I received a letter from MRS HARLEY MAY of Bolivar, MO (Polk) in response to a query I had in the GENEALOGICAL HELPER asking me if I could help her with her WESLEY PENNINGTON ancestor. Paul & I had just located 3 PENNINGTONS in Knox County, Illinois about the same time that RIGGS had helped make KNOX a county, separating it from the FULTON CO county seat: LIDIA m JESSE ADKINSON 1831 (I-p 1); STEPHEN I m MARY JANE McCALLISTER 1833 (I p 2); & WESLEY m MARGARET McCALLISTER 1833 (I p2). RIGGS named 3 of his children LYDIA, STEPHEN, & WESLEY; so it is conjecture as to whether these were younger brothers, or more nephews & a niece. WESLEY's movements seemed to follow the Missouri, Texas, Arkansas route of RIGGS and other PENNINGTONS. I am sending Mrs MAY's line as she is most anxious to establish her WESLEY PENNINGTON connection.

William P Thompson had gotten acquainted with Eliza Pennington when she was a pupil in a class he was teaching in McDonough County, Illinois. They moved to Blackhawk County, Iowa, in the fall of 1865 or early 1866, where they bought land at \$1.65 an acre. William P. was a Baptist minister in Hudson, Iowa. When Eliza's sister, Martha Marena Hastings died in 1889, William P. and Eliza raised Belle Hastings. Belle tried to keep in touch with her brother and two sisters during her lifetime. She adored "Grandpa Thompson" and mourned Eliza's passing after Belle had moved to California in 1906 to be with her Aunt, Malysa Jane Wydes, who had raised Belle's younger sister, Della.

William Riley Pennington was reared in Industry township, McDonough County, Illinois. He moved to Waterloo, Iowa (Blackhawk County) after the Civil War. He sent money to William P. Thompson, Eliza's husband--and brother of Mattie, to buy a farm in Blackhawk County. This was called "Mattie's '80'"--it was sold later and 160 acres in Page County were purchased for the same amount as had been paid for the "80." The 1870 census found William Riley's family in Eagle township, Blackhawk County, Iowa. William Riley mortgaged the 160 acres when he tried to buy more acreage. Hog cholera wiped him out and he lost the land.

Mattie never got over the death of her beloved children in 1877. In a letter to a relative, the Davis Byler family, on 24 February, 1878, she told about the deaths of Charlie and Mary. She wrote, "They had three different diseases combined---typhoid fever, putrid sore throat, and cerebral meningitis. Charlie was taken sick October 6 and died the 30th. Mary and Burtie were taken the 12th and Mary died the 26th--and Burtie would have died if we had not got a doctor that understood the diseases."

Walter Melvin Pennington, the 8th child, was the source of most of the Pennington information on the Allen and Hannah Power Pennington line. For years--1930s until his death in 1960--he wrote letters, kept copies, and tried to find the origins of the Penningtons. Much of this material is from letters he wrote to his cousin, Belle Hastings Andres during this 30-year period. Walter wrote that he was taken along with the baby by Aunt Jane Wydes, but after the father remarried he returned home (John Allen ran away) but his memories of the problems between his spirited sister, Flora Belle, and the club-footed stepmother, who had no children of her own, were typical of the period when so many women died from having too many children in a wilderness. The family moved to Redwillow County, Nebraska, to Bartley, in 1883.

Both Nicholas and Malysa Jane Wydes are buried in San Gabriel Cemetery, San Gabriel, California, next to the niece, Della Hastings, whom they raised after the death of Martha Marena Hastings in 1889. Another niece, Belle Hastings Andres is also buried along with her husband, Frank E Andres, and his parents, William Frank Andres and Margaret Gillin Andres, in another part of San Gabriel Cemetery (Los Angeles County).

Nicholas and Malysa first took Ola, daughter of her brother, John L. Pennington (married to Docia Holstine) and raised her when John and Docia separated for a period of time. Later Nicholas and "Aunt Jane" took Walter Melvin and William H. Pennington after Mattie's death (the baby died soon and Walter went home when his father remarried in three years). After Martha Marena's death in 1889, her children were scattered far and wide (she died in Nebraska). Eliza & William Thompson took Belle; the father, Andrew Hastings, took Charles (who ran away while a teenager), and William Riley and his second wife, Mary Jane Calkins, took Marena Jane, but this spirited girl fared no better with the stepmother than did Flora Belle. By 1900 Marena Jane showed up in California with the Wydes family. Belle joined Aunt Jane and Uncle Nicholas "to try to find a husband" after her 24th birthday came. This unselfish couple, with no children of their own, made a comfortable home for these nieces and nephews. Belle Hastings Andres always spoke glowingly of "Aunt Jane." Della Hastings was fortunate in having "drawn" the Wydes couple as her "parents."

Nicholas Wydes was grantee of lot #6 of the N W Quarter of the N W quarter of Section 28 in Township 85 N & Range 19 W of 5th PM of Iowa--7 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres--executed 4 Jan 1879 Marshall Co., Iowa. Deed Record 94 p 267. In 1900 they sold 40 acres & also 120 more acres; it was notarized 6 Dec 1900 from Los Angeles, California. Deed record #225 p 392 & #225 P 393, Marshall Co., Iowa.

Frank Andres bought the "Aunt Jane house" for Belle Andres and in 1973 it is still owned by Helen Russell, Belle's daughter.

Frank Pennington was a private in Co 1, 11th Cavalry, Illinois enlisting 1 April 1862 at Des Moines, Iowa and being mustered out 30 Sept, 1865 at Memphis, Tennessee. He went home to McDonough County, then to Blackhawk County, Iowa where he married (his oldest sister, Eliza and older brother, William Riley Pennington were there) and later moved to Lebanon, Nebraska, in Red Willow County near the William Riley Pennington family. One of William R's boys, Edward M is buried near Frank.

George Albert Thompson and his sister Abbie Isabel Thompson married Cora B Speicher and John G. Speicher, who were brother and sister also. These offspring were double cousins. The offspring of William Riley Pennington were double cousins of Eliza Ann Pennington Thompson's issue. Walter Melvin Pennington in his genealogical findings thoroughly enjoyed trying to line up the various relationships for his siblings and cousins.

The Speicher line became religiously involved in a fundamentalist religion which had its center in Zion City, Illinois (Lake). The many relatives referred to this as the ZIONIST movement. John G. and Abbie Isabel Thompson Speicher traveled extensively in Europe under this Zionist faith. Abbie's health broke under this travel along with too many pregnancies and she died at 34 years of age.

Spirited Flora provoked her stepmother into beating her with a stove poker, making life unbearable for both. The club-footed Mary Jane Calkins Pennington probably took many taunts from Flora and later from young equally as aggressive Marena Jane Hastings. Walter Melvin Pennington's letters to various relatives have been the main source of many of these dates. He carefully checked on relatives for over 25 years. He became acquainted (after his wife's death) with the widow of Arthur Elza "Bud" Robertson, son of Sarah D. Pennington, who married Cyrus Robertson. Her name was Inez McCoy Robertson, and she married Walter Melvin in 1953 at Lebanon, Indiana (Boone). Inez died 29 January, 1966 at Lebanon, Indiana.

Walter Melvin's son, Ivo, gathered up Walter's things after his death and evidently burned most of the facts in his father's family history. Only copies of his letters to such relatives as Belle Hastings Andres (1933 and also 1950-1952) and Miss Treva Leftridge of Vermont, Illinois (1935). Hazel (Mrs. Loren) Garner daughter of Inez McCoy Robertson also found scraps of letters that Ivo did not destroy. Most of the family rested secure for two generations--thinking that Walter Melvin Pennington had their PENNINGTON facts available for them when they wanted them.

Ola Pennington's parents separated after the birth of her sister Aveline (November, 1869) evidently. This sister is never mentioned except in the 1870 census, page 28, in the city of Industry (McDonough County) Illinois when Docia was still the wife of John L. Pennington. Her father is supposed to have divorced Docia and married Alma _____, by whom he had a daughter who lived near Rocky Ford, Colorado (Otera). Later John L. Pennington (according to Walter Melvin Pennington) went back to Docia Holstine Pennington and without a divorce from Alma or a remarriage raised a boy and two girls with her out in McMinnville, Oregon (Yamhill).

Ola, in the meanwhile, was raised by her aunt, Malysa Jane Wydes, and must have gone to Bangor, Iowa (Marshall) with them and must have been there when Hannah Power Pennington died from pneumonia on a visit to the Nicholas Wydes in January, 1883. Ola was probably married by the time the Wydes took on the rearing of Della Hastings on October 12, 1889, after Della's mother's death on September 10th near Broken Bow, Nebraska (Custer).

Ola must have been with the Wydes when Walter Melvin Pennington and his baby brother, William H. Pennington, were taken by "Aunt Jane" Wydes after Mattie Thompson Pennington's death in July, 1880. Little William died from malnutrition six weeks later. Perhaps Walter Melvin stayed there until his father remarried in 1883. Walter Melvin seemed to know the "gossip" about Docia and John L. Pennington, but her removal to California around 1900 broke her contact with the Penningtons in the Midwest.....Aunt Jane Wydes had no children of her own, but she and Uncle Nicholas served as loving guardians to many Pennington children without parents of their own.

PAUL E & FRANKYE ANDRES have been trying to put together the story of Paul's PENNINGTON connection--ALLEN & HANNAH POWER PENNINGTON. Frankye got the genealogy bug a couple of years ago and Paul soon joined her in the cemetery and courthouse delving. The summer of 1973 they visited Schuyler, McDonough, Knox, Tazewell, Peoria & McLean counties in Illinois searching out lands, births, deaths, marriages. They went on to Iowa to Marshall County and Blackhawk County. They ended up in Harlan, Custer, Furnas, McCook, & other counties in NEBRASKA where they knew PENNINGTONS had lived. Their appetite had been whetted by the finding of the ALLEN & HANNAH POWER PENNINGTON bible in the effects of ROGER THOMPSON, youngest child of WILLIAM P & ELIZA ANN PENNINGTON THOMPSON, just as WALTER MELVIN PENNINGTON had described the bible in a 1953 letter to BELLE HASTINGS ANDRES, his cousin. POWER was spelled this way by JAMES POWER b 30 Jan 1789 and PENNINGTON was spelled with one N in all the early names (1833 Bible published by V Waugh & T Mason for the Methodist Episcopal Church, J Collord printer) purchased 4 August, 1834, 6 months before the marriage of ALLEN & HANNAH. JAMES POWER helped to build the first public building in Schuyler County in 1829, & he & his wife RACHEL b 11 Feb 1796, m 6 July 1815 had HANNAH b 12 Apr 1817 in Pennsylvania, ELIZA b 12 June 1819, JOHN b 6 Sept 1821, JANE b 21 July 1823, JAMES b 23 Dec 1827 & d ___ 7 1829, & SARAH b 1 Jan ___ (a piece of the page is gone) The bible mentions that ALLEN IS THE SON OF M___ & ANN (How we wish that portion of the page were still there!) HANNAH POWER PENNINGTON had lost ALLEN in 1867 from typhoid, and her last child was gone; so she went to live with ELIZA THOMPSON in Hudson, Iowa (Blackhawk). She left her belongings there expecting to return from a visit to JANE WYDES in Marshall County. Perhaps she visited her other children nearby as WILLIAM RILEY PENNINGTON who had lost his wife in July, 1880 in Shenandoah Iowa (Page) moved to Nebraska in 1883. HANNAH was buried with a marker with one N and nearby is the baby WILLIAM of WILLIAM RILEY PENNINGTON who died after JANE WYDES took him after the mother's death in 1880.

WILLIAM RILEY PENNINGTON moved from Industry, McDonough Co., Ill., to Waterloo, Iowa (Blackhawk) after the Civil War. He sent money to William P Thompson, Eliza's husband and the brother of his wife, Mattie, to buy a farm for him. This was called 'Mattie's '80'--and it was sold later and 160 acres in Page County, Iowa were purchased for the same amount as had been paid for the '80.' The 1870 census found his family in Eagle township, Blackhawk Co., Iowa. William Riley mortgaged the 160 acres when he tried to buy more acreage, but hog cholera wiped him out and he lost the land. Mattie never got over the death of her beloved children in 1877. She died after the birth of William in 1880. WALTER MELVIN, the 8th child, was the source of most of the original information on the ALLEN and HANNAH POWER PENNINGTON line. For years--1930s until his death--he wrote letters, kept copies, and tried to find the origins of the PENNINGTONS. Much of this material found in this summary is from his letters to his cousin, BELLE HASTINGS ANDRES during this period. WALTER wrote that he too was taken along with the baby by Aunt "JANE" WYDES in Iowa, but after the father remarried, he returned home (John Allen ran away) but his memories of the problems between his spirited sister, FLORA BELLE, and the club-footed stepmother, who had no children of her own, were typical of the period when so many women died from having too many children in a wilderness. The family moved to Bartley Nebraska (Redwillow) in 1883.

GROVER b 5 June 1886 Alma Nebraska (Harlan), d 17 July 1889, probably in Callaway, NEBR (Custer) although there is no mention of him in the SAND VALLEY CEMETERY records that list his father and mother.

DELLA b 25 July 1888 probably near Callaway, NEBR (Custer), m briefly but kept maiden name, d 4 May 1946 Pasadena, CA (Los Angeles) DELLA lived with UNCLE NICHOLAS & AUNT JANE (Myliissa Jane) PENNINGTON WYDES & went to Alhambra, California in 1900 when they left Liberty twp, Marshall Co., Iowa.

ANDREW E & MARTHA MARENA PENNINGTON HASTINGS were typical of the restlessness of families in those days. Andrew's father, HANDY E HASTINGS left McDonough County, Illinois after the death of his wife; he remarried in Alma, NEBR (Harlan). Andrew joined him and bought land; JOEL JUDSON PENNINGTON also bought land nearby, and WILLIAM RILEY PENNINGTON married again in Furnas County; so there were HASTINGS & PENNINGTONS in Nebraska. ANDREW sold his Alma land at a profit and took out a loan on a homestead near Callaway, NEBR (Custer). Water was available only at a neighbor's well. With MATTIE'S death ANDREW took out a second mortgage to pay for the cemetery lots and to send the children home to the PENNINGTONS; this came due 10 days after he signed it! He lost the land and never saw his children. The PENNINGTONS were bitter, but the Custer County records are filled with the shyster dealings of the loan company which preyed on grieving settlers. ANDREW later remarried and lived in Dawson County. The children were scattered. BELLE lived with WILLIAM P & ELIZA PENNINGTON THOMPSON in Hudson Iowa (Blackhawk); RENA lived with WILLIAM RILEY PENNINGTON and his second wife, but spirited RENA got along no better with MARY CALKINS than did WILLIAM'S daughter FLORA BELLE. NICHOLAS & MYLISSA JANE PENNINGTON WYDES took over baby DELLA (as she had reared brother JOHN L PENNINGTON'S daughter VIOLA) and in 1899 moved to California. RENA followed later as did BELLE. CHARLES EDGAR stayed with his father but ran away to the woods; he died in Vancouver B C. BELLE kept in touch with her brother & sisters. Her son, PAUL ANDRES visited with CHARLES in 1959 before Charles died. BELLE ANDRES' face was kind and sweet but the sadness of her own lack of family and the repeat in the children of sister RENA was mirrored in her facial expression, & in her kindness toward others. Buried in San Gabriel Cemetery (California) are DELLA HASTINGS with MYLISSA JANE & NICHOLAS WYDES, and FRANK EDWARD & BELLE HASTINGS ANDRES with WILLIAM F ANDRES (Frank's father) and nearby MARGARET GILLIN ANDRES (Frank's mother).
