April 18, 1883.

DICY PERKINS, wife of WM. G. PERKINS. Died in St. George, UT of old age. Deceased was born 12 Aug 1796 in Patrick Co. VA; came with her husband to Hancock Co. & settled in Webster ca. 1827; joined Mormons & left in 1846 for Salt Lake; leaves daughter PATTY and her aged husband. "Aunt Dicy Perkins" used to attend to many with sickness in their families.

From Salt Lake paper, 1886.

January 12, 1887.

PERKINS. Died 16th?(hard to read) Nov 1886, in St. George, Washington Co. UT, WILLIAM G. PERKINS. He was son of UTE PERKINS and SARAH GRANT PERKINS, was born in SC11 Jan 1801. His father moved to TN in 1805 and lived there until 1829. He married DICY ANN RAY 22 Feb 1818 with whom he had son and daughter. Moved to Hancock Co. IL in 1829. Baptized by Joel H. Johnson and was ordained as a Preacher. He was ordained as High Priest by Hyrum Smith and set apart under the hands of Pres. Brigham Young & H. C. Kimball & act as Bishop in Macedonia. He took his mission to southern IL in 1843, received his endowments in 1846, moved to Council Bluff (IA) for 2 years then moved to Salt Lake & made Bishop of the 7th Ward. 1851? sent on mission to St. George and remained there until his death.....Funeral services were held in the Tabernacle at St. George on 17 Nov. 1886 at 2 p.m. A large number of attendants & vehicles accompanied him to the grave.

WHITE HOUSE FARM or PERKINS HOUSE is a one and a half story farm house built ca. 1721. The date appears in glazed headers on the west gable. The brick facade on the north side is laid in English bond while on the south and west gable is laid in Flemish bond. The house retains original hand-hewn beams in the kitchen ceiling and corner stairs. The fireplaces on both floors are provided for with double flues in the chimneys. Iron firebacks made in England are featured in two first floor fireplaces. The house contains some of the original hardware.

WHITE HOUSE FARM is mentioned in the will of DANIEL PERKINS in 1742: "my dwelling plantation, including acreage, saw mill & grist mill, to my son, THOMAS PERKINS." The present owner, a gracious hostess, Mrs. Arthur Pinder is descended from Daniel Perkins.

Editor's note: This home is well maintained and contains an intriguing mixture of ghost stories and mysterious footprints indelibly etched on the kitchen ceiling.

He had two sons, JAMES and LUKE; seven daughters: ANNA, JEMIMA, MARY, KEZIA, SUSANNAH, PATTY and PHEBE. Anna married Joseph Reynolds; Mary married Capt. William French; Kezia married Matthew Packard; Susannah married Simeon Brett; Patty married Gideon Lincoln; Phebe married Asaph Howard Esq.; James married a Packard and lives in Minot, ME; Luke married a Snell and resides in Winthrop, ME. Ensign Luke Perkins was 51 years old when he died in 1776.

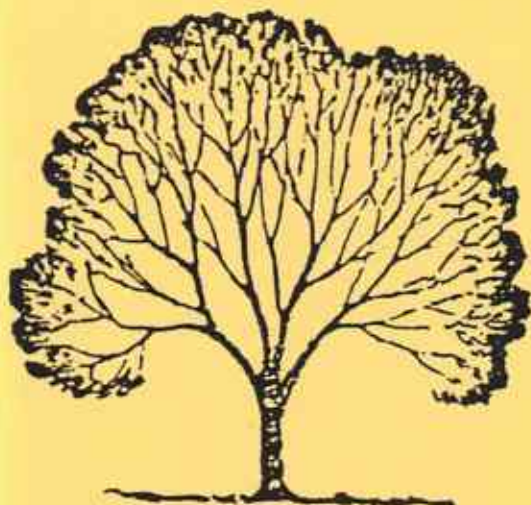

Recently one of our cousins, David L. Perkins of Sunnyvale, California visited Hillmorton, England; and in 1984 The Rev. Ken Perkins of Honolulu, Hawaii visited there. They both wrote me of their experiences which I found very interesting. I will share parts of their letters with you.

They each met with the Vicar of Hillmorton Parish, and were taken on a tour of St. John the Baptist Church. Inside the church on the narthex wall, is a plaque with the wording:

#### THE PERKINS CHARITY

The sum of L100 was invested in L3 per centum India stock by Thomas Perkins of Hitchin, and John Edward Perkins and Edward Perkins of Bromsgrove upon trust for the income to be divided annually at Christmas among poor women of Hillmorton over the age of sixty years at the discretion of the Vicar. This gift was made in memory of:

Elizabeth Perkins born 27 June 1735 died 14 Aug. 1804

John Perkins born 26 June 1733 died 27 Aug. 1805

Edward Perkins died 31 July 1831 aged 63 years

Elizabeth Perkins born 21 Jan. 1780 died 12 Jan. 1857

whose graves are in the churchyard on the South side of the chancel, and with the desire that the same graves and tombstones thereon, and the inscriptions, may always be kept in good order and condition.

The font near the door of the church dates from the 1400's. The church itself has a history going back to 1250. In the side aisle, on the right facing the altar, are life sized effigies of Thomas and Edith de Astley who lived in the 14th century. They are forebears of Alice de Astley who is said to have married Thomas Perkins (ca 1475-1528), whose will directed that he "be buried in the Church of St. John the Baptist before the Rood". His wife Alice was also buried there. An old description of the church states that "In the middle Ile (sic) of this Church are two grave stones of marble, each of them having small portraitures in brass of a man and a woman, with divers children; on one of them is this Inscription:

Here lyeth Thomas Perkins and Alice and Elizabeth,  
Our Lord save their souls from everlasting death. Amen."

The Vicar explained that the church periodically underwent repair and restoration work, and during one of the repairs a new floor was installed. He was not certain if the new floor was laid over the old stone floor or if the old floor was removed first. In any case, all traces of the marble and brass memorials for Thomas and Alice Perkins are gone.

Dave and Ken each had an opportunity to visit with the local historial and genealogist Jim Perkins. They discussed the Perkins family tree and the fact that there was a record of the marriage of John Perkins and Judith Gater at Hillmorton, but that they were also reported to be on the records of Gloucestershire. He planned in the near future to search these records, and see just what they contained.

Both Dave and Ken reported how congenial everyone was, and that they had very thoroughly enjoyed themselves, and came back with a great deal of family information.

When I read of the possible duplication in records, I decided I had to do something about searching them myself. So I went over to the LDS Church Library and searched the Gloucestershire IGI microfiche. I also ordered the microfilm of the original records, which came this week. They were

impossible to read as they were in such poor condition, so they did not offer much help. We will just have to go with the IGI for now.

First I will report my findings on the Hillmorton Parish Records. When the microfilm of the original records of Warwickshire came, I examined them very carefully for the marriage of Michael Gater. The handwriting was very hard to read. It was very hard to distinguish just exactly what the first name of the wife of Michael Gater was, but comparing the name Elizabeth to other Elizabeths on the same page, the name is definitely not Elizabeth, and does look to me to indeed be Isabel.

Here are the some of the Perkins/Gater/Bailey/Sawbridge entries in the Hillmorton Parish Records of Warwickshire taken from the IGI Records.

JACOB PERKINS, WHO CAME FROM CANTERBURY, CT. 1779, WAS THE FIRST SETTLER OF THE WEST ROAD. HE MARRIED MARY FITCH, DAUGHTER OF JOSEPH FITCH, WHO HAD COME TO PAWLET FROM NORWICH, CT. THREE YEARS EARLIER. JACOB AND MARY RAISED A LARGE FAMILY, ALL OF WHOM, WITH MOST OF THEIR DESCENDENTS, HAD LEFT PAWLET BY 1867.

THE FAMILY HISTORY FROM HERE ON IS NOT AT PRESENT KNOWN, BUT IT IS KNOWN THAT THE PREMISES WERE SUBSEQUENTLY OWNED BY THE MERRITT WILLIAMS FAMILY (TWO GENERATIONS) AND IN 1942 WERE PURCHASED BY THE PRESENT OWNERS, REGINALD AND EVELYN PALMER.

THE ACTUAL DATE WHEN THE HOUSE WAS BUILT HAS NOT BEEN CONCLUSIVELY PROVED. HOWEVER, ALL RECORDS POINT TO THE FACT THAT THE MAIN HOUSE WAS BUILT BY JACOB PERKINS BY 1797 (PROBABLY EARLIER), AND THAT THE WING WAS ADDED AND SOME ALTERATIONS MADE LATER BY HIS SON, RUFUS.

JACOB PERKINS WAS THE FIRST SETTLER BURIED IN THE WEST PAWLET CEMETERY (MOUNTAIN VIEW), PRACTICALLY IN SIGHT OF THE HOUSE. HE WAS A REVOLUTIONARY SOLDIER, AND A FEW YEARS AGO THE DAR HAD A NEW HEADSTONE PLACED FOR HIM AND HIS WIFE. THE HEADSTONE OF RUFUS, HIS FIRST WIFE AND FOUR CHILDREN, AND HIS SECOND WIFE, SALINDA, MAY ALSO BE LOCATED IN THE SAME CEMETERY.

A FEATURE OF THE HOUSE, WHICH IS SOMEWHAT UNIQUE, IN THIS AREA, IS THE CURVED CEILING IN THE LARGE UPSTAIRS BEDROOM. THIS FEATURE IS FREQUENTLY FOUND IN CONNECTICUT HOUSES BUILT IN THE EIGHTEENTH AND EARLY NINETEENTH CENTURIES.

According to my mother, Ellen Theresa Perkins, her mother, Rose, had 12 children, three dying in infancy and another at a young age. The three who died very soon after birth were: Gertrude b. 1911, James b. 1919 in New Market, NH and Phyllis Anita whose date of birth is unknown. The other child to die young from that disease once dreaded by families with small children, Diphtheria, was Christina Iva born, 1915, in Rawlingsford, NH. The surviving children were: Mary b. 11-11-1905 in Lewiston, ME, Madeleine born in May 1907, Frederick b. 18-7-1909 in Glassville, N.B., Ellen Theresa b. 6-9-1913 at W. Chester, PA (married 22-4-1919 at Fulton, NY to Theodore Brassard), Ned born in Glassville, N.B., John b. 13-3-1920, Barbara, and Thomas. The last three children were all born at New Market, NH.

Harvey, the third son of Clara Harold and Gideon, never got married. He lived for some years in Auburn and in Lewiston, ME. In the later part of his life he lived in Fred-erickton, but is buried in the family plot at Centreville.

Watts Isaac, the son who was born in Maine, married Alice Pryor of Lakeville, N.B. they had six sons and four daughters: Harold of Presque Isle, ME; Howard who lived in New York State; Bryce, a college professor; Claude, a teacher; Eldon an engineer at the sub-marine base in Groton, CT; Peter, an engineer, lived in Wapping, CT; Clara, a nurse in Presque Isle; Ferne of Crouseville, ME; and Mary who lived in Connecticut.

Now we can return to Gideon to discuss his second marriage which is also recorded in a family Bible. It occurred on 18 December 1896 when he married Margaret Scarrah of Gordonsville. She was born on 14 August 1870 and died 28 August 1952. Her husband died on 9-10-1924. They are both buried in the same ground as his father, Isaac.

This second wife would add four more children to the family: William Wilbur b. 30-9-1897, Jack Roland b. 17-7-1900, Cecil Edward b. 2-6-1903, and Marguerite Ivy b. 18-8-1908.

Don't ever take just one persons' or sources' word for something. Check and double check. **Perkins Family**

Search on various PERKINS lines, and as with any research, I am sometimes is controversy concerning the maiden names of some of the wives. One of these controversies concerns the name of the wife of Sgt. Jacob Perkins, son of John Perkins, Sr. of Ipswich, MA. In order to help those of you who descend from this Jacob, I thought I would list here some of the references with the two names that have been given her.

Ref.: THE FAMILY OF JOHN PERKINS OF IPSWICH, MA, by George A. Perkins, M.D. Part I. page 18--in referring to Elizabeth the wife of Jacob Perkins--Footnote: "Possibly the daughter of Matthew Whipple," Part III, page 5, "Thomas Lovell, who was one of the first settlers of Ipswich and one of the leading men in the little colony, mentions in his will a 'daughter Elizabeth Perkins.' When Serg. Jacob Perkins gave to his two sons, Jacob and Matthew, deeds of gift of land at the time of their marriage, we find on each deed the name of Thomas Lovell as a witness."

Ref.: JOHN PERKINS, OF WELLS, MAINE, AND HIS DESCENDANTS 1583-1936, by Thomas Allen Perkins. Page 2, "Jacob --- married first, about 1648, Elizabeth Lovell, daughter of Thomas Lovell of Ipswich."

Ref.: NEW ENGLAND MARRIAGES PRIOR TO 1700, by Clarence Almon Torrey. Page 571, "PERKINS, Jacob (1624-1700) & 1wf Elizabeth [WHIPPLE] (ca 1629-1686; ca 1648; Ipswich."

Correspondence from both the Connecticut Nutmegger and New England Historic and Genealogical Society, both lean towards the premise that Sergt. Jacob Perkins married Elizabeth Whipple.

I am indebted to David L. Perkins of Sunnyvale for most of the above references concerning the wife of Jacob Perkins. I have a few other references, but they say basically the same as the above. I would welcome any correspondence in regards to this marriage, and will share it in the newsletter with other researchers. One correspondent has suggested the possibility that John Perkins, Jr.'s wife may have been Elizabeth Lovell. Any Comments? I have seen two other possible names for this Elizabeth, but we will go into this another time.
