

JOHN SHRYOCK

John Shryock b. 1705 in Germany, came to America with two brothers, Jacob and George on the ship "Hope" from Rotterdam landing at Philadelphia on Aug. 28, 1733. Were of Lutheran religion. Lived first west of the Susquehanna R. near Yorktown which in 1749 was made York Co. Pa. Later they migrated to Elizabethtown (Hagerstown) Frederick Co. Md. On Aug. 2, 1736 he m. Susanna Kern in Lancaster Co Pa. She was b Dec. 6, 1713 d at York, Pa. Feb. 10, 1750.

Children:

I. (John) Leonard Shryock b Jan. 2, 1738, d Feb. 2, 1782 m Margaret Streiter, dau of Lutheran minister Rev. John Philip Streiter and Anna Julianna Wittman (Whitmer). The Philip Whitmers came on same ship to America with the Shryocks. Leonard Shryock served in the French & Indian War. After the War he sank the first tanyard at his homestead "TODDY" near Hagerstown, Md. He served in the Rev. War as a 2nd Lieut. in his bro-in-law's Company - Capt. Michael Fackler, Margaret Streiter and Leonard were m in 1765 at Hagerstown, and all his children were b there:

1. Henry Shryock b Dec 1766 m his cousin Susan Shryock, dau of John and Mary (Teagarden) in 1790. They were among the first settlers in Indiana Co., Pa. The names of marriages into this family are: WOODS, WOODWARD, CARPENTER, WICK, HALL, RUSSELL.

2. Catherine Shryock b 1773 m William Doty

3. John Shryock b Oct. 17, 1771 d Oct. 5, 1856 at Chambersburg, Pa. m/1 Rachel Aston, m/2 Martha Cochran. Had 20 children: Names of marriages into this family - KNIGHT, BATES, BURR, WM. F. FLORY, KEAGY, HICKS, STEVENSON, SLOAN, SCOTT.

4. Mary Shryock b 1775 married a DIELTY.

5. Susanna Shryock b 1769 d Oct 1, 1819 m John Johns.

6. Elizabeth Shryock b 1779 d Apr. 7, 1854 m Thomas Johns. (These two Johns men were bros and the prominent Johns family who started the Johns-Hopkins Hospital. Both were doctors.

7. Michael Shryock b about 1781 d 1811. Was a sea-faring man. Never married.

II. Michael Shryock b July 2, 1740 m Rosina Kraftin, lived in Loudoun Co. Va. d about 1833. According to his Will his children were: Samuel Shryock, George Shryock, Elizabeth, Susanna, Nancy, Rosanna m a Harned, Elenor m Chas. Moffett, Margaret m Ezra Fox.

III. Anna Barbara Shryock b Sept 22, 1741 d Apr. 23, 1752

IV. Helena Shryock b April 22 1743 m Capt. Michael Fackler. No trace of their children except a Mary Fackler m William Lewis and their dau Elizabeth Lewis m George Shryock, son of John and Rachel (Aston) Shryock.

V. John Jacob Shryock b 1745. ?

VI. John (Johannes) Shryock b Sept. 15, 1747 m Mary Tea garden He d in Westmoreland Co. Pa. 1831. Their children:

1. Susan Shryock m her cousin Henry Shryock. She was b 1770

2. Maria Shryock b Feb 27, 1772 d Nov 11, 1851 m Samuel Beeler.

3. Elizabeth Shryock b Feb. 3, 1774 d Feb. 3, 1835 m John Jamison

4. John Shryock b Mar. 24, 1776 d Oct 11, 1859 m/1 Jane Conway, m/2 Jean Graham

5. Ellen Shryock b May 27, 1778

- 8. Daniel Shryock b Sept. 13 1786 d 1872 in Meadville m Elizabeth McNamara
- 9. David Shryock b 1791 m Sarah Ann Wilson d Sept. 21, 1856.
- 10. Samuel Shryock 1793 d 1878 m Martha Shackelford. Lived at St. Louis, Mo.

After the death of Susannah Kern Shryock, wife of the immigrant John Shryock in 1750, he m Sabina Wolf, a sister to Barbara Wolf who m John's bro. Jacob Shryock. John and Sabina (Wolf) Shryock had one son:

Christian Shryock b May 26, 1754 m Phoebe Kline at Lancaster Co., Pa Dec. 8, 1774, moved to Bedford Co., Pa, then to Ross Co., Ohio in 1819, then to Fulton Co., Ind. in 1831. They had a son, John Jacob b 1784 m Susanna Lawhead. Their Children:
