COLLEGE PLACE - Wilma Alexine Perrin, 71, of 1023 Dove Lane died Jan. 25, 1998, at her home.

She met her future husband, Milford Perrin, in San Andreas, Calif., in January 1947. He had just returned from serving a tour of duty with the U.S. Army in Italy during World War II. They became engaged on May 21, 1947, and married July 6, 1947, in Lodi, and continued their education at PUC.

Mrs. Perrin was employed in nursing homes, taught typing and physical education, and was librarian at Sacramento (Calif.) Union Academy. She had worked in food service at Mt. Ellis Academy in Bozeman, Mont., and was director of food service at Far Eastern Academy, Singapore, from 1967 until 1981.

Mr. and Mrs. Perrin traveled to many countries pursuing their hobby of studying birds and mammals, as well as the people and their culture.

They retired in 1985 and moved to College Place at that time.

She was very involved with her church. She was devoted to her family.

Mrs. Perrin is survived by her husband at the home; a daughter, Eileen Stuart of College Place; three sons, Ralph Perrin of Redlands, Calif., Lloyd Perrin of Spokane and Keith Perrin of Riverside; two brothers, Luther Warner of Calumet, Calif., and Leonard Warner of Modesto, Calif.; and 14 grandchildren.
