Foreword

This partial history of the lineage of Captain John Jacob Wether-holt was compiled by the writer with the hope that it would prove interesting to many of his living descendants. In this effort I want to thank those who responded to my request for information, and especially to Saraellen E. Wetherhold, of Emmaus, Pa., and Sylvester Wetherhold of Saratoga Springs, N. Y.

Gathering data for a family history has its good points; you meet relatives that you would not meet under ordinary circumstances. It is interesting, but it can also be disappointing.

In June of this year I was curious as to what might have happened to William Wetherhold, son of John (B1) who settled in Illinois and married a Miss Boyer; they had a daughter named Ella. I wrote to the State Capitol in Springfield. Here is the reply from the Bureau of Vital Statistics:

"We cannot fill the attached request because it relates to a record presumably filed before January 1, 1916, and is, therefore, only in the file of the county clerk of the county in which the event took place. Only that county clerk can make corrections or issue copies of this record.

"Enclosed is a list of addresses of county seats, to aid you in directing your request to the appropriate county clerk."

Right there I stopped. Believe it or not, there are over one hundred counties in Illinois. I decided to concentrate on the lineage of Joseph Wetherhold, first son of John (B1), and his two sons, Nathan and Elias.

There are many more members of the Wetherhold Family to be heard from. A Family Reunion could bring much information to light.

The Wetherhold Family

N October 22, 1754, there arrived at Philadelphia two brothers named John Nicholas and John Jacob Wetherholt. They had probably both seen military service in Germany, as they entered the army of the province soon after their arrival.

- (1) John Nicholas Wetherholt was born in 1724 and on December 21, 1755, was commissioned captain in the First Battalion of the Second Pennsylvania Regiment. He was in command of Fort Everett during the French and Indian war and the muster roll of his company is given in the chapter relating to that war. In 1762 he resided in Heidelberg Township, where he was taxed in 1764 on seventy acres of land.
- (2) John Jacob Wetherholt was born in 17... He was commissioned a Lieutenant in Major Parson's town guard on December 21, 1755, and in April, 1756, was stationed at Deitz Blockhouse. On September 21, 1756 he was commissioned captain, and on September 2, 1757, was paid 88 pounds, 6s, 6d. for enlisting fifty-three men in the provincial service. He was a man of undaunted courage and believed that he was invulnerable to bullets. He remained in the provincial service and on October 7, 1763, left Bethlehem with Lieutenant Jonathan Dodge, Sergeant Laurence McGuire and a small party of soldiers on the way to Fort Allen. The party stopped for the night at the tavern of John Stenton, about a mile north of Howertown, in the Irish settlement.

Early next morning, October 8th, Captain Wetherhold ordered one of his men to get his horse ready and as he opened the door he was shot and instantly killed by a party of Indians who had surrounded the tavern. Captain Wetherhold then went to the door and was mortally wounded. The sergeant then attempted to pull in the Captain and shut the door, but was dangerously wounded. The Lieutenant succeeded in closing the door, but meanwhile other Indians shot Stenton, the landlord, through a window, who ran a mile and then dropped dead. Captain Wetherhold crawled to a window and shot an Indian dead, who was about to set fire to the house. The other Indians then took their comrade's body and left, going toward the Lehigh. On the way they killed several persons and crossing the river into Whitehall township, killed or wounded fifteen or twenty persons, a full account of which is given in the chapter on the massacre of 1763.

A few hours later the news reached Bethlehem and a small armed force was sent to bring in the wounded men for surgical treatment. Captain Wetherhold died the next day, October 9, 1763, at the Crown Inn and was buried on the 10th in the graveyard that was located near Second and Ottawa streets. South Bethlehem.

Captain Wetherhold resided in Lynn township, where his widow, Susanna, and his three children, resided in 1764 on a tract of 150 acres, which he owned. In 1766 his widow married Michael Kern. His children were:

- (A1) Jacob Wetherhold, son of Captain John Jacob and his wife Susanna. We have no information on the family of Jacob, other than he had a son: John.
 - (B1) John Wetherhold, son of Jacob (A1), of whom tradition says that on a certain occasion he rode away on a white horse and never returned, having doubtless been killed by Indians. His widow later sold the land and removed from the township. They had three sons.

 - (C1) Joseph, son of John Wetherhold (B1) became a farmer and tanner and the owner of the homestead. He later removed to Allentown, where he resided at the northeast corner of 11th and Hamilton streets, and died in 1859. He married Sarah Acker and had four children. They were:

 - (D1) Nathan Wetherhold, son of Joseph and Sarah (Acker) Wetherhold, was a farmer and tanner at Lyon Valley. He married Polly, daughter of John and Sophia (Ebert) Mosser, of Mosserville. They had eight children:

 - (D2) Elias Wetherhold, son of Joseph and Sarah (Acker) Wetherhold, was born February 12, 1826, in Lowhill Township. He was reared on his father's farm and became a merchant in Hynemansville, where he successfully carried on business for forty years, and was postmaster for over thirty years. Sometime during the 1870's he was granted 160 acres of land by the government in the vicinity of Iola, Kansas. He took his oldest son, Chester, with him to Kansas to fulfill government regulations, after which he leased the farm to a tenant. In 1904, Sylvester, another son, was sent by the family to Kansas to investigate conditions on the farm. Oil wells had sprung up in that part of Kansas but no oil was discovered on the Wetherhold property, and after some fifty years of ownership it was sold. Elias was married to Amelia E., daughter of David and Magdalena (Neff) Stein, born September 14, 1831.

He died on May 4, 1888 and was buried at Seiberlingsville. His wife, Amelia, died in Allentown on November 29, 1918 and was buried on Greenwood Cemetery. Later his body was exhumed, as were also those of three of their children who had died in infancy, and placed beside that of his wife on Greenwood. They had ten children:

His remains were interred in the Union Cemetery at Allentown, but hers in the Fairview Cemetery. They had seven children:

He then returned to Allentown (1888) and embarked in the local express business, which he conducted very successfully, at one time employing nine men and twelve horses. In politics he was a Republican. On July 30, 1881 he was married to Mary Newhard, daughter of David and Martha (Heimbach) Newhard.

She died August 6, 1898, aged 37 years. On December 24, 1907 he married as his second wife, Elizabeth M. Lafey, daughter of Jeremiah and Emma (Gilbert) Lafey, of Klinesville, Berks County.

ANOTHER BRANCH OF THE FAMILY

Some years ago, as we were gathering data on the Wetherhold Family, one of my sons who is living in Delaware informed me that there is another Wetherhold in the telephone directory besides his name. On my next trip to Delaware, we drove 20 miles to Seaford to see Mr. William Wetherhold. He had gone to pick up a son who was to be brought home from college, so we missed meeting him, but his wife gave us some information, and later we had a letter from "Bill." He said his sister, a retired school teacher would be able to give us more information than he could.

We got in touch with Miss Katharine A. Wetherhold (his sister) who was in Maine at the time. She wrote us a very nice letter; however, she did admit that the information she could give was very limited as they were not a "clannish" family. She remembered going to reunions in Kutztown and Allentown.

Following is the information we received. Maybe someone can enlighten us further.

Foreword

It is just a little more than a year since we went to press with the first edition of "The Wetherhold Family" booklet. We realized that our information should have been more complete, and could have been, with a little greater effort; but, not being a professional historian, we were very grateful for any help we could get.

After the book was printed we immediately began correcting mistakes and gathering information for another printing, which of course was an uncertainty at the time.

On August 5th, the undersigned made a trip to Doylestown where we visited the Bucks County Historical Society Museum and Library. In the library Saraellen found a book written by Professor Daniel Rupp. Among the ship arrivals she found the following:

"October 22, 1754 — Ship Halifax, Thomas Coatam, Captain, from Rotterdam, last from Corves — inhabitants from Wurttemberg, Hesse, Franconia, and the Palatinate." Then came a list of the passengers, among them was J. Jacob Wetherholt. We did not see the name John Nicholas Wetherholt.

While gathering material for the first book, we had letters from members of two different branches of the family who expressed the belief that we came from Holland. We think perhaps they were confused with the fact that the ship sailed from Holland.

We are making an effort to find members of the Wetherhold family in Illinois, but so far have been unsuccessful.

We have, however, made some progress locally. We have found the burial place of Nathan and Polly Wetherhold, as well as our progenitor, Joseph, and his wife Sarah.

Further investigation led us to what is believed to have been the Wether-hold Homestead in Lyon Valley. Oliver Kressley of Lowhill Township informed us that he was personally acquainted with Robert N. Wetherhold, who left the homestead in 1905 to open a store at 9th and Tilghman streets in Allentown; and that he was the last member of the family to live there.

We spoke to the present owner, Mr. Carl Lenz, who told us that the proposed Trexler Dam will put most of the homestead under water. This is to be regretted, because, having seen the place, we realize what a beautiful spot it must have been. Back of the house (or to the east) possibly 200 yards away there is a creek, flowing freely, and immediately beyond, a steep wooded hillside.

All the reports state there was a tannery at the homestead. Mr. Kressley says there was a creamery there. When this transition took place is a mystery. Robert N. Wetherhold's father, John W., we are told, was a tanner in Lyon Valley and a farmer in Ballietsville.

We are inclined to believe the tannery to have been a fact. Perhaps the following incident which occurred when we started the printing trade back in 1907, will help to get you on our side.

In the early days of my apprenticeship I worked with Mr. Milton P. Haas, father of H. Ray Haas, founder of the firm. One day, during conversation, he was curious as to where my parents lived before moving to Allentown. I told him my father was raised in Hynemansville. He suggested that probably he was related to the Wetherholds who had the tannery near there. Before joining his son in the printing business, Mr. Haas had been a salesman for Allentown Shoe Manufacturing Company, and later the Philip Schneider Shoe Company; his territory covering Pennsylvania and four adjacent States. So it is quite possible that he had first hand knowledge of the Wetherhold Tannery.

After the first printing of "The Wetherhold Family" booklet we realized how little we knew of the burial places of our ancestors. The more we thought about it the more curious we became; so, on a Sunday afternoon we took a trip to Lowhill Church, believing this the most logical place to commence our search. Our hunch was correct, as we discovered first, the graves of Nathan and Polly Wetherhold. After taking several pictures we continued our search and not too far away we found the graves of Joseph and Sarah, parents of Nathan and Elias. However, for some unknown reason there is a grave between that of Joseph and Sarah. This may have been the result of a second marriage. Angeline Wetherhold Kilmer says Joseph was a wealthy man but a second marriage after Sarah died removed his wealth from the family.

The stone at Joseph's grave is not the original one, which indicates that someone has shown an interest in marking the spot, and had the old stone replaced with one more modern.

The graves of John W. Wetherhold and his wife Amelia, nee Bachman, as well as several of their children, are also located at Lowhill Church.

Since Heidelberg Church is less than a mile from Lowhill, we searched both cemeteries there, but found no Wetherhold buried on either one.

We hope you will find this book a little more interesting than the first edition.

The Wetherhold Family

N October 22, 1754, there arrived at Philadelphia two brothers named John Nicholas and John Jacob Wetherholt. They had probably both seen military service in Germany, as they entered the army of the province soon after their arrival.

- (1) John Nicholas Wetherholt was born in 1724 and on December 21, 1755, was commissioned captain in the First Battalion of the Second Pennsylvania Regiment. He was in command of Fort Everett during the French and Indian war and the muster roll of his company is given in the chapter relating to that war. In 1762 he resided in Heidelberg Township, where he was taxed in 1764 on seventy acres of land.
- (2) John Jacob Wetherholt was born in 17... He was commissioned a Lieutenant in Major Parson's town guard on December 21, 1755, and in April, 1756, was stationed at Deitz Blockhouse. On September 21, 1756 he was commissioned captain, and on September 2, 1757, was paid 88 pounds, 6s, 6d. for enlisting fifty-three men in the provincial service. He was a man of undaunted courage and believed that he was invulnerable to bullets. He remained in the provincial service and on October 7, 1763, left Bethlehem with Lieutenant Jonathan Dodge, Sergeant Laurence McGuire and a small party of soldiers on the way to Fort Allen. The party stopped for the night at the tavern of John Stenton, about a mile north of Howertown, in the Irish settlement.

Early next morning, October 8th, Captain Wetherhold ordered one of his men to get his horse ready and as he opened the door he was shot and instantly killed by a party of Indians who had surrounded the tavern. Captain Wetherhold then went to the door and was mortally wounded. The sergeant then attempted to pull in the Captain and shut the door, but was dangerously wounded. The Lieutenant succeeded in closing the door, but meanwhile other Indians shot Stenton, the landlord, through a window, who ran a mile and then dropped dead. Captain Wetherhold crawled to a window and shot an Indian dead, who was about to set fire to the house. The other Indians then took their comrade's body and left, going toward the Lehigh. On the way they killed several persons and crossing the river into Whitehall township, killed or wounded fifteen or twenty persons, a full account of which is given in the chapter on the massacre of 1763.

A few hours later the news reached Bethlehem and a small armed force was sent to bring in the wounded men for surgical treatment. Captain Wetherhold died the next day, October 9, 1763, at the Crown Inn and was buried on the 10th in the graveyard that was located near Second and Ottawa streets, South Bethlehem.

Captain Wetherhold resided in Lynn township, where his widow, Susanna, and his three children, resided in 1764 on a tract of 150 acres, which he owned. In 1766 his widow married Michael Kern. His children were:

Sometime during the 1870's he was granted 160 acres of land by the government in the vicinity of Iola, Kansas. He took his oldest son, Chester, with him to Kansas to fulfill government regulations, after which he leased the farm to a tenant. In 1904, Sylvester, another son, was sent by the family to Kansas to investigate conditions on the farm. Oil wells had sprung up in that part of Kansas but no oil was discovered

on the Wetherhold property, and after some fifty years of ownership it was sold. Elias was married to Amelia E., daughter of David and Magdalena (Neff) Stein, born September 14, 1831. Elias died on May 4, 1888 and was buried at Seiberlingsville. His wife, Amelia, died in Allentown on November 29, 1918 and was buried on Greenwood Cemetery. Later his body was exhumed, as were also those of three of their children who had died in infancy, and placed beside that of his wife on Greenwood. They had ten children:

She was born December 28, 1803, and died November 11, 1881. Mr. Wetherhold learned the trade of tailor, which he carried on for a time. He removed to Allentown and conducted a hotel business for upward of thirty years, at the northwest corner of 7th and Hamilton streets for six years, (known as The Eagle Hotel), and then on the southeast corner of 7th and Walnut streets for 25 years. His prominence led to his election as 9heriff of the county in 1841, and his re-election in 1844. During his service of six years his residence was in the County prison, the office of prison warden not yet having been created. They had twelve children:
