Newton Howard SHIELDS died at Albert Lea, Minn., in 1919, and is buried there. A bachelor.

Almarado GREENWOOD, husband of Aima (SHIELDS) GREENWOOD, passed away in 1945. Two sons.

Rolla R. SHIELDS passed away in Los Angeles, California, Sept. 5, 1960. Is buried in the family plot by his wife and sons. She passed away April 26, 1924. Eleven children.

William H. SHIELDS passed away at Mason City, Iowa, May 25, 1963. Buried at Britt, Iowa, in the family plot by his wife who passed away in 1945. Seven children to this union.
