CHIEF PINK JENKINS

During the early 1900's, there were several saloons located in down town Gadsden and Attalla. The saloons were very popular until the incidences of violence grew at an alarming rate. The violence continued until the public cried for the closing of open saloons in the county.

On September 26, 1903, Attalla Police Chief Pink Jenkins was patrolling Fifth Avenue in downtown Attalla around Fowler's Saloon. Chief Jenkins was a popular Attalla police officer who had been elected as an extra policeman by the Attalla City Council in early 1903. He was considered a fearless police officer and was well respected by the citizens of Attalla.

As Chief Jenkins was making his rounds this Saturday night, the sound of a gunshot inside Fowler's Saloon drew him to the saloon's rear door. He went into the rear of the saloon and discovered two men shooting at an elderly man. Pink approached one of the shooters and took him by the arm. As Pink attempted to arrest the first shooter, the second jumped him. As the three men struggled, one of the men opened fire on Pink.

The two men, John White and Charles Gibbs, ran from the saloon. They were approached by Attalla Officer Blankenship at the bell tower. He called for them to halt. They opened fire on Officer Blankenship, striking him in the shoulder. The Officer returned fire, striking one suspect in the left arm. White was arrested. Gibbs fled the city and a reward was placed on his head.

Chief Jenkins died at the scene within fifteen minutes of the shooting. The funeral for Chief Jenkins was held at the Methodist Church of Attalla on Monday, September 28, 1903. The police departments of Gadsden and Attalla turned out in large numbers to pay their last respects to this well respected officer.
