Dear Editor: I had a delightful time at the recent A.G.S. Seminar, found more members who share common ancestors, heard some great talks and got to show off my crazy computer. As a relative newcomer to the Society it was great to hear Charles Denney's personal history of A.G.S. since its inception ten short years ago. Our after-lunch, Dr. Roy Wilson, both entertained and informed me with his Medicine Hat presentation. My Loyalist and Nova Scotia background made the Rompkey and Kennedy contributions particularly relevant. I wish I had had more time to see the displays. Kurt Nagel's chart going back 44 generations (1) was worth far more than the five cursory minutes I was able to give it.

However, there was something missing. We need more information about the A.G.S. today. There are people doing some wonderful things for the Society that we need to know more about -- in some cases more assistance is needed. Specifically, I am referring to "Relatively Speaking", Activities, successes, problems in the branches, the A.G.S. Library, the Cemeteries Project, Genealogical Researchers' Committee and the Ancestor INDEX.

Would it be possible to have a set of concurrent workshops on A.G.S. activities at the next seminar? Some people have suggested that the 3 workshops at this seminar went well. Possibly on Friday evening, (in lieu of the reception, perhaps) we could have a workshop on each of the province-wise A.G.S. activities -- except Branch activities. I am sure there are many members like me, who are not aware of the effort involved in these activities or the contribution each of us could make to one or more of them.

As for Branch activities, I believe it is crucial to the success of AGS that we all have a sense of what is happening within the seven branches, and an appreciation of our much neglected members-at-large. We could achieve this through a variety of ways -- a display by each branch at the seminar. An eight minute presentation by each branch which could take the form of a skit, slide show, debate, whatever -- something creative that would give us all a glimpse not only at the activities but some of the people involved.

Please understand that these ideas come from the 20/20 vision provided by hindsight. I was a member of this year's seminar planning committee and could suggest something like this -- I didn't. Fortunately, there is always next year.
