In the space below give interesting fact of life of pioneer—i. e., where he lived before coming to California or the Middle West; when he arrived; the route and method by which he came; what his business was and other facts of importance.

W. O. Stafford came to California from Missouri in 1849, crossing the plains by ox-team. He and two others were separated from the company and arrived in Sacramento after going seventy-two hours without food. He settled in Placerville, commonly called in those days Hangtown, and entered into the business of placer mining. Did not make much of a success at this, and later went into the bakery and butcher business for a short time. In 1853 he returned to Missouri by oxteam where he married Mary Hall Pursh, returning the same year, and settled in Petaluma, Sonoma Co. where he entered into partnership with John Tritsch and conducted a wagon making and blacksmith business until 1873. His first wife died in 1869 and he married Amanda J. Harmon in 1870. In 1873 he moved his family to Santa Ana, and settled on land purchased by himself, John Tritsch and Columbus Tustin. This tract of land comprised 135- $\frac{9}{10}$ acres, at a price of \$500, lying between First St. & W. T. Fadden St., Santa Ana, on the north and south, & between Main St., Santa Ana, on the west, and the San Joaquin Rancher on the east. The records show that this purchase was made Aug. 27th 1868, and title confirmed by the United States District Court Sept. 12th 1868.

These Staffords are not direct descendants of A 1 or B 1 Thomas but since they were present in New England at the same time it is necessary to include them in this index to keep things in order.

William Stafford (brother) of A 1 Thomas came to Virginia on ship Furtherance in 1622. His history and descendants are well covered in the Laban Stafford Genealogy and additional coverage is found in the Deal - Stafford Genealogy and the Jarvis Stafford book. They are not indexed in this book. They will be included in a future index.

This work does include the Col. Joab Stafford data as well as all of the New England and Rhode Island classics that could be found. The Westcott and Cleveland data is also included.

who married FRANCIS THORNTON.

His birth date is given as 1651 so something is haywire.

This leads to the question; Could she have had a brother, son of Humphrey, who could have been the father of A 3 JANE of Barbados, A 1 THOMAS of Rhode Island and A 2 WILLIAM of Virginia.

A 3 - JANE STAFFORD # (evidently an older sister) was on board the same ship that brought A 2 WILLIAM to Va. but she went on to the Barbados. (Probably to be married there).

A 2 - WILLIAM STAFFORD - b Warwickshire, Eng 1606 - came to Jamestown, Va at the age of 16, as a ward or servant of Francis Mason, on the ship "FURTHERANCE".

It is reported that he made his home at Elizabeth City, and in 1639 or 40 married FRANCES MASON, youngest dau of FRANCIS.

FRANCES was born in 1623 so would have been only 16 or 17 at the time of her marriage. WILLIAM would have been 33 or 34.


One son was born of this marriage -

B 100 - WILLIAM (II). The mother dying at his birth in 1641/2.

It is also reported that William (I) then married ANNE MASON, an older daughter of FRANCIS, who was born in 1610 in Eng. This marriage is reported to have taken place in 1643/44. She would have been 33 and he 37.

WILLIAM (I) appears to have died suddenly in 1643/44 as we have an inventory of his estate dated 3 March 1644. (Valued in bunches of tobacco.) Now it would make more sense to me if William (I) had married at a normal age of 21 or 22 to Anne who would then have been 17 or 18; and later married Frances/????

Also Dr. G.M.G. Stafford in his "House of Stafford" says "II WILLIAM STAFFORD, SON OF THE above, settled in Stafford County, Va. where he married and had two children. His sons William and John moved to North Carolina." This I think is an unjustified assumption. From "The Masons of Virginia" by Kent Sagendorph - 1947. "Col George Mason laid out and named Stafford County Va after his old home town in Staffordshire, Eng." No records of any Stafford presence have been found in this county until many generations later.



A 5 - William Stafford, whom I estimate to have been born about 1610, with wife REBECCA lived in Warwick River County (now Newport News) and "claimed" 300 acres on Kethes Creek with a son or relative. In 1634.

B 102 - CHRISTOPHER STAFFORD (b est 1631)

A 2 and A 5 could very well have been the same WILLIAM.

B 105 - PETER STAFFORD (b est 1632) Parents unknown. Evidently an immigrant, but possibly a brother of Christopher settled in Gloucester Co (Just to the North) in 1653. See "Cavaliers & Pioneers - Va Land Patents. Pg 280.

B 100 - WILLIAM STAFFORD II b 1641/2 must have been brought up by relatives. "Laban" says he resided in York Co Va adjoining Yorktown and Williamsburg. He died in Currituck, the most North Easterly county of N.C. where his son had gone. d 17 Feb 1728. From various sources I have his wife's name as Jean (Brown and their children See "Laban" Pg 36. Jane)






It was indeed a pleasure to hear from you again.

Acknowledging your favor of the 18th inst.

I am afraid I can be of little assistance to you regarding the genealogy of the Stafford Family. My father's name was Nelson C. Stafford and he was born in Vermont April 2nd 1828. His father's name was Job Stafford and he was born in 1798. My father's peoples were very poor and he went to Missouri where, only a lad to try and find employment to help support the family. Father came to California in 1849 at the age of 21 during the gold rush. He was working at Petaluma, Calif on July 2 - 1862, and Father moved his family to Santa Ana in 1873 when he was 11 years old. I remember Father telling of trying to trace his family tree when he was only a boy, more than 65 years ago. He wrote a number of letters to Lerkont and in reply to one he received a letter from an old aunt reciting a most pitiful story about having nothing. Father sent her twenty dollars and they gave up his research work in disgust. He has a brother who has traveled a great deal and he made it a point when he was in Vermont to try and find out something about our ancestors. He found that there ~~was~~ two lines of Stafford's and that one line had nothing to do with our family. He did not think it worthwhile to keep these records. Very sorry I can't help you


