I Joseph Ulmsted Sen - of Hartford do make my last will and testament - I give to my wife 1-3 - part of all my moveable estate - she to have her choice - to be at her own disposal - and the use of 1-3 of all my lands during her natural life - also as much of my housing and barn and cellar as she shall judge she shall have need of for her use - always provided that it amount not to above 1-2 of the building - I give to my son Joseph Ulmsted as followeth - I confirm to him all the housing and lands given him by deed of gift also 1/2 of the logg meadow or wet land belonging to the lot where his dwelling house standeth. I give to my son Joseph Ulmsted 10. acres of upland and 10. acres in a part of a lott on which my dwelling standeth and is to begin after 10. acres is measured off from the land given to the Rev. Samuel Woodbridge, east - I give to my son James Ulmsted all that estate in housing and lands given him by deed of gift - and I give to my son James Ulmsted

Will - It is my will to give my Estate between my two sons - that is to say one halfe to my son Nicholas and the other halfe to my sonne Nehemiah, equally devidded between the both of them, with this reservation - that my brother ^{Leomis} Symus doe make good his word to make my sonne Nicholas's wife's portion as good as any child he hath - for so I understand his promise is, but if he should refuse to do so, I shall then refuse to give my sonne any parte of my movable goods - catells - or debts -

but my Will is to have the thing with Richard Webb and William Wodsworth to see my Brother ^{Leomis} Symus doe perform his promise, and as the said Richard Webb and Will Wodsworth shall doe I shall be content. And if my Brother Symus doe performe his promise then my Will is their portions shall be a like - only Nicholas shall abate as much as I have given him before, and my Will is that my sonne Nehemiah shall give out of his portion ten pounds to my Cousin Rebecca Ulmstead who now dwelleth with me - and he shall pay yt to her with in

and Thomas 20 - 8 shillings. I give to my son Samuel
Ulmstead my Dwelling house in Hartford, after
my decease, only the use of some part of it to his
mother. I give unto my son Samuel $\frac{1}{2}$ of my Barn,
and all that part of my home lotte not given to my
son Thomas. I give my Barn Yard equally to my
sons Samuel and my son Thomas with my will
in the same - I give to my son Thomas that
part of my Home lott next Mr. Haynes and Mr.

my son Thomas my meadow lott in the Long
Meadow lying between Deacon Butlers and

Swamp land belonging to the same up on
which he hath built his home, on the East
