THE TOWNSEND FAMILY

Our first ancestor of the Townsend family in America was Joseph Townsend, who came to our shores in 1711, first settling at Abington, Pennsylvania, later at Concord and finally at Chester. He was the son of William Townsend, a son of Richard. William was of Bucklebury, England. He married Mary Lawrence in 1683, and died in 1692.

This surname formerly "the town's end" from a residence there, has various forms in The Hundred Rolls, such as Ate-Towneshand; Ate Tunesend; Ate Tunishende, etc. The name, though of escentially plebian origin, emerged, according to Lower's "Patronymica Britannica" from the ignoble vulgus at an early period after its adoption being traced to the year 1377, in gentle degree at Snoring Magna, County Norfolk, England.

WITH TOWNS IND.

VILLIAM TOVASEND, of Bucklebury, England, believed to have been a brother of Richard Townsend an intimate friend and fellow traveller with William Penn on
the "Velcome", was a corpensor by trade, and was held in
esteem by his seighbors. He was twice married, first, on
the twenty-eighth day of the Eleventh Month, 1679, to
Jane Smith, who probably did not live long after her marriage, as William Townsend was married again on the first
of the Second Month, 1683, to Mary Lowrence, of Little
Coxwell, at Maringdon Magna, County Berks, England. She
was the mother of his four children, the eldeat of whom
was Joseph Townsend who came to Pennsylvania bearing a
Certificate of Removal from the Monthly Meeting at Newbury in Berkshire, England, dated the fifteenth day of
the Eleventh Month, 1711.

Nothing further appears of record in connection with Hary lawrence. William Townsend died in 1692, and was buried at Bucklebury on the ninteenth day of the Fifth Honth in that year, if the date has been correctly stated.

JOSEPH TOWNSEND

JOSEPH TOWNSEND, the eldest son of William
Townsend of Bucklebury, England, by his second wife, Mary
Lawrence, was born the eighteenth day of the Eleventh
Month, 1684, and was, therefore, about eight years old
at his father's death. He lived for a number of years
with Oliver Sansom, a friend of the family, and a valued
and respected follower of the doctrines of George Fox.

On the 29th of September, 1699, at the age of fifteen, he was bound apprentice to a weaver, - Jonathan Sargood, - for a period of seven years, when he established himself in that trade.

On the twenty-seventh of the Ninth Month, 1710 he was married to Martha Wooderson, the daughter of Julian and Esther Wooderson. She was born the eighteenth of the Ninth Month, 1683, and died the second of Third Month, 1767. They were active in the Society of Friends, and they, with his sister Jean, received a Certificate of Removal from the Monthly Meeting of Friends at Newbury, in Berkshire, England, under date of the fifteenth day of Eleventh Month, 1711, which was presented to Abington Monthly Meeting, Pennsylvania, of which his uncle, Richard Townsend, friend of William Penn, was a member.

They did not however, permanently reside at Abington, as they submitted on the eleventh of Second Month 1715, a Certificate from Abington to Concord Meeting, and on the first of Sixth Month 1720, from the latter Monthly Meeting to Chester. Here they remained for a while, both he and his wife taking an active part in the meeting, and were both overseers. They later returned to Abington, bearing a Certificate dated the twenty-sixth of Seventh Month, 1725.

On the 21st of October, 1725, "Joseph Townsend, weaver, of Bristol Township, Pennsylvania," signed articles of Agreement with John Wanton, of Newport, Rhode Island, for the conveyance to the former of eight hundred acres of land in East Bradford, Chester County, Pennsylvania, The price was forty pounds per hundred acres, to be paid in three installments. One hundred pounds on the 21st of October, 1726, One hundred pounds upon signing the Agreement, and the remainder on the 21st of October, 1727. The deeds or lease and release were executed on the sixth

and seventh of September, 1727, and once again the subject of our eketch removes with his family, with a Certificate from Chester to Concord Monthly Meeting, the third of Bleventh Month, 1725. From which time Joseph and Eartha Townsend were active and respected members of Birmingham Meeting.

Joseph Townsend died the minth day of the Fourth Month, 1766, and was buried at Birmingham, where his vidow followed him the second day of the Third Month, 1767. His will is dated 16th of Fifth Month, 1766, and was proven on the twenty-second of September, 1766. He provides for his wife Martha, the plantation whereon he lately duelt in East Bradford containing about 165 acres, and for the maintednance of his son William.

JOHN TOWNSEND

The fourth child and third son of Jospph and Martha (Wooderson) Townsend, was John Townsend, of East Bradford, Chester County, Pennsylvania. He was born the second day of Twelfth Month, 1716, and inherited his father's plantation of one hundred twenty-one acres upon the death of his mother in 1767.

On the thirty-first day of Twelfth Month, 1741 he married Joanna, the eldest daughter of Joseph England by his wife Margaret Orbell. She was born at Burton-on-Trent, England, the twenty-ninth day of Seventh Month, 1721, and bore her husband ten children, the best known probably, being her son Joseph Townsend of Baltimore, Maryland.

A writer gives the following account of Joseph and Joanna, the father and the wife of John Townsend:"Joanna Townsend was an intelligent, old fashioned English woman, with much energy of character and a determined will of her own. Her son Joseph inherited a full share of his mother's tenacity of purpose, with a tinge of quaint eccentricity, derived from his father's side of the house, but withal, he was a most actively useful philanthropic and exemplary man. His family were all desciples of George Fox, and Joseph himself was one of the strictest of the sect."

John Townsend died the eighteenth day of the Eighth Month, 1803, and his wife Joanna (nee England) having predeceased her husband on the thirtieth day of the Fifth Month, 1786.
