My Aunt, Nannie May Westover, now 90 years of age, tells me that there were three Westover brothers who immigrated from England, that when the Revolutionary war came on, one brother went to Canada and fought with the British. The story about the three brothers is referred to in a pamphlet published in 1940 in connection with the Westover Centennial Celebration in which it is said that Nathaniel Westover, the father of the Westovers, and the first settler in Westover Pa., lived in Scheffield Mass.

Begat : Came to Ky., with his father Homer
: Westover. Married Eliza Jane Page on
: April 11, 1861. Had 13 children out of
: WHOM CAME ONE LAWYER, AND TWO NEWSPAPER
: owners and publishers. and three school
: teachers.
- John H. Westover : Born Nov. 3, 1863. Married Anna Rebecca
Begat : Musselman Sept. 26, 1888. Had twin boys.
: born May 19, 1894 in Williamstown Ky.
- William H. Westover : William H. Westover and his brother Harry
: graduated from the Law School at the Uni-
: versity of Arizona in 1918. Both drafted
: into the armed forces of the U.S. in
: March of that year. After discharged both
: returned to Yuma and opened a law office.
: After a few years Harry moved to Santa
: Ana, Calif where he practiced law, became
: a Superior Court Judge . Collector of
