JOHN BRYANT ENTREKIN

John Bryant Entrekin indicated at the time of the 1850 census that he was born in Georgia in 1801. According to tradition he followed his wife's family from Georgia to Hancock Co., Miss. They must have married about 1819 and were probably living in the house of her father John Stanford in Hancock Co. in 1820. John Bryant Entrekin's wife was Matilda Stanford. She was born on the 5th of July 1801, also in Georgia. She was the daughter of John Stanford who was born in Maryland, 15 Jan. 1778 and his wife Delila Ruark who was born June 1779, also in Maryland. They married 20 Sep. 1798. The Stanfords moved from Maryland to Georgia sometime between 1799 and 1801. It is my belief that John Stanford's father was probably Joshua Stanford who reputedly was born 1740 in "Chesapeake Co.", Md. and whose will is recorded as being signed May 1825 and probated 4 May 1826 in Warren Co., Ga. and lists sons: Joseph, Levi, John, Joshua and Levin. In 1805 William Entrekin who I believe to be the father of John Bryant Entrekin participated in a land lottery in Columbia Co., Ga. which was adjacent to Warren Co at that time.

In 1830 John Bryant Entrekin is living in Marion Co., Miss. and he is still listed there in 1840. However, a son born in 1843 listed his birthplace, according to descendants, as Jackson Co., Miss. John Bryant Entrekin is indeed recorded in Jackson Co., Miss in the 1850 census as is his second son William Bryant Entrekin. The transcripts of the Jackson Co. Tract books show that John B. Entrekin was the assignee on 40 acres in 1852, being the E½ of the NW¼ of Section 5, Township 7 South, Range 7 West. I have not found any record of John Bryant Entrekin in 1860. One possibility is that he may have lived in Hancock Co. since the 1860 Hancock Co. census is missing. It is not known when he died but tradition states that he died about 1865. His wife Matilda lived on and family records show that she died 3 April 1870 in Jackson Co., Miss. John and Matilda had the following children:

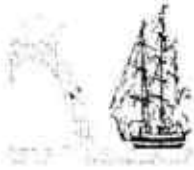

Ohio was part of Virginia from 1728 to 1803. Illinois was in Virginia between 1781 and 1792. Indiana was too from 1782 to 1816. Kentucky was in Virginia from 1775 to 1792. Part of Maryland was in Virginia from 1775 to 1792, part of North Carolina was from 1728 to 1803 and West Virginia was from 1728 to 1863.

**SEAMAN'S PROTECTION CERTIFICATE:** If your ancestor went to sea in the 1800's, he may have applied for a Seaman's Protection Certificate to protect him from imprisonment by Great Britain and other powers. This program lasted from 1796 to 1897. The applicant presented proof of citizenship and paid a 25 cent fee. Every 3 months a list of seamen was sent to the Secretary of State, giving each seaman's age and physical description. Write the Archives Division, National Archives & Records, Washington, DC 20408.
