RUSSIAN EMBASSY RECORDS

by Wyn Welton

In the spring of 1980 the Archives of Canada acquired 100 boxes of Canadian Immigration records which had been sent to New York when the Russian Embassy closed its consulate in 1922.

For thousands of Canadians of Armenian. Doukhobor, Esthonian, Finnish, Georgian, Jewish, Latvian, Lithuanian, Mennonite, Polish, Russian and Ukrainian origins a rich new source of genealogical material is available.

Information available includes: places of origin, dates of arrival in Canada, education, names of next of kin, ownership of property, and value of estates left behind.

I have been keeping in touch with Myron Momryk of the Ethnic Archives Section of the PAC. He is responsible for indexing this collection and developing a finding aid. Because of the personal and confidentail nature of the material in this collection, the PAC has not yet developed a policy in respect to researchers. However, Mr. Momryk indicates that they are now in a position to reply to written inquiries whether or not particular names appear in the preliminary nominal lists created to date. Strong evidence of family relationship is required.

I suggest a copy of your pedigree or a photstat of a certificate should be sent along with your letter of inquiry.



The Irish Shewfelts Anne Baines #229

At the 1993 AGS conference in Red Deer the entertainment at the closing banquet was provided by a delightful group of Irish dancers dressed in beautifully hand embroidered outfits. The lady who announced the dances, presumably a mother or a teacher, was a Ms. Shewfelt. Anyone who is familiar with the name Shewfelt knows that it is German in origin. How did the Shewfelts become Irish?

It is likely that anyone in North America with the surname Shewfelt (Zufelt, Schufelt, etc) is a descendent of Johann Georg Zufelt who, at age 50 with his wife and children, emigrated from Germany to New York with the Palatinates in 1709. He was born at Hasselbach, Hessen, Germany in 1659. His wife was Anna Catherine Zaam. Some of their descendants ended up in Ontario.

About 1850 in Kincardine Township, Bruce County, Ontario some of the Shewfelts married Irish girls who came to Canada in the 1840's. On the 1871 census it is interesting to note that several of the Shewfelts were listed as German, their wives Irish and all their children Irish. Following are extracts of some of these families taken from the 1871 Ontario Census, Kincardine Twp., Bruce County District 27, Sub District E:

There are other examples, such as the James Shewfelt family on page fifty-six that illustrate this point. There are also examples where the children follow the father's German origin.

Grandfather, Peter Thomas Shewfelt, is the Peter Thom. listed on page 32. He was one of the Shewfelts that celebrated St. Patrick's day faithfully. A letter written by Grandfather on the 20th March 1939 begins:


I received your card on St. Patrick's Day and many thanks for. Remember me of St. Patrick day and Old Ireland forever.

Mom, a daughter of Peter Thomas, grew up thinking she was Irish. It wasn't until she was in her twenties that someone confused her by telling her she wasn't Irish, but Pensylvannia Dutch. After that when she was asked about her origins she said she was either Irish or Dutch, but wasn't sure which.

So it was that the Shewfelts changed from being German to Irish!

A recent letter contained a reminder of the importance of not only searching for direct ancestors but also for seeking out children of these ancestors. Smith and Gardner in their book "Genealogical Research in England and Wales Vol 1." (page 14) say:

As the research proceeds, every effort should be made to find the complete family in each generation. In haste to extend pedigrees back to as early a date as possible, many sometimes fail to do this.

About 1833 third great-grandfather, John Cook, came to Nicol Township, Wellington Co., Ontario from Thornbury, Gloucester, England. He had been married to Jane Pick on Dec. 28, 1825 at Tortworth, Gloucester, England. However his marriage record did not contain his parents names, nor did his death record, obituary, or will. The only clue as to the name of his father was the 1851 census which showed there was an elderly man by the name of William Cook living with the John Cook family. This did not support the belief of descendents that John's father was also John.

The parish records for Thornbury area contain many John Cooks - including those with father John and those with father William. It seemed like there would be no way of knowing which christening was for the correct John Cook.

John had a brother, Robert, who came from England and settled on the next farm to John. He was there on each census record next to the John Cooks - first with wife, Margaret, and later with wife, Mary. A Cook history mentioned that his first wife died and he then married Mary Blinco, widow of Wm. Stockford. This information was noted but as he was not a direct ancestor, nothing was verified.

When the "Index to the Wellington County Marriage Register" came out, Robert's second marriage was there. Mr. Wm. Britnell looked up the original entry and it arrived in the mail containing the names of Robert's parents - William & Ann Cook. These parents, of course, were also John's parents pushing back one more generation.

A similar situation occured earlier in the search for the birthplace of great-grandfather, John Murray, in Scotland. John was, perhaps, a stubborn fellow. On the 1871 census for Pictou county, N.S., the census taker noted that John would not give the requested information. His marriage record contained only "Scotland" as his place of birth and no other record was more specific. However, one of his sons (not a direct-line ancester) was more specific on his marriage certificate and listed his father's birthplace as "Sutherlandshire, Scotland" and this was enough of a clue to find John's birth in Brora, ClyneParish, Sutherland, Scotland.

Research time spent on brothers and sisters of direct-line ancestors can turn out to be very valuable and is sometimes the only source for information about direct line ancestors.



in Search Eight. Going through the cause of death column for the many William Jones there is only one which might fit (though a few had the cause of death unknown). His cause of death was "shot". This happened the July before the 1850 census and so could not possibly be the right one. Checking through the place of birth column. only one William was born in Canada. He died of lung inflamation in Pennsylvania the May before the 1870 census. So William may not have died conveniently the year before a census or he may be in those records that are yet incomplete.

This index is a wonderful help for locating ancestors in the US. However, the manual from Salt Lake points out that it is not perfect. The Genealogical Department has done an extensive study and finds an overall error rate of 19%. The type of errors found sound very familiar: names missed on the index, typographical errors, transposition errors, transcription errors, people appearing twice on a search, and inconsistent format. Most genealogists are used to these types of errors and have learned to work around them. It always helps to have uncommon surnames as well.

Although there are errors in the index. it is most extensive and could be very valuable. As an article in the Church News (April 22. 1984) states: "New index can help bring you to your census."





Read in your issues about "Ghostly Addresses". In the Acadia Electoral District in 1911 there was a Post Office established by the name of "REIST".

It was established by my great-grandfather, Elias B. Reist, who moved there from Michigan to homestead. Many of my family came along, thus the office was named after their family, and was operated in their home until their 1922 move to Oregon.

The location given is 13-31-10-W4. It moved later to SW 36-31-10-W4, and still later to SE 14-32-10-W4, prior to closing in 1948.

Editor's Note: Our resident specialist in matters in this area of Alberta, Hugh Greenslade, reports the community of "Reist" to be located about 25 miles east of the town of Hanna, north and north-west of Antelope Lake.






