



## BALL FAMILY (Report of researcher, 1963)

We were asked to trace the ancestors of George & Charlotte BALL who were married 27 Dec 1849 at Lew Trenchard, Devonshire parish church. According to the Marriage Certificate we think George Ball was at the time of his marriage a labourer of full age, and his wife was also of full age.

First of all we searched the Census Returns for 1851 in an attempt to locate the family of George & Charlotte Ball and to discover their exact ages and where they were born. As you will see from the attached Appendix 1, we located the family at John's Cottage, Lew Trenchard. You will note that it is stated

that George was 26 and was born at Lifton, Devonshire, and his wife Charlotte was also 26, and was born at Brentor, Devonshire. Other information relating to the BALL and KINSMAN families was also found and we particularly noticed that a George and Mary Ball who might be the parents of the George Ball who was married in 1849 were living at the Cross Roads. With this information we decided next to try to find the following particulars:

(a) Baptism of George Ball at Lifton. (b) Baptism of Charlotte Kinsman at Brentor. (c) Marriage of George Ball, the father of the George Ball who was married in 1849. (d) Marriage of John Kinsman, the father of Charlotte Kinsman.

We know the names of the father of the parties to the marriage of 1849 from the Marriage Certificate.

The results of our initial searches at Lifton and Brentor are to be found in Appendix 2 and 3.

There is no trace of the baptism of George Ball, son of George in the registers of Lifton. We found the baptism of Charlotte Kinsman at Brentor in 1824. It took place on 21 May 1824 and from the registers we are able to say that her parents were John and Grace Kinsman of Bowden Hill, and that her father's occupation was farmer.

We found a marriage of a George Ball & Mary DINGLE in Brentor in 1812 (16 Nov 1812) and we feel that these are probably the parents of George Ball who married in 1849.

It is now necessary to try and find the baptism of the George Ball who married in 1849, which did not apparently take place at Brentor, nor at Lifton. We should also find the marriage of John Kinsman to Grace which probably took place before 1816 when their eldest child was baptized at Brentor.
