EARLY SETTLERS ON THE ROANOKE 1740-1760

90- "As in the Great Valley and on the upper branches of the James River early adventurers were home-seekers rather than explorers and land-grabbers...in the main, each newcomer took the next best location available and settled down to making the improvements necessary to perfect the title to his claims". ...Some staked off claims and then migrated to the South or West or returned to the more settled communities in the North or East." Militia Rolls give evidence of actual residence on the land:

91- CAPT. GEORGE ROBINSON'S CO. OF MILITIA (#8) 1742

(All lived South of the James River, a part on the branches of the James, and the rest on the Roanoke. We have here, then, the vanguard of the western migration of that period.)
