

#2235 -- (1) L.W.L. July 3, 1937. MEIGS From Meigs Family in America.

Vincent Meigs, emigrant, came with sons Vincent, John and Mark, time and port not known
Vincent (1) b. 1583, d. abt. 1658; mar. 1608, Churchill. He was first recorded
in Weymouth, Mass., 1639, removed to Rehoboth, 1642 and New Haven, 1644.

John, said to have been b. near Bradford, Eng., 1612, mar. 1632 Thomassine Fry.
Their first child, Mary, as b. Weymouth, Eng., 1633; the others born in America.

(2) CRANE- MEIGS. From Genealogy of the Crane Family, Vol. 11, Descendants of
Henry Crane, b. abt. 1635, was first in business with his brother, Benjamin in Wethers-
field; were farmers and tanners and carriers. * * * * *
