JOHN MOULTON of Hampton.

He arrived in Boston 8 June 1637, age 38, with wife ANNE, age 38, five children and two servants. He was one of those asking leave in 1638 to settle in Hampton where he was granted 250 acres in December 1639. He was a Freeman, 22 May 1639; lot layer; Representative to the General Court in Boston in 1639; with Goodman Cross he made a valuation of the Hampton live stock for the General Court in 1640; he was a commissioner to end small causes in 1641, and selectman in 1647.

Children:-

HENRY MOULTON, Born in England and came with his parents to New England.
Died: 8 September 1701 *Dover*
Married 20 November 1651 to Sobriety Hilton. Five children.

MARY MOULTON, married before January 1649, to William Sanborn.
Sometimes called Mercy. Six children.

ANNE MOULTON, probably unmarried in 1649.

JANE MOULTON)

) Twins, both unmarried, and both died 19 March 1699.

BRIDGET MOULTON)

JOHN MOULTON, (Lieut.) of Hampton .

Baptized, (March) 1638 at Newbury

Married 23 March 1666 to LYDIA TAYLOR (dau. of Anthony)

Administration of his estate granted to son John 4 March 1706/7.

Eleven children

RUTH MOULTON, baptized 7 March 1640/1 at Hampton. Apparently died before 1649.

THOMAS MOULTON of Hampton.

He came to Newbury in 1637, and with the first settlers to Hampton, where he was granted 80 acres in December 1639 and lived near the home of his older brother JOHN. He was a Freeman 31 March 1638; Selectman 1644, & 1652. He was designated "of Hampton" in deeds to 12 May 1656 when he sold his home there, but owned in York in July 1654 and bought 70 acres with a small building adjacent to Arthur Bragdon in March 1655; of York, he sold this to Alexander Maxwell 23 January 1657. He lived on Georges Neck until his death. He had York grants in 1659, 1681; he was constable in 1661; grand juror 1666-7; trial juror in 1668. He signed a petition in favor of Peter Weare in 1668. In 1684 Thomas and wife Martha deeded their whole estate to son Jeremiah and Joseph for life support.

Children:-

THOMAS MOULTON: baptized 24 November 1639 at Hampton; no later record, probably died without issue.

DANIEL MOULTON; Baptized 13 February 1641/2 Hampton; removed to Portsmouth, d.s.p.

ABIGAIL MOULTON; born ca. 1645; married before July 1669 to Henry Simpson,

JOSEPH MOULTON: BORN PROBABLY before 1660 at York, removed to Portsmouth, N.H. 4 sons.

Children of Thomas Moulton and Martha, continued.

JEREMIAH MOULTON, Born about 1657 (or 1650), probably at Yonk, Maine,
died, 26 December 1731. Married twice, see following.

MARY MOULTON, born, 25 January 1651/2, Hampton

HANNAH MOULTON, born 19 June 1655, Hampton
married Samuel Tilton.

MIRIAM MOULTON, Born ca. 1614.
married before December 1641 to Thomas King.
Her will dated 11 March and proved 9 April 1667.
She came to New England in 1637 with brothers John & Thomas.
The will of her husband in 1667 names cousin Henry, cousin
Rachel wife of Christian Dolloff, and cousin John.

(A son) MOULTON (name unknown) ? *Walter*
He was a brother of John and Miriam Moulton.
Only known child,

RACHEL MOULTON, she married (as first wife) to Christian Dolloff.
Mary Dolloff, born 17 Sept. 1667; married James Gilman.

John Dolloff, born 17 February 1668/9; killed by Indians
on 15 September 1707.

James Dolloff, born 25 December 1670, killed by the heathen
at Casco, 4 August 1691.

Christian Dolloff by his second wife, Sarah Scammon, had
four more children. They were married 10 December 1674.

HENRY MOULTON, (John¹) Of Hampton.

Born in England and came with his parents to New England in 1637.

Died 8 September 1701

Married, 20 November 1651, to Sobriety Hilton. *d/o Edward*

In June 1640 he had a grant in the town of Hampton and shared in the division of common lands in 1645. He lived on the third lot east of his father's.

He was a selectman ten times 1653- 1688; grand juror 1683-4; he was called "Senior" in 1683, but no "Junior" appears in his family. His estate was

divided by agreement 1701, the homestead to son John, he and son Jonathan to maintain the mother who died 31 January 1718/9, aged 85.

JOHN MOULTON, born 22 February 1659/60; died 21 January 1741;

married (1st.) 3 December 1685, Lucy Marston, she died 8 March 1688.
(2nd.) 25 April 1689, Elizabeth Worthington.
Eight children in all.

JONATHAN MOULTON, born 25 December 1663; died 3 July 1742.
Married Sarah Paine of Gloucester; three children.

ABIGAIL MOULTON, born 2 October 1666; died a widow, 7 October 1705.
Married _____ Leacock, with issue.

(Lieut.) JOHN MOULTON, (John ¹) of Hampton "The Giant"

Baptized, March 1638 at Newbury.

Died, before 4 March 1706/7, when administration of his estate was granted to son John.

Married; 23 March 1666 to Lydia Taylor (daughter of Anthony).

He lived on the homestead.

He was Selectman in 1676-7 and 1694; grand jury in 1683, 1694, and 1696.

He deposed in October 1669, aged about 30; in 1694 as Ensign aged about 55.

He was called lieutenant in 1700.

His heirs signed an agreement 4 March 1706/7 when son John was appointed as administrator. Widow Lydia died in 1729, aged 83.

John Moulton, carpenter, born 30 May 1669; died 1 April 1740

married 11 December 1713 to Rebecca Smith, (dau. of John) 5 children.

Daniel Moulton, born 16 March 1672/3; died 4 January 1718. -

married Mary _____ who survived him. Ten Children.

James Moulton, born 29 July 1675;

married 15 October 1702 to Dorothy Clements; one daughter.

Sarah Keaser of Haverhill. Two children recorded at Hampton.

David Moulton, blacksmith, born 1704; died 15 February 1732/3.

married 2 January 1710 to Sarah Leavitt. Seven children recorded.

Anna Moulton, born 2 March 1679; married Caleb Marston.

Lydia Moulton, born 19 July 1681; married Thomas Marston.

Jacob Moulton, 21 June 1688; he died 7 March 1751.

married 10 December 1714 to Sarah Smith. Six children.

married 21 May 1718 to Captain Jabex Smith
