The final graveyard in Inyo County is the Old Soldiers Cemetery at Fort Independence. The soldier bodies were removed in 1898 to the Presidio, San Francisco, but there are a few very old civilian graves still there; H. C. BADGER, a native of Erie Co., N.Y., d. 12 Dec 1881, age 46; Curtis BELLOWS, brother to Horace Bellows who ran Haiwee Meadows 1870-1900, killed by an Indian 3 Mar 1863, age 32, native of Franklin Co., N. Y.; Lizzie CHALFANT, d. 24 May 1875, age; 3-6-10 and the children of P. A. and Adeline CHALFANT: Adrian, b. 19 Dec 1870, d. 4 June 1871; Clarence S., b. 16 Oct 1873, d. 12 June 1875 and Maud E., b. 9 Apr 1871, d. 4 June 1875. John T. DENTON b.
