STATE OF NORTH-CAROLINA, ] Timer and Lowis Servones thefe prefents, that we Channet , are held and firmly bound unto Nathanel alerander Elquire, Governor, &c. or his Succeffors in Office, . in the full Sum of Five Hundred Pounds, Current Money, to be paid to the faid Governor, his Succeffors, or Affignz, for the which Payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourfelves, our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators. jointly and feverally, firmly by thefe prefents, fealed with our Seals, and dated this 2710 Day of May Anno Domini 1800 THE Condition of the above-Obligation is fuch, that whereas the above bounden Plasant Sor once hath made Application for a Licence for a Marriage to be celebrated between him and Elimbeth Haker of the County aforefaid: Now, in Cafe it fhall not appear hereafter, that there is any lawful Caufe or Impediment to obstruct the faid Marriage, then the above Obligation to be void : otherwife to remain in full Force and Virtue.
