### OGLESBY FAMILY

A family sketch of this family was published in *Fayette Facts*, Volume 7 #1 (1978). Since that time much additional information has been uncovered which we are pleased to present here. Information on the GELSINGER line of this family came in part from Carol Gustafson's book, "Gelsinger, Friend...". Richard Paul who descends through Nancy OGLESBY contributed much information. We would appreciate any updates from our readers.

Two brothers, Archibald and Joseph OGLESBY came from Tennessee in 1838-9 and settled in the southeastern part of what is now Otego Twp. A possible sister is Sarah OGLESBY who married Thomas BRITTON. This couple is living a few doors away from Archibald on the 1870 Fayette Co., Census. More research would need to be done to prove this relationship.

**Archibald OGLESBY** was born ca 1794 in North Carolina and died after 1870. He married Elizabeth STRAUTHER she b ca 1795 in Virginia and she died after 1852. They lived in Otego Township. Both are buried in Nichols Cem. Dick Paul said that at one time a grandson of theirs was going to place a marker. When he got ready to do so he had forgotten the location of their graves.

**Joseph OGLESBY** was born in North Carolina around 1799 and died after the 1860 Census in Fayette County. We believe his wife was Elizabeth born 24 Sep 1781 and buried in Evans Cem., Bear Grove Twp.; the death date is broken from her tombstone. She was dead by 1850. In 1831 an election was held at Joseph's home in Kaskaskia District. In 1860 Joseph with his children living near him is found in Bear Grove Twp.

## OGLESBY FAMILY

On March 26, 1841 Reuben OGLESBY was charged with theft from Jonathan BRITTON of "fine comb and a string money purse made of fleac (flex) linen cloth with some money in it...stolen and carried away out of the house of Jonathan Britain". An order to search the house of Archibald OGLESBY for stolen property was published in *Fayette Facts*, Vol. 19 No. 1 pages 11-12. Reuben admitted to stealing the money. He served 1 year in a northern Illinois penitentiary.
