John Mills b England d America 1-17-1704/5 probably m 1682 Sarah Harrold d 10-17-1759 lived in Philadelphia, Pa.

Another John Mills b ca 1688 d 11-24-1760 New Garden MM, N.C., may have been a son of the first John and Sarah - he lived in Prince George Co., Maryland, went to North Carolina 1752, settled in Rowan Co. His will written 9-28-1759 probated Rowan Co. July 1761. All of his children were in Frederick County, Va. near Winchester. They went to N.C. about 1753. John was considered one of the "fathers of the colony."

Thomas Mills b 1709 or 1-28-1713 d 9-10-1793, son of John Mills of Monoquiesy, m 4-18-1730 at Josiah Ballinger's, Elizabeth Harrold b 3-10-1711 d 9-9-1771 dt of Richard and Mary Harold of New Garden MM, Pa. (son of the John Mills who was born 1688 d 11-24-1760 m 1st 1708 _____).

John Mills b 1730 d 8-9-1814 Clinton Co., Ohio - maybe son of Thomas and Elizabeth (Harrold) Mills, maybe Jonathan - called that by some - lived Cane Creek, S. C. Bush River MM 1782 went to Ohio 1805 m 1st 1765 Elizabeth Edwards b 1750 d 1784 dt Samuel R and Elizabeth (Franklin) Edwards

Marmaduke Mills b 1777 d 3-14-1823 son of John and Elizabeth (Edward) Mills m at Bush River MM SC Patience O'Neal dt Hugh O'Neal. They went from Bush River MM SC to Miami MM O 1804
