THE JOSEPH RENCH FAMILY

There are many Fayette County connections within the RENCH family who lived just over the line in Bond County around the area of Pleasant Mound and Mulberry Grove. The bulk of the work is credited to Harold C. LEIDNER who compiled the material over a two year period, 1973 to 1975 and typed the manuscript in final form in 1981. Additional information has been added with source noted.

Joseph RENCH was born 15 Jul 1785 in Lancaster Co., PA d 8 Sep 1856. When a lad, he moved with his father to Darke Co., OH where later he married on 21 Aug 1811, Rhoda COATES who was born 29 Dec 1789 in South Carolina of Quaker parentage and died 12 Feb 1877. Both are buried in Maxey Cem., Pleasant Mound Twp., Bond Co., IL.

Around the year 1835, the family traveled through Bond County on their way to Missouri. They remained in Missouri for a year and in the spring of 1837 came to the Pleasant Mound area in Bond County. Joseph entered land in the NE 1/4 of Section 26 of Pleasant Mound Township. He worked as a teamster hauling freight to St. Louis.

Joseph and Rhoda helped organize the Hurricane Brethren (Dunkard) Church in the Fairview area; the first church services were held in their home. The congregation was able to build a church in 1844 and it stood on the northeast corner of what was known as the Roland BRITT farm. It was dismantled in 1907-8 and moved to Fairview.

Jacob CRIPE was born in Montgomery Co., OH. The CRIPE Family History says that Mary and Jacob became acquainted in Ohio as the families were on the road to Indiana. They married in South Bend, Indiana. Jacob and Mary appear on the 1840 Fayette County Census and later moved to Bond Co. where he owned a section of land southeast of Pleasant Mound. Here he built the Dunkard Church Later, this was moved to the village. Some of the family were first buried on the farm, but the stones later were taken up and buried in Noffsinger Cemetery.
