Some early marriage records have "HF or H/F" annotated beside the names of the couple. This abbreviation stands for "Handfast." Handfasting was a form of announcing the intention of a couple to marry without the formal blessing of a preacher. A couple would stand before a group of their peers, clasp their hands together over their heads, and state their intentions. Handfasting was good for a year and a day, or until the preacher came to perform the marriage rites. Any child born of Handfasting was legitimate and would inherit.

## Iowa Historical Society Library - Iowa City

Having done my homework ahead of time, I was prepared with a map of Iowa City showing the location of the Iowa Historical Society Library. A quick exit off I-80 at Dubuque Street (marked for the old state capitol) lead me into the city. The library is located two blocks east of Dubuque at the corner of Gilbert and Iowa in the middle of the Iowa State University campus. Parking is on the street and there are meters which take quarters. The meters are not limited as to the number of hours you can park, but you must have enough quarters to feed them. You will also need two quarters for the locker to store your purse, coat and other items besides your notebook. The quarters are refunded when you take your belongings back out of the locker.

I had been to the Iowa Historical Society Library in Des Moines several times and wondered how there could be two historical society libraries in the same state with good genealogy collections. I was not disappointed. As in most historical libraries, the use of pencils is required. Also, the staff needs to make the copies for you, but the cost is only ten cents per page for the first seventy copies, and then fifteen cents per page. I almost used up my seventy page allotment in the short two hours that I spent there. Copy forms are on all the tables in the reading room, and all you have to do is write down the page numbers and your name, insert the form in the book and take it to the front desk. The staff was most friendly, and willing to make all the copies that I wanted. I think I shocked the lady on duty when I told her that I considered this my rest stop in a day's long drive.

The books are on open shelves, and while I did not have any Iowa research to do, I found plenty of material on my New York and New England ancestors. They have the complete set of Massachusetts published town records, and a full set of *The New York Biographical and Genealogical Record*. I spent most of my time browsing through this resource picking out articles that I could use. I only wish that I had had the time to complete browsing the entire set of this valuable resource.

## Clell and Molly - Nebraska Homesteaders 1883-1895

During the War between the States, on May 20, 1862, the free-land Homestead Act was passed by Congress and signed by President Lincoln. A few weeks later, President Lincoln signed the Emancipation Proclamation; and by coincidence, both became effective on the same day, January 1, 1863.

In 1883, at the age of 19, my maternal grandfather, Amos "Clell" McClellan Lugar, paid the sum of \$10.00 to file with the government land office for 160 acres (1/4 section) of barren land in Hayes County, Nebraska<sup>1</sup>. His mother had died when he was 13 years old; and his father had remarried a year later. Clell was the fourth son, having also four sisters and a younger brother.

Clell met his future wife, Mary "Molly" Estella Muse, in Iowa; and she filed for land beside his. Clell went to Nebraska first, and Molly followed a year later, and they were married at David City, Butler, NE. In Hayes County, they built a sod house to shelter them from their first winter there, and collected buffalo chips to burn for fuel. Under the provisions of the Homestead Act, they must live on their homestead six months of the year. As their claims joined, they erected their sod house on the line, with a bedroom on Clell's land and a bedroom on Molly's land, so they would occupy each claim six months of the year.

Clell caught wild horses from the range. He planted crops to feed his family and the livestock and to barter for sugar, coffee and other store goods at a frontier village. Molly helped in the field harvesting corn, and wore an oil cloth apron for protection.

One day Clell, barefoot, was plowing the land to grow crops, and he plowed into a den of rattlesnakes. He was bitten on his bare feet and legs. His brother, James, was nearby and sucked the venom from the bites. As James was chewing tobacco, it prevented his being poisoned. Another time, horses hitched to a wagon load of hogs balked and lay down and refused to get up. Clell built a fire under one horse's ear - and he got up.

Clell traded a herd of wild horses for 20 vacant lots in Denver Heights, CO. Hayes County is located in the southwest corner of NE, about 80 miles from the Colorado border. He was unable to pay taxes when due, and eventually the lots were sold for taxes.

All four of their children were born in Nebraska. Nora Mae was born at Butler, NE, 16 Sep 1885, and my mother, Letha Grace, was born 17 Sep 1887 at Hayes, NE. Laurel LaVerne was born 15 Aug 1889 at Lincoln, Lancaster, NE, and Frank Edward was born 22 Jun 1893 at Hayes, NE. Nora and Grace began school in Hayes County. Grace recalled one time when she was at school, a tornado was coming and a strong wind was blowing. As she hurried home, her mother came to meet her.

Grace remembers a trip by covered wagon to Iowa to visit relatives. A hired hand was left in charge of a stallion and the poultry, etc. The hired hand became frightened by the howling coyotes in the night and left the animals unattended. When Clell returned, he found the stallion with a broken leg caught between two boards in the floor and starved. He had to be destroyed.

Clell and Molly had fulfilled the requirements to live on their Homestead five years, Clell having lived there for twelve years. And Grace had lived the first eight years of her life in NE. But Homesteading was a hard life. Clell decided to move to Iowa. He left his family in Iowa, and returned to his Homestead for the livestock and belongings. So, in 1895, the family went to live in Corydon, the seat of Wayne County, centrally located across the state of Iowa, and on the Missouri border. The

<sup>1</sup>In January 1872, eleven years before Clell went to Hayes, NE, the Grand Duke Alexis, the 22 year old brother of the Czar of Russia, was hosted to a Buffalo Hunt, eight miles north of Hayes Center. The hunt was led by Buffalo Bill Cody as chief scout, accompanied by officers from Fort McPherson, and the Sioux Indian Chief, Spotted Tail, with 100 warriors. This spot was once a cherished hunting grounds for the Indians and is now a State Wildlife Park.
