William SANFORD, Jr., served in the Rev. War. Records from the National Archives, show that he was drafted in 1775, as a private, in the Company commanded by Capt Isaac Cook of the Rhode Island Militia.

In 1776, he enlisted in the State Militia and continued to serve through 1779, under such officers as Captains Isaac Cook, Christopher Manchester and Benjamin Borden.

Sgt. William Sanford served at Taunton, Howland Ferry, Bristol Ferry, Little Compton, Trenton Shore, Fall River Mills and Newport Harbor. He was placed on Pension Rolls 4 Sept, 1833. Military Record #11351
