NESSLY, Jacob of Brook Co., VA dec'd recorded in Col. Co., 1832/33

Finally I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my son John NESSLY and James W. BROWN, son of Barbara, my daughter, my grandson, my sole executors of this my last will and testament hereby giving and allowing each of them the sum of one dollar for each and everyday they shall be engaged nessariarly in settling and adjusting the business and affairs of my estate and also all their necessary and incidental expenses and I do hereby authorise empower and direct them to make and execute deed for any lands which I may have sold and yet payment and satisfaction therefore. Executed this twenty sixth day of March 1827.

Jacob NESSLY of Brook Co., VA sold to Thomas CARROLL of Belmont Co. and then Thomas CARROLL sold to Chas COFFIN and David SMALL.
