Examining Ancestral Baptismal Records

While all of us share a common thread of having ancestors from the former area of Czechoslovakia, the lan-

guage used in recording official records of our ancestors may differ. The language used for recording baptisms usually was based on the preferred language of the priest or pastor. At other times in history, the official government language (German) was required. Some priests or pastors used a version of Czech language that was made to look like the old German script. The records of your ancestors may be in German, Latin,

Czech, Slovak, Rusyn, Hungarian, or Hebrew.

The baptismal records were generally recorded by the church in large registers called Matriky. The older records for which most of us are interested are stored in Regional Archives in the Czech and Slovak Republics. The two archives in Moravia go by the terms Provincial Archives. The age of the records vary from district to district throughout the Czech and Slovak Republics. In most cases you can find baptismal records beginning from the mid 1700's. A recent decision made by the Czech Ministry requires that all matriky books completed (filled) after 1900 and before 1920 were to be transferred from City Halls to the Regional Archive. This information was provided by Miroslav Koudelka of Olomouc, Czech Republic. Previous to this year the archives generally held all vital statistic records prior to 1900.

Some families possess copies of baptismal certificates issued from the family church in Bohemia, Moravia, Silesia, or Slovakia (Upper Hungary). These

certificates were generally issued many years after the birth of the person. The most common reason they were issued was to obtain a passport for emigration to another country. Sometimes persons who had become U.S. citizens later wrote to request a certificate to obtain their social security benefits.

Country of Birth, District Office, Judicial District, Diocese, Vicariate, Parish, book number, page number, day, month and year of birth and baptism, name of baptizer, name of infant to be baptized, religion, place of birth (house number, town, district), name of midwife; name of father with his occupation, house number, the father's father and mother's names (with maiden name) and the house numbers; name of the mother, house number for her, names of her mother and father and the house numbers for them; names of godparents; special annotations; the seal of the church or town hall office; date issued; and signature of deacon, priest, or other official.

The most unusual example of a baptismal certificate was submitted by Chris Miksanek of Rochester, Minnesota and formerly of Elmhurst, Illinois. According to Chris his grandmother Rosalia had a "mysteri-

ous" copy from a Roman Catholic Church in Transylvania. "It is suspected to be an alternate "covert" copy because it was believed there were caps on the number of immigrants from a given country."

The records for the Slovak Regional Archives have been microfilmed by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Included with this article is a microfilm printout of a page from the baptismal register (exhibit #1) of the Greek Catholic Parish in Komloša, Diocese of Prešov, Slovakia. The information on this register (matrika) was used to produce the attached baptismal certificate (exhibit #2) with the heading Výtah pokrstených. Note that the headings for this certificate are given in Slovak, Rusyn (Cyrillic alphabet), and Latin. These two documents were provided by Karen Varian of Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The parish is St. Peter and Paul. She is the legitimate female child of Karol (Carolus) Rentka and Johana (Joanna) Pajta. The certificate has both Latin and Slovak headings. It was completed on April 8, 1921.

Exhibit #5 Baptismal Certificate for Rosalia Rentka (?), the Grandmother of Chris Miksanek.

This copy listed as being from Transylvania in 1897, is described by Chris as an alternate "covert" copy. It appears to be from a Roman Catholic Church in Csik Gyimes, Transylvania. While this document was in the possession of Chris' grandmother, it is not entirely clear whether this was hers. It is a mystery indeed. If someone knows of similar events or knows the whereabouts of Csik Gyimes, please contact Paul Makousky.

Exhibit #6 Birth and Baptismal Certificate for Barbara Pleniger born October 4, 1872 and baptised October 4, 1872

She was born in Hoslau #11, district of Bischofteinitz, and judicial district of Ronsperg. The midwife is Elisabeth Grossl of Ronsperg, licensed. The father (Vater) is Johann Pleniger, farmer, Hoslau #11, legitimate son of Josef Pleniger, farmer Hoslau #11 and Magdalene (nee Hofmann) from Altrindl #17. The mother (Mutter) is Anna Helget, legitimate daughter of Georg Helget, residing in Natschetin #11 and Margaretha (nee Heidl) of Natschetin #19. Godparents are Georg Prokosch and Maria Prokosch, farmers in Hoslau. Certificate dated November 14, 1936.





Early Baptismal Records of St. John Nepomucene Catholic Church Fox River Grove (McHenry County) Illinois

In his book, *History of Czechs in America*, published in 1910, Dr. Jan Habenicht writes about a settlement of Czech immigrants in Illinois, referring to it as the "lovely neighborhood" of Cary and Algonquin. He also notes "a small wooden Czech Catholic church stands there, too."

Around 1860, Czech immigrants, most of them farmers, settled near the Fox River towns of Algonquin, Cary, and Fox River Grove (formerly Cary Station). In 1867, eighteen area families decided it was time to organize a parish and purchase land for a church and a cemetery. An acre of land high on a hill was purchased for \$20.00 from John Bohacek and construction of St. John Nepomucene Catholic Church began in 1871 and was completed two years later.

Since the church never had a resident pastor, priests would come to St. John's from Bohemian-founded parishes in Chicago. They were from St. Wenceslaus, St. Procopius, Blessed Agnes of Bohemia, St. John Nepomucene, Our Lady of Good Counsel, Sts. Cyril & Methodius and St. Ludmilla. At first, a priest came only once a year and as the parish grew, priests came every three months and finally once a month. The trip was made by train to Barrington and then by oxen or horse-drawn wagon to St. John's.

The last regular Sunday mass was held about 1914 when a new parish, Sts. Peter & Paul, was formed in Cary and a new mission church, St. Margaret Mary, started in Algonquin. Perpetual care of the church and cemetery is overseen by trustees of the association. Each Labor Day weekend mass is still celebrated there.

The early baptismal register also contains some death record entries. Today, the original book may be found at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Cary, Illinois.

Editor's Note: The following listing is a scaled-down version of Judy Lovaas's translation of the early baptismal register. To conserve space, I have included only the name of each person in the register and his or her dates of birth and baptism. Judy has also included the parents' names and the names of the baptismal sponsor(s) for each person. Occasionally, some additional information appears such as the priest's name and less frequently, some town names. Judy's original translation can be viewed in its entirety at the CSAGSI Library or by ordering back issues of McHenry County Connection, the quarterly journal of the McHenry County Illinois Genealogical Society. Illinois State Archives Online Databases Updated



Staff of the Illinois State Archives and the Department of Information Technology has recently completed a conversion of the Archives' online databases to Java-based programs. The content of some databases has been updated and the format of the data returned by all database queries has been enhanced. The Illinois Statewide Marriage Index and the Database of Illinois Servitude and Emancipation Records have been updated to include additional records. The format in which data is returned after a search has been enhanced for the Servitude and Emancipation index and the Public Domain Land Tract Sales Database.

Because all of the databases on the Archives Web site are now Java-based, the global search option, which returns a list of all databases including a specific name, now searches all databases, including the Illinois Statewide Death Index and several others which had not been previously included. The global query now searches over 7 million names—more than doubling the extent of its search. All Archives databases may be found on the Web page address given above.

Early Bohemian Settlers in Chicago

In 1898, Chicago Czech immigrants formed a social organization called Bohemian Old Settlers' Association (Dejiny Spolku Starých Ceských Osadníků v Chicagu). The association was for Czechs who arrived in America after 1848 and lived in America over thirty years. The tenth anniversary (1908) publication of this group provides a complete listing of the men and women within the organization and their date of arrival in America for the years 1848 through 1881. The first officers elected were president Antonin Pregler, vice-president Jakob Padecky, and secretary Frantisek Steiskal (a civil war veteran). Readers should note that as membership was voluntary every Czech immigrant in Chicago would not be included in the membership of this association.

Following is a list of one thousand members of this Bohemian Old Settlers' Association as shown in the publication with their arrival dates in America from 1848 through 1867. Apparent spelling errors exist. An article by Robert O. Uher on the founding and first annual picnic of this association appeared in the Fall 1997 issue of KORENY.

Examining Ancestral Baptismal Records

by Paul M. Makousky, Editor

While all of us share a common thread of having ancestors from the former area of Czechoslovakia, the lan-

guage used in recording official records of our ancestors may differ. The language used for recording baptisms usually was based on the preferred language of the priest or pastor. At other times in history, the official government language (German) was required. Some priests or pastors used a version of Czech language that was made to look like the old German script. The records of your ancestors may be in German, Latin,

While most Catholic parish records are available only locally, and thus accessible either by writing to the archives of the archdiocese or diocese, or the parish; or visiting in person, there are some sacramental records that have been microfilmed by the Genealogical Society of Utah. A partial list of the microfilmed records, shown below, are available at the Family History Library in Salt Lake City, UT or at any of its family history centers.

During my personal visit to the St. Paul Archdiocese archive I was helped by Patrick Anzelc, archives assistant. He brought to me the two books mentioned earlier, and showed me the microfilms of the parish records for this archdiocese. To get a feel for the records, I looked at films for St. Margaret's in Hopkins, St. Stanislaus in St. Paul, and St. Wenceslaus in New Prague.

The registers of baptism are large books maintained by the parish priests. Generally there is a alphabetical list in the front giving the page number for each baptized baby. The first recorded baptisms for St. Margaret's were 1882. At this time the priests were already using standardized forms containing columns of information written in Latin.

The information recorded across the top of the attached register (page 7 from St. Stanislaus) includes: Nomen Familiae (name of family), A.D. Die Mensis (year, day, month), Registrum Baptismorum (Register of Baptism), Observanda (Observations or notes). The body of the form contains the name of the baptized, the date, father's name and place (on this page Reverend Jan Rynda gave the birthplace, although in most cases it is the city of residence), mother's name and place, and names of godparents (Patrini fuerunt), and at the bottom, the priest.

Be patient in your research as records may not be held where you think they are, and the addresses, especially zip codes may have changed, preventing your mail from reaching its destination.

Czech, Slovak, Rusyn, Hungarian, or Hebrew.

The baptismal records were generally recorded by the church in large registers called Matriky. The older records for which most of us are interested are stored in Regional Archives in the Czech and Slovak Republics. The two archives in Moravia go by the terms Provincial Archives. The age of the records vary from district to district throughout the Czech and Slovak Republics. In most cases you can find baptismal records beginning from the mid 1700's. A recent decision made by the Czech Ministry requires that all matriky books completed (filled) after 1900 and before 1920 were to be transferred from City Halls to the Regional Archive. This information was provided by Miroslav Koudelka of Olomouc, Czech Republic. Previous to this year the archives generally held all vital statistic records prior to 1900.

Some families possess copies of baptismal certificates issued from the family church in Bohemia, Moravia, Silesia, or Slovakia (Upper Hungary). These

certificates were generally issued many years after the birth of the person. The most common reason they were issued was to obtain a passport for emigration to another country. Sometimes persons who had become U.S. citizens later wrote to request a certificate to obtain their social security benefits.

The names for Baptismal certificates in the different languages are:

Country of Birth, District Office, Judicial District, Diocese, Vicariate, Parish, book number, page number, day, month and year of birth and baptism, name of baptizer, name of infant to be baptized, religion, place of birth (house number, town, district), name of midwife; name of father with his occupation, house number, the father's father and mother's names (with maiden name) and the house numbers; name of the mother, house number for her, names of her mother and father and the house numbers for them; names of godparents; special annotations; the seal of the church or town hall office; date issued; and signature of deacon, priest, or other official.

The most unusual example of a baptismal certificate was submitted by Chris Miksanek of Rochester, Minnesota and formerly of Elmhurst, Illinois. According to Chris his grandmother Rosalia had a "mysteri-

ous" copy from a Roman Catholic Church in Transylvania. "It is suspected to be an alternate "covert" copy because it was believed there were caps on the number of immigrants from a given country."

The records for the Slovak Regional Archives have been microfilmed by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints. Included with this article is a microfilm printout of a page from the baptismal register (exhibit #1) of the Greek Catholic Parish in Komloša, Diocese of Prešov, Slovakia. The information on this register (matrika) was used to produce the attached baptismal certificate (exhibit #2) with the heading Výtah pokrstených. Note that the headings for this certificate are given in Slovak, Rusyn (Cyrillic alphabet), and Latin. These two documents were provided by Karen Varian of Minneapolis, Minnesota.

The remainder of the information for this article

consists of seven examples of baptismal records (exhibits #1-7) that were created in Europe. I have provided translations for some of the information on each exhibit. I hope that this gives you a good overview of the type of information and format of various baptismal records you may encounter in your research.

Exhibit #1 Baptismal Register for Greek Catholic Church in Komloša, Slovakia

The numbers running at the very left are the entries in numeric order. The second and third columns are the date of birth and baptism with the month beneath. In the fourth column is the first name of the child. The next four columns have the sex (male or female) and type of birth (legitimate or illegitimate). In the middle column are the names of the parents (wife's maiden name) and their religious affiliation. The last name of the father is underlined>. The following column (#10) is the birthplace of the child. Column #11 gives the names of the godparents or witnesses. Column #12 gives the name of the baptizer (priest or pastor). The

last column is for comments (observations).

The relative of Karen Varian is the third entry, Eliáš Varjan born July 23 (baptized 27), 1884 the son of Adam Varjan and Maria Hnatišin of Komloša. The godparents or witnesses were Peter Ruszinyak and Maria (nee Jaroscak) Varjan. The pastor was Peter Petrašovič.

The child baptized is Jan Ivančo, born on April 8, 1920 legitimate male child of Jan Ivančo and Anna Stefankova, both Greek Catholic. The certificate was issued on December 29, 1940 which is shown at the bottom (center). This certificate has both the Slovak and Hungarian headings. It was submitted by Jean Ivanco Cook of Fort Wayne, Indiana.

The mother (Mutter) is Anna Helget, legitimate daughter of Georg Helget, residing in Natschetin #11 and Margaretha (nee Heintl) of Natschetin #19. Godparents are Georg Prokosch and Maria Prokosch, farmers in Hoslau. Certificate dated November 14, 1936.





Early Baptismal Records of St. John Nepomucene Catholic Church Fox River Grove (McHenry County) Illinois

By Judith Kosatka Lovaas

In his book, *History of Czechs in America*, published in 1910, Dr. Jan Habenicht writes about a settlement of Czech immigrants in Illinois, referring to it as the "lovely neighborhood" of Cary and Algonquin. He also notes "a small wooden Czech Catholic church stands there, too."

Around 1860, Czech immigrants, most of them farmers, settled near the Fox River towns of Algonquin, Cary, and Fox River Grove (formerly Cary Station). In 1867, eighteen area families decided it was time to organize a parish and purchase land for a church and a cemetery. An acre of land high on a hill was purchased for \$20.00 from John Bohacek and construction of St. John Nepomucene Catholic Church began in 1871 and was completed two years later.

Since the church never had a resident pastor, priests would come to St. John's from Bohemian-founded parishes in Chicago. They were from St. Wenceslaus, St. Procopius, Blessed Agnes of Bohemia, St. John Nepomucene, Our Lady of Good Counsel, Sts. Cyril & Methodius and St. Ludmilla. At first, a priest came only once a year and as the parish grew, priests came every three months and finally once a month. The trip was made by train to Barrington and then by oxen or horse-drawn wagon to St. John's.

The last regular Sunday mass was held about 1914 when a new parish, Sts. Peter & Paul, was formed in Cary and a new mission church, St. Margaret Mary, started in Algonquin. Perpetual care of the church and cemetery is overseen by trustees of the association. Each Labor Day weekend mass is still celebrated there.

The early baptismal register also contains some death record entries. Today, the original book may be found at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Cary, Illinois.

Illinois State Archives Online Databases Updated



Staff of the Illinois State Archives and the Department of Information Technology has recently completed a conversion of the Archives' online databases to Java-based programs. The content of some databases has been updated and the format of the data returned by all database queries has been enhanced. The Illinois Statewide Marriage Index and the Database of Illinois Servitude and Emancipation Records have been updated to include additional records. The format in which data is returned after a search has been enhanced for the Servitude and Emancipation index and the Public Domain Land Tract Sales Database.

Because all of the databases on the Archives Web site are now Java-based, the global search option, which returns a list of all databases including a specific name, now searches all databases, including the Illinois Statewide Death Index and several others which had not been previously included. The global query now searches over 7 million names—more than doubling the extent of its search. All Archives databases may be found on the Web page address given above.

Early Bohemian Settlers in Chicago

In 1898, Chicago Czech immigrants formed a social organization called Bohemian Old Settlers' Association (Dejiny Spolku Starych Ceskych Osadniku v Chicagu). The association was for Czechs who arrived in America after 1848 and lived in America over thirty years. The tenth anniversary (1908) publication of this group provides a complete listing of the men and women within the organization and their date of arrival in America for the years 1848 through 1881. The first officers elected were president Antonin Pregler, vice-president Jakob Padecky, and secretary Frantisek Steiskal (a civil war veteran). Readers should note that as membership was voluntary every Czech immigrant in Chicago would not be included in the membership of this association.

Following is a list of one thousand members of this Bohemian Old Settlers' Association as shown in the publication with their arrival dates in America from 1848 through 1867. Apparent spelling errors exist. An article by Robert O. Uher on the founding and first annual picnic of this association appeared in the Fall 1997 issue of KORENY.



A Call For Papers Minneapolis, St. Paul 1997

Are you interested in presenting a particular topic at C.G.S.I.'s next genealogical/cultural conference to be held in the Twin Cities in 1997? If so we are asking you to submit your outline or presentation topic(s) so that we may start planning and evaluating possible session ideas.

How should you present this paper? An outline format is best that would include the topic(s) and title(s) of the presentation(s). You should include information that you would include in your presentation and it should be clear as to what and how the information will be presented (i.e. mainly demonstration, lecture only, slides, videotape, combination). The number of pages of outline material depends on your topic, however two pages double spaced should be adequate.

What should I present? That's difficult, unless you know all the topics we've presented at past conferences. We will consider topics from past conferences that were popular, as well as new ideas. We would like to have presentations that will meet the needs of most of our members. As usual, the conference program will be more heavily weighed to genealogy than to culture. But what I would recommend if you are interested is to think about the ethnic groups that inhabited the former Czechoslovakia, namely Czech, Slovak, Rusyn (Ruthenian), German-Bohemian, Gypsy, Jewish, or other group. Concentrate on the ethnic group or genre that is most familiar to you.

Hands-on demonstration presentations would be most welcome. In the past we have had Kolače baking demonstrations, craft demonstrations, and folk dance demonstrations. Use your imagination.

We would like to have all speakers on board by the fall of 1996 so that the conference committee can make determinations based on the ideas submitted. If you know of someone who might be interested, inform them of what we are looking for, and ask them to send their outline to us. For those submitting topic ideas we also request a resume of your previous genealogical or cultural experience relating to the topic. The conference committee will make the final decision.
