Notes: These FAMILY RECORD pages were incredibly difficult to read with the blue ink nearly faded. All of these entries appear to be made with the same pen and the same hand. With my magnifying glass and light in hand, Selona's maiden name looks like McBOY, although someone with more experience deciphering old handwriting might think it something else. I also question the name Robbie under births, however, I wouldn't venture a guess. Regarding the death of Iva SALYERS; it looks to me as if they weren't sure, or the pen slipped. It could be 1891 or 1896. I believe it to be 1891.
