Joliffe ACKERMAN and wife,
1830 BISHOP and wife,
1845 Captain WELSH and wife, John HARVY and wife, John GOLDING and wife, William BAKER and wife
1870 Joseph Welsh and wife - Joseph Welsh died early 1888, nearly blind, wife moved to no 7 April,
1888 Apr PEACH and wife - Peach died July 1888, wife moved to no 4,
1888 Sep J HALLETT and wife - Hallett died, wife removed to Union,
1898 GAUGE and wife - Gauge died Feb 1900, wife removed to ?
1900 Mar LATHEY and wife - removed to no 9 to give REASON (blind) house without stairs, 1901 Reason and wife - moved to no 1,
1902 Nov MIDDLETON and wife - Middleton moved to Workhouse and died, painters colic, wife to no 7.

Tenement No 6

Ann VERAU, Kate GALE, Mary ROSSITER, Betty HOUNSELL - died 1832 of cholera, all her bedding etc were buried. (?)
William Hounsell and wife - wife died about 1860, Wm Hounsell married Anna LONG
1874 William FRY and wife - Wm died 1877 ? - kept the "Sun" West St. husband a blacksmith,
1877 GATCH and wife - G died 1880 - wife moved to no 4
1880 Thomas LOVERIDGE and wife - TL died Jan 1883 - for many years carter to Perry's waggons,
188? Miss HARDY and sister - younger sister died 1893 - Miss Hardy to no 7,
1894 John STEVENS and wife - wife died 1896 Jan - Stevens moved to Workhouse in 1900,
1901 COMBS and wife - moved to no 3,
1902 Mrs TREVETT (of Flood House) Banton - from no 5.

Tenement No 7

Ann GIBBS, Mary CHOIR (Ohoir?) died 1813 - buried in Lower Burial Ground, William Long and daughter - W.L. was a baker in "Guppys Court" next door - doorway in wall for him to come thro' attending afternoon meeting and always had a nap, (Isaac STEPHENS - bread not remembered with favour), Sarah SMITH, John PAUL and wife, Fanny Welsh, Sarah WARD, Mrs VAGE, Mary CURME - moved to ?, Mrs RATTENS died - May Rattens died April 15. 1888 after long illness.
Ap 1888 Jane Welsh - moved to 4 and 2 - widow of Joseph.
1894 Miss Hardy - moved to Workhouse 1902, died there,

1902 Mrs Trevett (?) of Flood House - moved to Workhouse (?),
1902 Mrs KENWAY - moved to Workhouse 1906 and died there,
Nov 1905 Anne HODDER - moved to Workhouse,
1906 Mrs Middleton - from No 5.

John HOOPER and wife. Thomas WELLS and wife. George LACY, wife and daughter, John Baker, wife and daughter, Simon STONE and wife.,
1860 (?) William LEGGE and wife - W.L. was an old soldier in Peninsular War, worked for SSL for A. R. Houses rebuilt.
BARTLETT and wife - 1874 - an old Tailor, who made trousers for S&R,
1874 W WAY and wife - Mrs Way died March 1889, W Way blind and removed,
1888 James Kenway and wife - moved to No 1, 1890,
1892 W Gale and wife - Wm Gale died 1895, wife moved to No 4,
Sep (?) 1895 MOULTON and wife (from No 4) - Mr Moulton died and wife left,
Oct 1904 MACEY and wife.

Tenement No 9

Ann CURTIS - buried friend Lower Ground 1813, Lydia BUTCHER - ditto 1821,
Polly EGERN. John DUNN and wife. Ann WHETHAM, Ann Welsh ? - A.W. mother to Charles and Joseph Welsh and William W. Michael Welsh and wife. Joseph Ackerman and wife. John SLADER and wife. House rebuilt.
Capt HILL and wife, Robert PATTEN and wife, Wm Welsh and wife - Jane W died Jan 91,
1891 Joseph Stone and wife - died 1897,
1897 James Gale and wife - died 1898,
1898 W Ackerman and wife - moved to No 1 1901,
1901 Lathey and wife - wife died 1905 - Lathey left.
July 1905 RICHARDS and wife - wife died 1906 - Richards left,
May 1906 John ROUSE (?) and wife, Joel DIMENT and wife, Brian (?) MILLER and wife.

Tenement No 10

John Slader and wife - moved after house was rebuilt, Thomas LOCOCK and wife, John Stone and wife - John stone died 1885, Mary Stone March 1886,
1886 John (?) Welsford and wife, Mrs W died 1895 - Welsford removed,
1896 COLLINS and wife - died in Workhouse of cancer (?) 1899,
1899 George and Prudence BUSSEL - G.B. died 1902, Mrs Bussel 1903,
1903 George GALPIN and wife, GARD and wife.
