He was uniform in life; wise in counsel; tender of the feelings of others, and consequently had the faculty of giving counsel, which was ever-kindly received.
- 2. That as a lodge we tender to his afflicted family, and especially his widow, our deepest sympathy and tender regards.
- 3. That as a Lodge we have suffered an irreparable loss. His venerable form will no more stand before us on the level, to call us back to the ancient landmarks, and teach us the noble tenets of our Order. In humble resignation would we bow before the mandate of the Grand Master above, grateful to Him that he has been spared so long, and in his life given us so bright an example for our imitation.
- 4. That a copy of these resolutions be furnished to the family of the deceased, and that they be published in the De Witt "Observer," and "Evergreen," and spread upon our records.



ARMY EXPERIENCE OF CAPTAIN VERNE E. BARNES

On Gaduating from OCS at Camp Barkeley, Texas my first permament outfit was Canp Bouse. It was classified a secret camp and the 150th Station Hospital was assigned to the Tank Battalion and Armored Infantry Company training here. We later found out they were training to night fight with huge beacons atop some of tanks with flickering colored lights which confused anyone trying to locate them, much like some of the dance floors of the younger people today. They were to take the hedge row country of France just beyond the landing beaches, but by the time they arrived they were not needed, for General Patton's 3rd Army had broken through. They were later used to light up the Remagen bridgehead area on the Rhine. Nobody was allowed to leave our camp except me. The hospital had made arrangement with a local grocer at Parker to supply it with a 30 dozen crate of fresh eggs each week, which was used only for the patients. I was allowed a driver to go with me. We had a good time driving over the sand roads, bouncing when hitting a rutt. Once, after a heavy rain we had to cross wide rivulets to reach our small western cattletown. Parker was exactly like the western towns we would see in the movies. It had dirt streets and board sidwalks. We usually stopped at a local tavern for a quick drink before returning to camp. This was precisely why I had little trouble in having drivers volunteer to drive me to Parker. Our only USO show was when Kay Kaiser surprised us late one afternoon and brought his Lucky Strike Orchestra with Ish Kabibble, Jack Haley and Frances Langford to entertain us. There was not over fifty in the audience. The camp had an officers club but it was dark and dreary with GI's playing high stake poker and drinking beer. The hospital officers met most every evening after dinner at the Nurses recreation tent. I was the youngest and they called me junior because my face turned red when they told off color stories. On Sunday's we would walk in the desert looking for rattlesnakes and climbing small mountains. Suguaro cactus was

At last we got orders to the United Kingdom. The advanced party left. We now had to move a small hospital with beds, machines, and personnel larger than our hospital in Monmouth. We were the Army's smallest station hospital in the United Kingdom with 250 beds. Pop Austin and the advanced party found quarters for us near Carmarthen in South Wales, and then proceded to Blackpool and waited for us to arrive. They were

everywhere.




