## PREFACE

### SHARLOT HALL MUSEUM AND ARCHIVES Prescott, AZ

The Museum has an outstanding collection of Southwestern Indian pottery, basketry, and jewelry. Artifacts of cowboys, miners, early politicians, doctors and lawyers are displayed. The "Old Governor's Mansion", built in 1864, is on the museum site. Its furnishings are representative of the time in which it was built. The home of John C. Fremont, the "Pathfinder" and fifth territorial Governor of Arizona, is also on the museum grounds.

The Archives houses many historical books, early newspapers, photographs, bibles, hospital ledgers, journals, obituaries. All of these pertain to the early settlement of Prescott and Yavapai County. The bibles which have been donated over the years are those from which these records have been taken.

The Museum and Archives were named for Miss Sharlot Hall, the first territorial historian of Arizona. The restoration of the "Old Governor's Mansion" was begun by Miss Hall in 1928. She was responsible for the collection of many artifacts of early pioneer days in the museum today.

**New York Born In Mohave and Pima Counties,  
First Arizona Territorial Census - 1870**

Extracted by L. M. Wilson.

While at the Arizona Department of Library and Archives it was determined that a number of Colonial, Territorial, and State census enumerations were made of either portions or all of that present state beginning with a Spanish Colonial census in 1790. The First Arizona Territorial census of 1870 has been indexed<sup>1</sup> and includes a considerable number of individuals that were born in New York. Lacking further data on who may have resided in New York, but were not born there; the extracted names are limited to only those born in that state. The census did include their age, gender, and type of work they were engaged in. Where one member or more of a family were born in New York the other members of the family are included and their place of birth noted. The two counties were selected at random as examples of small and large population.

This census does imply other data of interest. A large number of the population at this time were members of the United States Army, 21<sup>st</sup> U.S. Infantry Reg't. The census made no attempt to include Native Americans. The records did note individuals who were Negro and Chinese; however, both of these groups were extremely small. The proportion of women in the total census was very small. It is of interest that some of the women, wives of enlisted soldiers, were listed as laundresses, as it was a common practice at early Army posts for these women to augment the income of the family while solving a housekeeping problem for the numbers of single soldiers. The presence of one laundress, for whom no husband was recorded, reflects a possible tragedy of a wife who may have lost her husband and continued her job to provide for herself and children. The age of the officers in the army so soon after the Civil War reflects return to permanent rank and slow promotion. This was a frontier where sporadic warfare with local Native American tribes was common and the primary attraction bringing people to the territory was mining and minerals. Only limited evidence of farming or ranching was noted for the counties reported. Arizona became a Territory in 1863 and a State in 1912.
