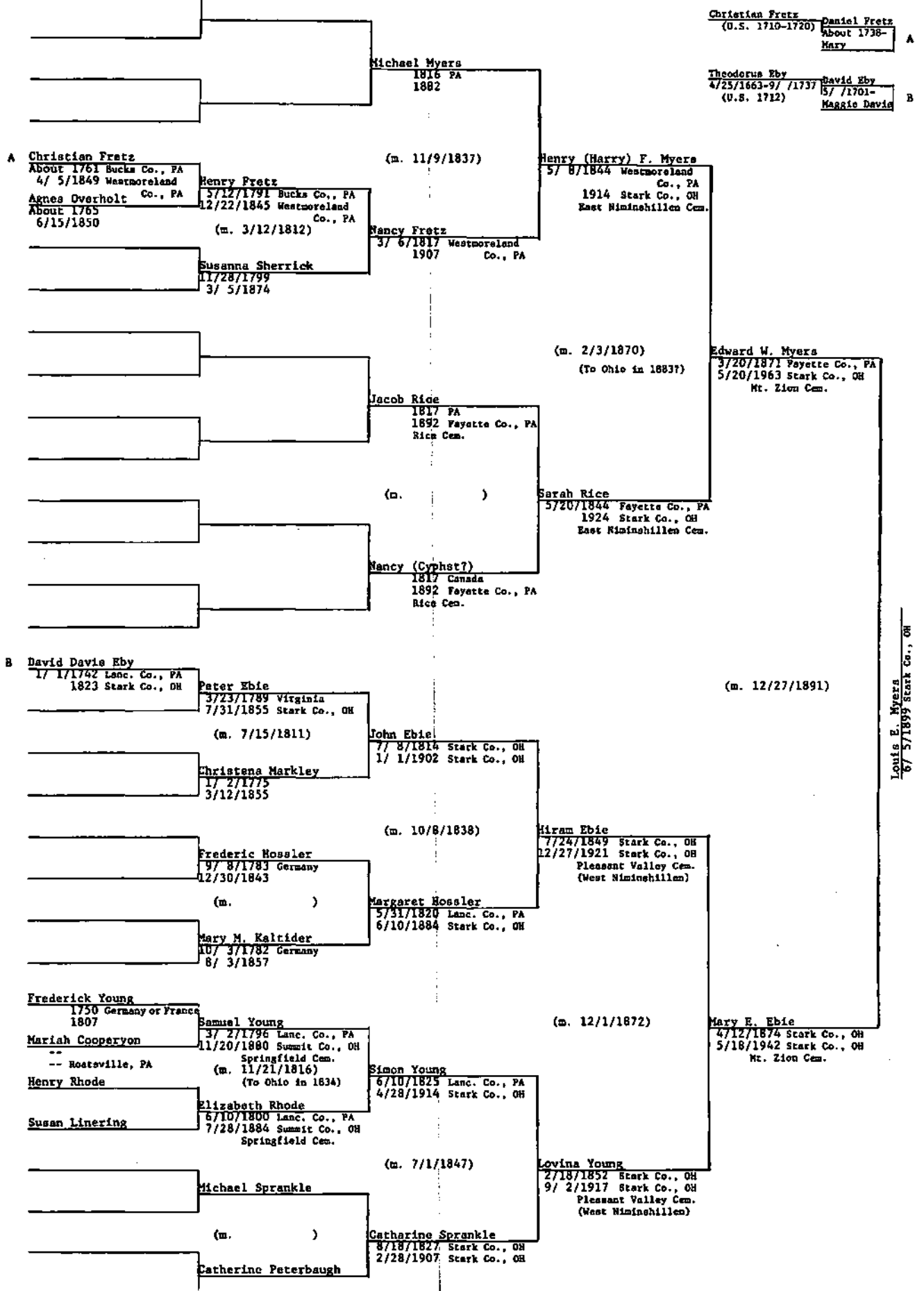

III Margaret (Hossler) Ebie, wife of John Ebie. She was the mother of 18 children one of whom was Hiram Ebie.



III Simon and Catharine (Sprankle) Young. Their children were Henry (1849-1915); Lovina (1852-1917) m. Hiram Ebie; Emanuel S. (1854-1923); Mary (1859-1944) m. George Cox; Simon S. (1862-1900). Simon was a carpenter and a farmer and a member of Brethren Church.

Pleasant Church in Stark Co.



III Jacob and Nancy (Cyphst?) Rice. These are the parents of Sarah who married Henry (Harry) Myers from whom we descend.

According to the 1850 Census, Jacob Rice was living in Bullskin Township, Fayette Co., Pennsylvania. He was born in Pa. and was a farmer with \$1500 worth of real estate. His age was given as 38. His wife, Nancy, was born in Canada and was also 38. The following children were listed with their ages: Mary (17); Nancy (9); Sarah (6); Joseph (4); Abraham (4); Nathan (1).

Nancy married Daniel Truxel and remained in the area. Sarah married Henry (Harry) Myers and moved to Ohio in the 1880's. The twins, Joseph and Abraham, moved further west -- possibly Iowa.

Henry, who was a farmer, and Sarah (Rice) Myers lived in western Pennsylvania -- either Westmoreland Co. or Fayette Co. -- until about 1883. At that time they moved to Marshallville, Ohio, by covered wagon. They were there a year or so before returning to Pa. About 1887 they again went to Ohio and settled south of Hartville. Edward was a young man by now and worked as a hired hand for Hiram Ebie who was to become his father-in-law.

V Edward (1871-1963) m. Mary Ebie (1874-1942). Children: VI William, Harry, Louis, Emanuel, Viola, James, Edna.

V Jacob Rice (1873-1952) m. Susan Weaver. Children: VI Henry, Roy, Sarah.

V Nanny (1876-1962) m. Amos Mohler (1877-1954). Children: VI Wally, Carl, twins Mary and Martha, Earl.

According to the 1850 Census, IV Henry's father, III Michael, and family were living in East Huntingdon Township, Westmoreland Co., Pa. All were born in Pa. His occupation was farmer and he owned real estate worth \$3500. His age was given as 33 and his wife Nancy was 32. The children and their ages were: Agnes (12), Susan (10), Ann Eliz (9), Catherine (7), Henry (6), Hannah (5), Mahlon (3), Elizabeth (2), and David (8/12). The Fretz History book lists seven more children born after 1850.



V John Peter and Alice (Mohler) Holl and children: Howard, Willard, Royal, Stella, Russell, and Ada (seated). Peter and Alice lived most of their lives in Summit and Stark Counties, Ohio. He was a farmer, and they were members of the Church of the Brethren. The following are their descendants to three generations.

Louis Myers was born June 5, 1899, west of Mt. Pleasant, Stark Co., Ohio. He went to school at the Mt. Zion School on Pittsburg Road next to the Mt. Zion Cemetery as did his mother, grandmother, Lovina, and Lovina's parents. The school building is no longer standing.

Stella Holl was born January 15, 1903, at the Treet Farm, Talmadge, Summit Co., Ohio. Diphtheria nearly took her life when she was three. She went to school at Springfield, Mishler Station, and North Canton.

Louis and Stella met at a church function, both of them being Brethren, in 1918. Both were baptized by Rev. Reuben Shroyer. Stella's home church was the Springfield Church in Summit Co. where many of her ancestors are buried. Louis' home church was the Mt. Pleasant (formerly West Nimishillen) Church.

After they were married February 6, 1921, they set up housekeeping at Hiram Ebie's place north of the Mt. Pleasant Church. They lived several places -- including Johnny Ream's south of Greensburg -- before building their first home on the Mt. Pleasant Road in 1925. Later, in 1938, they built on what is now the Akron-Canton Airport property. After the airport came into being, they lived for a time on Stella's Uncle Myron Mohler's farm east of Mt. Pleasant. In 1944 their home on the airport property was moved two miles west and placed at the intersection of Rt. 241 and the Mt. Pleasant Road where they lived for 19 years. In December of 1963, Louis retired from his business and they moved to 102 College Ave., Elizabethtown, Pa. where they now make their home.

Louis spent most of his life in the carpentry business working for Harry Mohler for 17 years then contracting over one hundred homes from 1948-1959 on his own. In his later years, he built 23 grandfather clocks. Stella put her energy into the family. She has made many quilts and hooked rugs over the years and still sews for her great-grandchildren. From 1964-1973 she worked at Elizabethtown College while Louis became the "neighborhood handy man." For the last seven summers they have worked at Camp Swatara, Bethel, Pa., preparing delicious meals for which they are known. In Elizabethtown, they serve in the Elizabethtown Church of the Brethren, but maintain their membership in the Mt. Pleasant Church in Ohio.

They have four children: Virgil E. and Burdette D. who live in North Canton, Ohio; Annabel (m. Paul Lautzenhiser) who lives in North Lawrence, Ohio; and Marialice (m. J. Robert Hollinger) who lives in Elizabethtown, Pa. All their children are members of the Church of the Brethren.
