Going south on Highway 101 you go thru Hopland, turn to the left on the highway going over hill to Lake County. Cross Russian River Bridge and at the fork in the road you turn right. The cemetery is approx. 1/4 mile on the left up on top of a hill. Originally this Cemetery belonged to the early Spanish settlers here. They gave permission to the White Settlers to use the cemetery.

Catalogued in full. The unmarked graves that are marked with a wooden white cross have no known record of who is buried there. The ones I have notated as unmarked graves have wooden headmarkers with no names written on them.






