Records taken from a Bible owned by William Crittenden Webb.

Published in Edinburg. Printed by the Assigns of Alexander Kincaid, His Majesty's Printer, MDCCLXXXV. This bible belongs now to the heirs of Dr. William Webb.

William Crittenden Webb and Jan Vivion, his wife, was married on Tuesday, the 23rd day of February in the year 1762 and we lived together 21 years and 2 days. Then she departed this life on Wednesday the 25th of February 1783, and in the 43rd year of her age.

John Vivion Webb was born the 11th of July in the year of 1765

Franky Vivion Webb was born the 21st day of December 1767

William Crittenden Webb was born the 20th day of April 1769

Thacker Webb was born the 27th of December in 1772

Garland Webb was born the 19th of April in 1775

Charles Webb was born the 20th of January in 1778

Wyatt Webb was born the 24th of July in the year 1781 and departed this life the 5th day of October 1813 in Sumpterville District, South Carolina in the 33rd year of his life.

Garland Webb departed this life the 22nd of August, 1814 at Aylotte(?) Warehouse, King William County, Virginia in the 40th year of his life.

Augustine Webb departed this life on the 9th day of October 1827 at his home in the County of Orange in the 76th year of his life.

Thacker Webb departed this life on the 2nd day of August, 1843 at home in the County of Orange in the 71st year of his life.

William Crittenden Webb departed this life on the 27th of November 1845 in the County of Orange in the 77th year of his life.

On Saturday the 11th day of July 1789 William C. Webb and Fanny Wortham, daughter of Maurice Smith of Middlesex was married.

**Supposedly born in Tennessee circa 1865 around Chattanooga area but listed his birth year as 1870 on his marriage license to Jeanetta Bell SPENCE in 1904 Conway Co. Ark. He may have lived with or near her family in Mississippi or North Carolina before moving to Arkansas then to Pontotoc Co., OK. He was supposed to be the son of John, James or William (Bill) BROOKS and Elizabeth THOMPSON, daughter of William Henry THOMPSON, a plantation owner in Tennessee. However, on his 1965 Social Security Application he listed his parents as Bill BROOKS and Elizabeth WHITSON. No record of his birth. He supposedly ran away from home at age 9 when his mother remarried. (Mother may have been Native American). There is also a family rumor that BROOKS is an assumed name. Declaration for Pension or for Increase of Pension of Children under Sixteen Years of Age. Stamped: U.S. Pension Office, Nov 15 1883, State of West Virginia, County of Raleigh:

On this the Twenty-ninth day of October, A.D., One thousand eight hundred and eighty three [1883], personally appeared before me JOHN BECKLEY, Clerk of the County Court, a Court of accord in and for the County and State aforesaid, application is made-----appointing of guardian, adding ----and then gave the names of minors. If minors apply in their own defense, insert names of applicants: [hand-written names entered] JOHN A. WEBB, RUSSELL WEBB & VIRGINIA CANTERBERRY, residents of Breckenridge, County of Raleigh, State of W.Va, aged 30, 26 & 23 years, respectively, who being duly sworn according to law, make the following declaration in order to obtain -----;

That they are the legitimate children of HENRY WEBB, who enlisted under the name of HENRY WEBB, in the Kanawha Valley, on the 20th day of Nov, A.D., 1861 in 7th Virginia Regiment of Cavalry, Co. H in the war of the Rebellion, who died of disease contracted in The Rebellion at Cove Creek, on the \_\_\_ day of July, A.D., 1865, and who bore at the time of his death the rank of private, in Co. H, 7th W. Va. Cav., that he left a widow surviving at the time of his death (LEAH WEBB) [sh/be LEAR WEBB, seen several ways] who died on the \_\_\_ day of March 1866. That the above-named are the only surviving legitimate children of HENRY WEBB who were under sixteen years of age at the time of his death, that said children were the issue of soldier, as follows the dates of their birth being as hereinafter stated:

JOHN A. [WEBB], (son) of soldier, by LEAH WEBB, born Nov 12 1853

RUSSELL [WEBB], (son) of soldier, by LEAH WEBB, born Oct 22 1857

VIRGINIA [WEBB] (daughter) of soldier, by LEAH WEBB, born Nov 4 1860.

That the mother was married under the name of LEAH WEBB to HENRY WEBB, there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that the said children have not aided or abetted the Rebellion; and that no prior application has been filed; that the declarant hereby appoints with full power of substitution

and revocation, A. B. WEBB of Washington D.C., their attorney to prosecute the above claim; that their post office address is Breckenridge, Raleigh County, W. Va.

Cav., Personally came before me ACHILLES McGINNIS, aged 38 years whose PO address is Matville Raleigh Co., W. Va, who is known to me to be reputable and entitled to credit and being duly sworn upon his Oath says in relation to aforesaid claim as follows viz:

That prior to Enlistment he had lived near and had been intimately acquainted with Said HENRY WEBB and by reason of his intimate and frequent association with him knows for a certainly that prior to and at the time of his enlistment in said Company & Regiment in the Autumn of 1861, that he was a Sound and very Stout man and had every tangible indication of living to a great age; that Affiant was a member of Same Company Enlisting about the Same time and Serving together; knows that the Soldier was Stout and hearty, did his duty faithfully and cheerfully until about March 1862, while the Company was quartered at Buffalo Mountain, same Co., W. Va. the Soldier appeared to have contracted a deep seated cold (resulting from the exposures incident to our Camp life) which settled upon his lungs judging by a Cough he had & Complaining of his Chest, it appeared to be Seated throughout his entire system, his flesh became swollen especially his feet & legs and know that the Soldier continued thus feeble and complaining or aforesaid (doing but little duty) during the remainder of his term of Service seemed to be dragging out the most gloomy despondent state of existence and after his discharge he did not live long, he died as near as He now remembers sometime about the first of July 1865, there is no doubt in his mind about his death being the result of his diseases aforesaid contracted in the Service in the line of his duty and further declares that he is not related to the claimants nor interested in the prosecution of the claim for pension.

WEBB, when acquaintance aforesaid began had every appearance of a sound healthy stout heavy square-built man, and was so reputed by his more intimate acquaintances i.e., a stout man, while at Buffalo, W.Va. about Feb or Mch 62, WEBB aforesaid Seemed to have contracted a deep seated cold, began coughing, grew thin and pale, looked feeble and complained much and so continued up to 8th June 62. Affiant was with Company none after, but from representations of comrades is Satisfied that WEBB aforesaid continued almost an invalid until he dragged out his term of Enlistment. Affiant met MR. WEBB about Feb or Mch 1865 after his discharge on Fields Creek in Kanawha Co, W.Va., who was coughing and barely able to walk with a staff, and did not think he could live long and further declare[s] that he has no interest in said case and is not concerned in its prosecution further than an anxiety that Justice may be done for RUSSEL WEBB and VIRGINIA CANTERBERRY, Soldiers surviving children, that their present PO address is Dry Creek, Raleigh Co, W.Va.

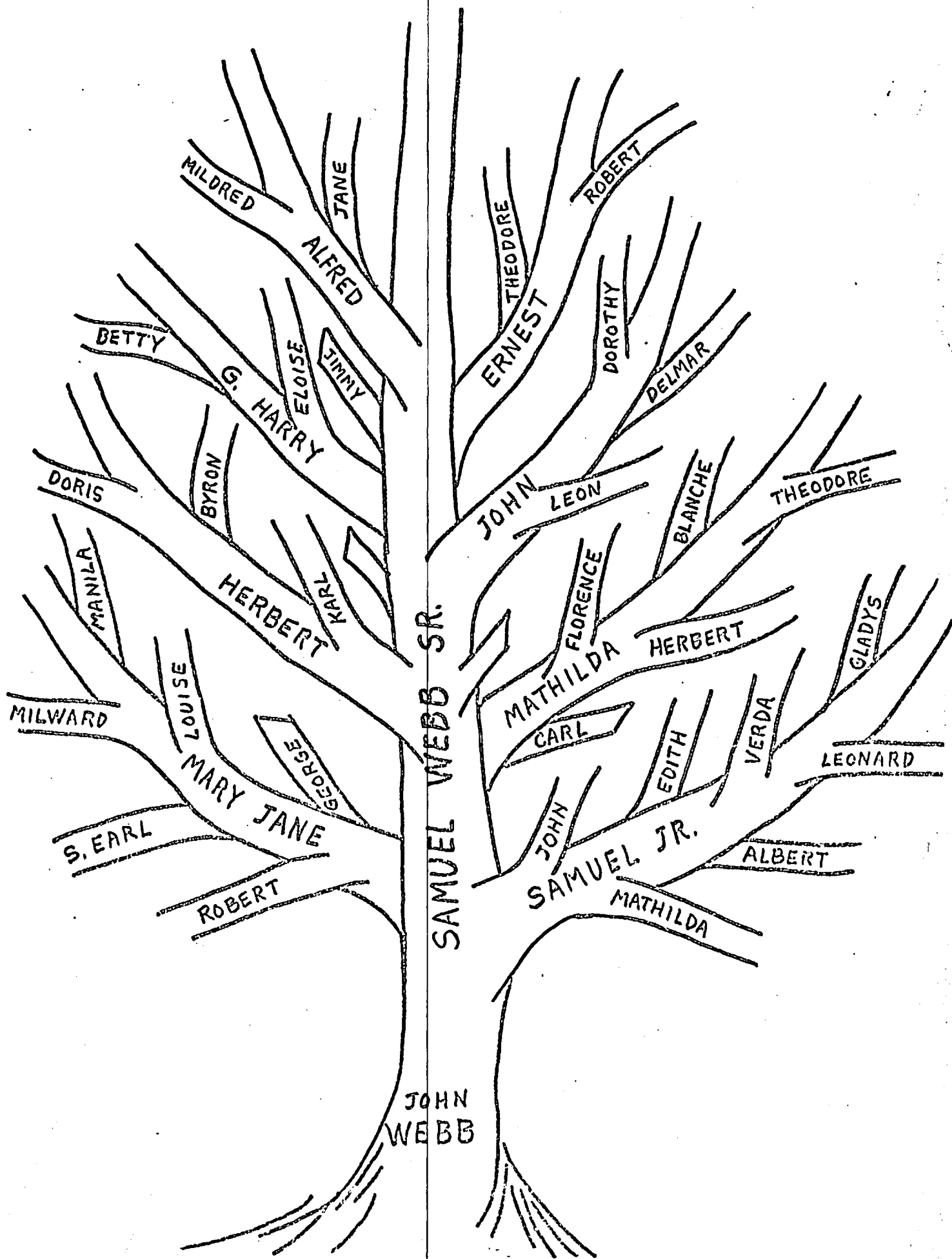

## THE WEBB FAMILY

John Webb, the forefather of the Webb family, was born and lived in England during his lifetime, probably in Warwickshire, or Derbyshire. He served in armed forces in India and Ireland. No record has been found of his birth or death dates, or locations. His son, Samuel Webb, Sr. was born in Warwickshire, England, on Dec. 18, 1837, and was married to Sarah Rodgers, of Bilston, Staffordshire, England, on Oct. 9, 1859. Through correspondence in early 1950's, with the husband of Sarah Rodgers' sister, a Charles Cousins, of North Chesterfield, Derbyshire, we know that the Webbs lived in or near Clay Crosse, Derbyshire, and left from there, in 1880 to go to America. First Sam Jr. and Mary Jane came over with their father; the mother, Sarah, and the rest of the children came at a later date, on the ship Illinois, landing at Philadelphia, and settling in Shamokin, Pa. then Houghdale, Pa. A few years later they moved to Edwards Station, Ill. and Richmond, Mo., the latter place where the men worked in the coal mines. In 1884 they moved to Seymour, Iowa. Charles Cousins was a minister in the Church of the Latter Day Saints, and came to America as a delegate to the Church Conferences in Missouri, in 1935 and in 1947, and visited with the Webbs on both occasions.

Shortly after the Webbs arrived in America, there was a severe epidemic of smallpox in Pennsylvania, and Jimmy, who was an infant at that time, succumbed to the disease there. Two other children, both boys, died in infancy, and to date, no record has been found. Thomas Alfred, the youngest son, was the only child of this family born in America.

Most of the men members of this large family were musicians and played in the Chicago Coal Miners Co. Band, at Seymour, Iowa, and later in bands in their communities; descendants have been or are in the music profession, as teachers or band leaders. Dr. Karl Webb was head of the Music Dept. at Missouri State Teacher's College at Kirkeville, Mo. until his retirement.
