Book Reviews

IRELAND AND IRISH EMIGRATION TO THE NEW WORLD, From 1815 to the Famine, by William Forbes Adams. Published and Donated by Clearfield Company, Inc., 200 E. Eager St, Baltimore, MD 21202, (1932) repr. 1993, indexed, paper, 444 pp. Cost is \$32.50 plus \$3.00 P & H. Reviewed by Ida Troye.

A painstaking, thorough research of the economic, social and political factors underlying these years of emigration. Professor Adams succeeds in treating a complex subject in an exhaustive and engaging manner, placing the history of the Irish emigration on a firm, scholarly basis, weighing cause and effect. Taking in such subjects as the emigrant trade and government policy to the fruits of emigration. A more comprehensive study cannot be imagined.

Although it does not really fall into a genealogical study, it is certainly a study as to why the emigration took place and would be helpful in filling in a lot of questions we all ask.

The French Protestant contribution to the history of Ireland is very well documented, portraying their influence in trade, the professions and Irish social life. There are specific biographical and genealogical details concerning the more successful Huguenot families. A very detailed map includes the Huguenot settlements is included along with a very serviceable index to surnames.

A comprehensive look at the sources available both through the Church of Jesus Christ of the Latter Day Saints (LDS) Library (now called Family History Centers) and through the availability of the printed word. Includes a wonderful description of each source, i.e., Griffith's Valuation, Hearth Money Rolls, Tithe Applotment Books, etc. A good book for any Irish Genealogist's book shelf.

The Irish surname RILEY in all it's spellings is from RAGHALLACH - an Irish word meaning "sportive."

The O and the Mac prefix denote descent. Mac (son) indicated that the surname was formed from the personal name of the father. O names are derived from a grandfather or possibly an even earlier ancestor, o or ua being the Irish word for grandson or even male descendant.

Therefore, O'Raghailligh was the grandson of Raghallach, and in time the name was shortened to O'Raghaill.

RILEY / O'RILEY

John Riley was born in Vermont, ca 1788 (census). His name has been recorded as John O.Riley and John O'Riley. In the 1790 census there was a John Riley at Pawlet, VT, with 3 females in the household and in the town of Tinmouth, Rutland Co, VT, was a Lawrence Riley with young sons. Relationship to subject, if any is unknown. A possible brother could be Owen Riley who was grantee of a deed from John Riley of land near Plattsburgh, NY, Clinton Co, NY in 1831.

John Riley married Orpha Finch on Nov. 26, 1809 at the home of Stephen Finch at Chazy, Clinton Co, NH by Rev. Byington (Widow Pension record and Finch family record). Orpha Finch was born in 1794 in Southamptn, MA (pension record) however, it cannot be verified as Town Clerk of Southamptn advised that Vital Statistics prior to 1850 are missing. She was a daughter of Stephen and Mindwell Moore Finch of RI, CT, MA & NY, (see the Finch family record). After the death of her husband in 1866 at Louisville, St. Lawrence Co, NY, she lived with her son Pliney (1880 census) and died there in 1882.

Her gravestone was observed in 1972 at the Hamlet of Louisville on the west side of Grasse River in a well kept cemetery located behind a brick church. There is another cemetery adjacent behind a white frame church and another across the highway. The stones are all in good condition and upright; Orpha, wife of John O'Riley, died March 1, 1882, aged 88 years, along with those of John O'Riley died July 16, 1866 age 78 years and Martha Riley, wife of Eli Denio born in Alburg, VT, May 30, 1822, died April 9, 1885, 63 years. These graves were relocated in 1960 from nearby Louisville Landing cemetery which was flooded for the St. Lawrence Seaway.

After their marriage in 1809, John and Orpha lived in the area of Chazy, as he served from there in 1813 and 1814 during the 1812 War. Service record as follows. John O. Riley of Beckmantown, Clinton Co, purchased 31 acres of land on May 30, 1823 about 6 miles north of Plattsburgh, NY. He sold land there on Jan. 10, 1831 to Owen Riley.

Apparently in 1833 they were in the next adjacent westerly county at Bombay, Franklin Co. in 1833, as their 8 year old son Daniel was in school then (Daniel Riley Bible of Massena Historian), until about 1847.

John and Orpha Riley (farmers) were in the town of Louisville, St. Lawrence Co, NY in 1850 census and remained there on property which they purchased in 1847. John Riley made a will in 1862, he named his wife Orpha, a son Ralph and daughters Lucretia and Orpha. These three children, named in the will did not appear in the family group in the 1850-80 census. It appears they were older members of the family and were living away.

John O'Riley made a deposition on Jan. 18, 1853 at Plattsburgh, Clinton Co, NY applying for Bounty Land from his services in the War of 1812. At that time he said he was a resident of Louisville, St. Lawrence Co, NY and was 63 years of age. He stated he was drafted at Chazy, Clinton Co, NY Aug. 15, 1813 and mustered in at Plattsburgh and was stationed at Plattsburgh as a private in Capt. Septa Fillmore's Company of Militia commanded by Major Jo(?) Roberts in the War with Great Britain declared by United States on the 18th day of June 1812 and he was honorably discharged Nov. 18, 1813. Other war records state he enlisted the next year Aug. 21, 1814, a private in Capt. O. B. Vaughn's Company, NY and was taken prisoner Sept. 6, 1814 at Plattsburgh and after 5 days was taken to Chambly (Champlain?) and Oct. 1 ordered released. On this service his widow applied for a pension May 22, 1871 when she said she was 77. His pension record is WC 5147 War 1812, (author has copy).

My 3ggf Samuel O'NEAL married Charlotte RILEY sometime around 1798. They lived all their lives in the Barnwell County area of South Carolina. Samuel O'NEAL died in 1829. His wife Charlotte RILEY died in July 1849.

Miles RILEY, Sr. lived in the Barnwell County, SC area and his name is on an 1825 map of the County. Sometime after 1775 he married widow Elizabeth Weekly PARKER and she had one son by her former marriage named Joseph PARKER.
