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## NOTES FOR THE USER OF THESE CEMETERY LISTINGS

These records are alphabetical listings of the gravestone inscriptions made in 1988 and 1989. These lists are NOT records of burials and it is not known whether such records were ever maintained except the records to be found in the Parish Registers.

Although great care has been taken to record the dates and information given on the gravestones, it is advisable to use the information with caution and, if possible, cross check the data from these lists with other records - death reports, obituary notices, family bibles et cetera.

Errors in recording gravestone inscriptions may occur in a variety of ways:

1. From incorrect information given at the time the marker was ordered.
2. Errors in reading and transcribing the inscriptions. This is often the case when the carving on the stone has become chipped or weathered.

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"J.W." A number of Hants County gravestones were carved by a man who is known only as J.W. His works extended over the period ca. 1820 - 1839. Deborah Trask's Life how Short Eternity how long: Gravestone Carving and Carvers in Nova Scotia states: "His stones are found in rural areas, particularly in many scattered locations in Hants County."

THE CONSECRATION OF THE  
CHURCH IN THE PARISH OF NEWPORT  
IN THE COUNTY OF HANTS  
AND IN  
OUR DIOCESE OF NOVA SCOTIA

IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN.

WHEREAS a Church has been built at Newport in the County of Hants and in our diocese of Nova Scotia to the Glory of Almighty God and for the celebration and performance of divine worship according to the Rites and Ceremonies of the United Church of England and Ireland as by law established and such fabric is finished and decently ornamented and furnished with all things necessary for divine worship and is now ready for Consecration. And whereas the officiating Minister, the Churchwardens and other inhabitants of the said place have humbly besought us that we would by our Authority ordinary and Episcopal vouchsafe to consecrate this parish Church and set apart and separate the said fabric and remain a place of worship forever according to the rites and Ceremonies of the United Church of England and Ireland as by Law established.

NOW, WE JOHN by divine permission Bishop of Nova Scotia and its dependencies do by virtue of the Authority to us committed separate the said Church at Newport from all profane and common uses and do dedicate the same to Almighty God and divine worship by the name of Saint James at Newport and consecrate it for the celebration and performance of divine service and do openly publicly pronounce, decree and declare that the same ought to remain so separated, dedicated and consecrated forever by this our definitive sentence or final decree which we read and promulge by these presents.

As Witness our Hand this third day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-six.

Continuation of Consecration document  
re St. James Anglican Cemetery:

In the name of GOD, Amen.

WHEREAS a piece of Gound hath been provided for the decent Burial of the Dead in the parish of St. James Newport in the County of Hants and in our Diocese of Nova Scotia and whereas the Minister, Churchwardens and principal inhabitants of the said parish have humbly besought us we would by our authority ordinary and Episcopal vouchsafe to consecrate the same piece of ground and set apart and separate it from all profane and common use and declare the same to be a place of burial forever.

NOW, we John by divine permission Bishop of Nova Scotia and its dependencies do by virtue of the Authority to us committed separate the said piece of ground from profane and common uses and do dedicate the same as a place of Burial. We do openly and publicly pronounce, decree and declare that the same ought to remain so separated, dedicated and consecrated forever by this our sentence or final decree which we read and promulge by these presents.

The early reference to the land on which this cemetery is located is found in a Deed of Trust dated October 8, 1824 when James Sterling of Newport, Nova Scotia and his wife, Jane, deeded a parcel of land "bounded by the school house near Meander Bridge thence running North, East, South, East, South and West until it reaches the highway thence following the highway until it reaches the first mentioned bound...."

This parcel of land "together with a Chapel and other premises now about to be built upon was to be held by trustees John Allison, John Forrest, Arnold Shaw, William Allison and Robert Salter...such persons as shall be appointed at the yearly Conference of the People called Methodists, held in London, Bristol, Leeds, Manchester, Sheffield, Liverpool or elsewhere specified by name in a deed enrolled in Chancery under the hand and seal of the Reverend John Wesley and bearing date the twenty eighth day of February, 1784 and no others. To have to Hold and enjoy the said premises, in order that they may therein Preach and expound God's Holy Words and perform all other acts of Religious Worship provided that the persons so appointed preach no other doctrines than as contained in Mr. Wesley's Notes upon the New Testament and his four volumes of Sermons by him published..."

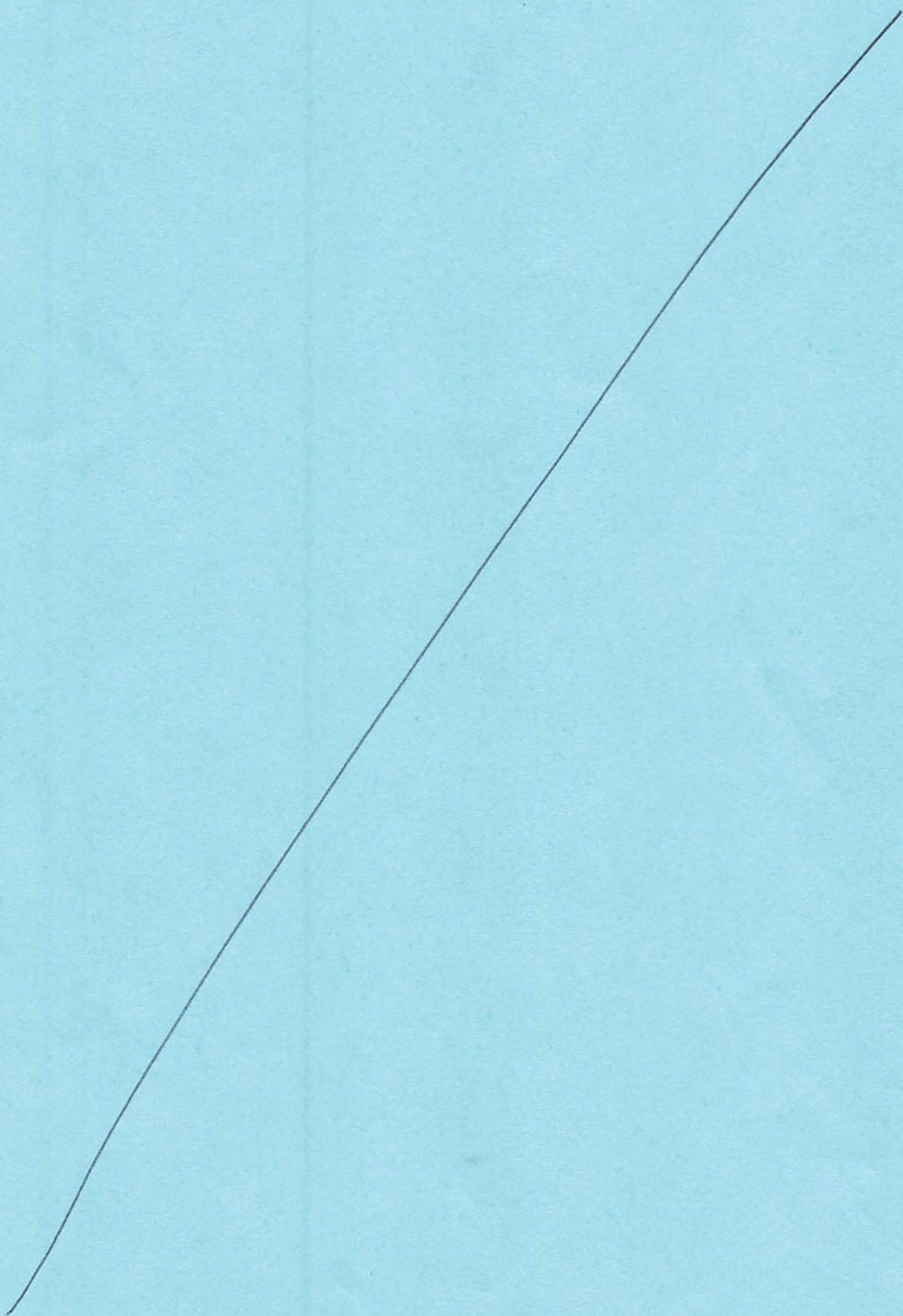
