



A Reid-Bedecarré Family History Tour

They say that you can't go home again but we did, at least we drove by. On the day after Thanksgiving, Nov. 26, 2004, John and Catherine Reid Bedecarré, their six children, spouses, and all 17 grandchildren boarded a chartered bus for a family history tour of our homes, churches, schools, businesses, and cemeteries that are part of our family's past and present.

It was a seven-hour odyssey with stops at many historic (for us) locations, and for lunch at Spenger's Restaurant, a longtime Reid family favorite in Berkeley. The bus ride began at our current home in Concord at 4386 Armand Drive where we have lived since 1973.

Our local itinerary included our present parish, St. Agnes Catholic Church, and our other two homes in Concord. We moved to 1700 Vernier Drive from Orinda in 1955, when John opened the Park and Shop Cleaners and Launderette in the new Park and Shop Center in Concord. While living at 1700 Vernier Drive, our son Thomas Hamilton Bedecarré was born 17 Jan., 1956 and son William Clark Bedecarré was born 8 Oct., 1957. We moved to 2195 Greenbrier Street in 1962 and youngest son Albert Pierre Bedecarré was born 20 March, 1963. We took pictures at these houses and shared memories of friends and neighbors we had known.

Our next stop was Queen of All Saints Church on Grant Street, the first Catholic church in Concord, where Tom, Bill, and Al were baptized. All six of our children graduated from QAS parochial school, and lots of funny stories about grade school days were related.

Mt. Diablo High School is next door on Grant Street, the original high school for the Diablo Valley. Students would come from areas as far as Orinda by train. All four sons graduated from MDHS and they clowned around, posing atop the high school's big concrete sign.

Park and Shop Cleaners closed about 1972 but we drove by 1762 Salvio where it was in operation 17 years. By this time John had begun his 20-year teaching career in the Mt. Diablo School District, primarily at Oak Grove Intermediate School in Concord.

Our bus continued on to Queen of Heaven Catholic Cemetery in Lafayette, where Catherine's parents; Lemuel Albert and Winifred Sloyan Reid are buried, as well as Daughter Diane's father-in-law, Henry Arthur White, former Mt. Diablo Genealogical Society President. John is the current President of the society, and editor of The Digger.

Our bus headed back to the freeway on the way to Berkeley, passing by Orinda, site of our first home in Contra Costa County at 10 Vianne Court. Our daughter Corrinne was born there 11 August 1954 and baptized at the forerunner of the present Santa Maria Church.

Our bus toured the perimeter of the University of California where John and Catherine met, as students working on the Daily Cal campus newspaper, John was a returning vet, whose junior year had been interrupted when he enlisted in the Army during WW II. He spent three years in the Pacific Theater and received a battle star for his service during the Okinawa campaign, being discharged as a Tech Sergeant in 1946. John, Class of '47, and Catherine, Class of '48 were married 25 Sept. 1948 at St. Jerome's Church, El Cerrito.

We continued our Berkeley tour to St. Mary Magdalen Church, the Reid family's parish church, and School of the Madeleine, which Catherine and her sister Eleanor Ann attended. Our big bus could not negotiate the narrow curving streets of Kensington to go to Catherine's family home at 21 Westminster Avenue so that was a disappointment. But we were ready for lunch and went on to Spenger's Fish Grotto in Berkeley.

We played a video of our old family movies on the bus while crossing the Bay Bridge, and the grandchildren laughed at the scenes of their parents growing up.

We stopped at 1145 Broderick Street, San Francisco where John and Catherine lived after their marriage. Son John Jay Bedecarré was born 4 Jan. 1950 and Daughter Catherine Diane Bedecarré was born 15 April 1952 at French Hospital, third generation San Franciscans. They were both baptized at Holy Cross Church.

We drove past 1212 Divisadero, former location of the Van Ness French Laundry, established in 1896 by Jean Bedecarrats, John's grandfather. Then we went by the old Lowell High School campus, John's alma mater. We visited his family's old home at 235 Moncada Way in Ingleside Terrace. Our tour ended at Holy Cross and Cypress Lawn Cemeteries in Colma where the Bedecarré, Bedecarrats, Attabit and Griffith family members are buried. The 17 grandchildren were able to view their GGG grandmother Gracieuse Attabit's tombstone, and we ended our seven hour family history sojourn, a once in a lifetime experience.

Monday of last week, the wife of Thomas W. INGRAM died. She was sick for eight hours then gave birth to a healthy daughter, then a stillborn daughter, another daughter, then a fourth child which resulted in the mother's death. INGRAM is left with the two newborns and twelve other children to raise.

A daughter was born in Martinez to the wife of C. Ed. MILLER on February 25, 1877.
