoy the advantages that were denied him. No sacrifice was too great for him to further this idea.

"In every community in which he lived he took an active part in all the religious activities. Very early in life he joined the United Presbyterian church, but about 1900 he became identified with the Methodist Episcopal church and remained a member until his death.

"Death came quickly and quietly, as he had often wished. In fact he evidently had a premonition of the coming end, for he had requested his daughter, with whom he was staying, to institute a search, without delay, in case he failed to return at an appointed hour.

"Funeral services were held at the Soldiers' Home at Milford... and the remains were laid to rest by the side of the beloved wife in the cemetery at Milford."

William's military medical history, summarized in his pension record, shows that he was 5'8½" in height, with brown hair and blue eyes; he had no absence from duty because of wounds. The character of his service may be inferred from the book, Federals on the Frontier - the Diary of Benjamin F. McIntire 1862-1864, edited by Nannie F. Tilley, (University of Texas Press, 1959), which describes the campaigns and other service of the 19th Iowa.

She attended college in College Springs, Iowa, and was a graduate of the Kirksville school of Osteopathy. She practiced Os-

teopathy in Sycamore and Chicago, Ill., also in Omaha, Neb. In Omaha she contracted measles which settled on her lungs finally ending in consumption. She was married to Dr. Samuel Runyon July 14, 1902. They moved to Creston, Iowa, where they lived until Mar. 5, 1907, when in search of health they went to N. M., but too late. When 12 years of age she gave her heart to Christ and was a consistent member of the 1st Methodist church of Creston, Iowa, and although her health was frail she was faithful in the Sabbath school and interested in all the work of the church, death came to her as a welcome relief after years of suffering. Her only regret was leaving her husband and little son, 'Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints'."

According to his eulogy, "In Laredo, Texas on November 15, 1903, a baby boy, Donald Mark, was born to Dr. Samuel Houston Runyon and Dr. Margaret McCulley Runyon. Four years later the mother died of tuberculosis, and the father, after fighting it for eleven more years, finally succumbed to the same disease. Thus before he was yet 15, Don was deprived of parental love and care, and found a home with an uncle and aunt who appeared to share the conviction of other relatives and friends that he would be an early victim of the same disease that had taken the lives of his parents..."

"Don was required to make his own way through college and seminary, the money left by his father for his education having been lost by his guardian. He enrolled at McMurry College, Abilene, Texas in 1923. In his second year danger signals warned him that he was endangering his health by his double duties. He writes, 'I worked too hard - had a job sweeping the city hall, a lodge hall, the Episcopal church and five homes. I had learned the art of house cleaning and did it well.' This extra work, with his studies, proved to be too much for him. He took a leave of absence from college and taught in a mission school at Piedras Negras, Coah., Mexico, for six months until religious disturbances forced him to leave that country. He returned to McMurry and graduated in 1927. He continued post graduate work and earned degrees of Master of Arts from Denver University and Bachelor of Divinity from Iliff Graduate School of Theology, 1929. He also did graduate work at Union Theological Seminary, Columbia and Yale Universities..."

"No pastor ever gave more faithful service or personal attention to his people than did Donald Mark Runyon; and yet, by carefully planning in advance each day's schedule and by working long hours, he managed to find time and energy for many extra-curricular activities. While at St. Andrews Church, New Haven, he regularly wrote editorials for the New Haven Journal-Courier, some of which attracted wide attention.

He was a pioneer in the use of Visual Aids in Education, was Chairman of the Conference Committee and lectured for a year on this subject at New York University. He attended the Yale School of Alcohol Studies for several sessions, was active in promoting the work of Alcoholics Anonymous, and served on the Conference Committee on Temperance..."

"Joining the New York East Conference on trial in 1930 by transfer from the Colorado Conference, Don was admitted in full and ordained elder in 1931. His first appointment was St. Andrews, New Haven, Conn., (1931-2), followed by Corona, New York City (1933-4), and Shelton, Conn., (1935-9). Then, after a notable eleven-year pastorate at Bellmore, L. I., N. Y., he rendered five years of outstanding service at Kings Highway before an untimely death suddenly ended his promising career."
