## INDEX TO THE OKLAHOMA INDIAN-PIONEER PAPERS

In the 1930s, the Works Progress Administration sponsored interviews with early pioneers and settlers of Oklahoma. These approximately 11,000 oral histories are on microfiche with complete collections located at the Oklahoma Historical Society, University of Oklahoma Libraries and McFarlin Library/The University of Tulsa. These oral histories were obtained by government employees interviewing pioneers and settlers all across Oklahoma and focuses on living conditions, daily life and experiences during the settlement of Oklahoma and Indian Territories. For a fee, copies of these interviews can be obtained from the entities with a copy of the complete collection.
