Extracts from family bible of Ralph Wells Shepard, who was born in Herkimer, New York, November 10, 1806, son of Silas and Anna (White) Shepard.

Silas Shepard was born Dec. 2, 1779; and died in Herkimer County New York January 19, 1863. His wife, Anna, took the remains of her husband to Freedom, Portage County Ohio, for burial. The younger generation of Shepards lived at Freedom.

Ralph Wells Shepard's first wife was his first cousin. It is said that Julia A. Pettibone, his second wife, was of Salisbury, Connecticut.

M 4. JAMES² SHEPHERD (James¹), born at Wiscasset, Maine, about 1761, died at Jefferson, Maine, 23 July 1818; married Mary Pressey of Alma, Maine, who died 8 Feb. 1843.

He applied for a pension 9 May 1818, aged 56; his brother William made affidavit supporting his claim. His widow Mary applied 15 May 1843, aged 82, giving her maiden name as Pressey. [Pension File.] If date is correct, her date of death in the family account is wrong.
