REV. E. A. SILVERNAIL DIES AT PALMYRA-

Norwich, N.Y. - Feb. 1948 - The Rev. Eatus Andrew Silvernail, 70, Methodist minister at several Southern Tier churches, died Feb. 28, in Palmyra, Pa.

Rev. Silvernail entered the ministry in 1918 at Onaquaga, N.Y. He joined the Wyoming Conference in 1921. After that he served in the following locations: East Worcester, Mt. Upton, Harpurville, N.Y. and Cherry Ridge, Lakeville, Jackson, Sterling, Carley Brook and Clifford, Pa. He retired in 1940.

He was born Oct. 21, 1877 in the Town of Fitcher, the son of Joseph and Elizabeth Silvernail. He married Mary Steward, Plymouth, on June 1, 1904. His wife died in Feb. 1928. He later married Viola Wolfe, Palmyra, who survives. Other survivors include three children of his first marriage: -Vyrat Silvernail of Plymouth; Ivon Silvernail of Windsor; Mrs. Ardith (Silvernail) Harris, Chatham, N.J.

Five sisters survive: Mrs. Hattie Oliver, Herkimer; Mrs. Lucetta Gently, Cincinnatus; Mrs. Maud Marvin of Cincinnatus; Mrs. Eva Elsworth, Fitcher; Mrs. Carrie Twitchell, Fitcher.

Lewis Silvernail, a brother, of North Norwich, also survives as well as eight grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held Mar. 2, at 1 P.M. at the Methodist Church, Norwich. Dr. George Savige and Rev. Thomas Swales will officiate. The body will be placed in Mt. Hope vault awaiting burial in South Plymouth in the Spring.
