That prior to Enlistment he had lived near and had been intimately acquainted with Said HENRY WEBB and by reason of his intimate and frequent association with him knows for a certainly that prior to and at the time of his enlistment in said Company & Regiment in the Autumn of 1861, that he was a Sound and very Stout man and had every tangible indication of living to a great age; that Affiant was a member of Same Company Enlisting about the Same time and Serving together; knows that the Soldier was Stout and hearty, did his duty faithfully and cheerfully until about March 1862, while the Company was quartered at Buffalo Mountain, same Co., W.Va. the Soldier appeared to have contracted a deep seated cold (resulting from the exposures incident to our Camp life) which settled upon his lungs judging by a Cough he had & Complaining of his Chest, it appeared to be Seated throughout his entire system, his flesh became swollen especially his feet & legs and know that the Soldier continued thus feeble and complaining or aforesaid (doing but little duty) during the remainder of his term of Service seemed to be dragging out the most gloomy despondent state of existence and after his discharge he did not live long, he died as near as He now remembers sometime about the first of July 1865, there is no doubt in his mind about his death being the result of his diseases aforesaid contracted in the Service in the line of his duty and further declares that he is not related to the claimants nor interested in the prosecution of the claim for pension.

WEBB, when acquaintance aforesaid begain had every appearance of a sound healthy stout heavy square-built man, and was so reputed by his more intimate acquaintances i.e., a stout man, while at Buffalo, W.Va. about Feb or Mch 62, WEBB aforesaid Seemed to have contracted a deep seeted cold, began coughing, grew thin and pale, looked feeble and complained much and so continued up to 8th June 62. Affiant was with Company none after, but from representations of comrades is Satisfied that WEBB aforesaid continued almost an invalid until he dragged out his term of Enlistment. Affiant met MR. WEBB about Feb or Mch 1865 after his discharge on Fields Creek in Kanawha Co, W.Va., who was coughing and barely able to walk with a staff, and did not think he could live long and further declare[s] that he has no interest in said case and is not concerned in its prosecution further than an anxiety that Justice may be done for RUSSEL WEBB and VIRGINIA CANTERBERRY, Soldiers surviving children, that their present PO address is Dry Creek, Raleigh Co, W.Va.



THE WEBB FAMILY

John Webb, the forefather of the Webb family, was born and lived in England during his lifetime, probably in Warwickshire, or Derbyshire. He served in armed forces in India and Ireland. No record has been found of his birth of death dates, or locations. His son, Samuel Webb, Sr. was born in Warwickshire, England, on Dec. 28, 1837, and was married to Sarah Rodgers, of Bilston, Staffordshire. England, on Oct. 9, 1859. Through correspondence in early 1950's, with the husband of Sarah Rodgers sister, a Charles Cousins, of North Chesterfield, Derbyshire, we know that the Webbs lived in or near Clay Crosse, Derbyshire, and left from there, in 1880 to go to America. First Sam Jr. and Many Jane came over with their father; the mother, Sarah, and the rest of the children came at a later date, on the ship Illinois, landing at Philadelphia, and settling in Shamokin, Pa. then Houghdale, Pa. Afew years later they moved to Edwards Station, Ill. and Richmond, No., the latter place where the men worked in the coal mines. In 1884 they moved to Seymour, Iowa. Charles Cousins was a minister in the Church of the Latter Day Saints, and came to America as a delegate to the Church Conferences in Missouri, in 1935 and in 1947, and visited with the Webbs on both occasions.

Shortly after the Webbs arrived in America, there was a sovere epidemic of smallpox in Pennsylvania, and Jimmy, who was an infant at that time, succumbed to the disease there. Two other children, both boys, died in infancy, and to date, no record has been found. Themas Alfred, the youngest son, was the only child of this family born in America.

Most of the men members of this large family were musicians and played in the Chicago Coal Miners Co. Band, at Seymour, Iowa, and later in bands in their communities; descendents have been or are in the music profession, as teachers or band leaders. Dr. Karl Webb was head of the Music Dept. at Missouri State Teacher's College at Kirksville, Mo. until his retirement.
