Carolyn J. CEARLOCK of Decatur, Illinois has sent a copy of the marriage license of Pleasant SCRIVNER/SCRIBNER and his wife, Elizabeth HANES from Wake Co., NC to help clear up the confusion as to her maiden name.

Carolyn writes, "Please note 'SCRIVNER' is written 3 times. In each, the "r" has a square top and the "n" has a rounded top. In Elizabeth's surname, there is only a rounded top letter, as an "n" - not 2 square "r's".

Know all Men by these presents, that we Pleasant Scrivner and Lewis Scrivner are held and firmly bound unto Nathaniel Alexander

Esquire, Governor, &c. or his Successors in Office, in the full Sum of Five Hundred Pounds, Current Money, to be paid to the said Governor, his Successors, or Assigns, for the which Payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our Seals, and dated this 27th Day of May Anno Domini 1876

THE Condition of the above-Obligation is such, that whereas the above bounden Pleasant Scrivner hath made Application for a Licence for a Marriage to be celebrated between him and Elizabeth Hanes of the County aforesaid: Now, in Case it shall not appear hereafter, that there is any lawful Cause or Impediment to obstruct the said Marriage, then the above Obligation to be void: otherwise to remain in full Force and Virtue.
