OF
THE NAME
STESKAL

Steskal
The surname STESKAL, with its variant spellings of Steskel, Steckal, Steyskal, Stejskal, Steiskal, Steckel, Steskal, and Stecke, seems to be the old German surname of "Steckel" Zum Schwarzberg auf Judendorff from Bavaria, a Kingdom of Southern Germany, the second in area and population of the states of the German Empire. The name means "Dweller" or "near a steep incline". Schwarzburg is a village in Schwarzburg-Rudolstadt, Germany. It is a tourist center and contains the princely castle of Schwarzburg. "Judendorff" comes from the town Judenburg, Germany.

Chapter I John Steskal Family

Johann Styskal (John Steskal) was born in Dasterich, Austria, on August 28, 1838. His parents are unknown, but his mother's given name was Dora, a good woman. Johann married Josepha (Josephine) nee Betnach who was born on August 11, 1841 at Gros Siegharth, Austria. Her parents are unknown.

Johann and Josepha were married in Austria in 1861. Nine children were born while living in Austria, namely:

Agnes, born December 25, 1862

Teresa, born 1864; at the age of 12 years died and was buried in Austria.

Leopoldine (Tena), born November 9, 1866

Mary, born November 1, 1873

Leopold (Lee), born April 8, 1877

Four children born and died in infancy (no record).

Johann didn't want his son, Leopold, to have to join the German Army so about 1878, he brought his little family to America. They had to sail across the Atlantic in the lowest deck of the ship because of their meager financial circumstances. They came to David City, Butler County, Nebraska. Johann had an older brother, Antone, who came here earlier.

While living here, two more children were born:

Jennie, on May 22, 1879

Josephine, born on April 23, 1882

In 1883, in a wagon drawn by a team of oxen, John came to Holt County in company of his son-in-law, Henry Winkler. They wanted to take advantage of the free Homestead Act, so came to O'Neill, Holt County. Johann applied for a claim on a homestead ten miles northwest of O'Neill; the Northwest quarter of Section 29, Township 30, Range 12, 160 acres which was patented June 29, 1891.

The homestead was a bare tract of ground. A kind neighbor, John Heeb, took the family in until a house could be built. An open well was dug first, then a house was moved from Stuart, Nebraska. This house stood until 1971, when it was torn down.

Two more children were born on this farm:

Susanna (Susie), born June 12, 1884

Edward, born September 18, 1885

The farm was sold in 1910, and Johann and Josepha moved to Atkinson, Holt County, Nebraska. They took a few chickens, a cow and a horse with them. They often drove out to the country with their single horse hitched to a single seated top buggy, especially in the summertime.

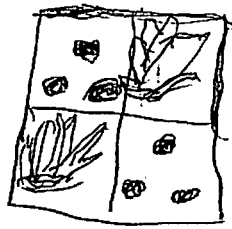
In 1911, they celebrated their Golden Wedding Day. Most of their children attended along with a large number of the grandchildren.

Johann Stejskl or Johan Stejske was admitted to citizenship on August 22, 1887; his former allegiance, Austria. Witnesses were Henry Winkler and Philip Bausch. Recorded in District Court of Holt County, O'Neill, Nebraska.

Josepha delivered babies and laid out the dead in the neighborhood. She had a sister Mary and a brother (name unknown) in this country.

Johann died March 28, 1912 and Josepha died day 26, 1925. Both are buried in St. Joseph's Cemetery in Atkinson, Holt County, Nebraska.

Chapter II Henry Winkler Family

Steskal, Agnes, the oldest daughter of John and Josephine Steskal, was born December 25, 1862 in Gros Sieghart, Austria, came with her parents to United States in 1878, and then to David City, Nebraska. Agnes found employment by a merchant in Crete, Nebraska to assist his wife in the home. At the Catholic Church in Abie, Nebraska, the Steskal family met Henry Winkler and since all spoke German, they became friends.

On December 25, 1881, at Abie, Butler County, Nebraska, Agnes married Henry Winkler, son of Joseph Winkler and wife, Susanna nee Keilman; born October 22, 1849 at Darmstadt, (Hessen) Germany. Two children were born to them in Butler County:

Anna, born April 16, 1882

Susanna, born August 22, 1883.

In 1883, in a wagon drawn by a team of oxen, Henry Winkler and his father-in-law, John Steskal, drove toward Holt County to take advantage of the land being offered for homesteading. After two or more weeks of travelling at the rate of approximately ten miles per day, John sighted smoke on the horizon and shouted the news that unbelievably people were living here in this wildness. Reaching the origin of the smoke, they found themselves at the dwelling of the John Heeb family; German speaking people from Switzerland.

Henry Winkler received his final papers of citizenship from Hon. M. P. Kincaid, Judge and author of the land grant bill. Homesteading procedure and later timber claim were filed and gave the families a place to live.

In 1908, Henry and Agnes moved to a small tract of land on the outskirts of east Atkinson that they purchased. They rented out their country farm. While living in their Atkinson home, they took in a foster daughter, Theresa Geis, born January 10, 1912 in New York.

Henry died on December 22, 1928 and Agnes died on May 5, 1935. Both are buried in St. Joseph's Cemetery, Atkinson, Holt County, NE.
