McHAFFIE FAMILY

Some twenty years after Andrew McHAFFIE moved his family from Virginia to Knox County, Tennessee, three of his sons, David, John and Hugh McHAFFIE loaded their possessions in wagons and brought their families to Springfield, Missouri where they took claims to land. David purchased 160 acres from the Springfield Land Office in 1838, the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, T 20 N, R 22 W. These men were tanners by trade and as they were unable to find the bark they needed on this Springfield prairie land, they sold their claims and moved southeast to take claims on Finley Creek, now in Christian County, Missouri. In 1839, David purchased 120 acres in Sections 7 and 18, T 27 N, R 10 W. Remaining in Tennessee were three brothers, James, Calvin and William and two sisters, Locky Jane who married James BRAZEL and Julia who married William BRADEN. Later the two sisters' families also came to Christian County. The BRAZELS settled on the Finley and the BRADENS on Stewart Creek.

The Teacher's Contract between Miss Annie VEALE, a legally qualified Public School Teacher and W. E. GREY, Robert JOHNSON and J. T. MOORE, as School Directors of District No. 4, stipulates she will receive Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per month for the four month term, commencing on the 1st day of March 1886. (Copied as written; obvious errors in sex designation).
