

Early Disinterments in Sonoma County

OCCGS RETURENCE ONLY

While searching the index to the Minutes of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, 1863-1905, 1 found a section listing disinterments. The California codes regulating burials specify that anyone wishing to move any buried person must apply for a permit in the county in which the person is buried. Both the exhuming and reinterring cemeteries must record the reburial. The county recorder is also supposed to update the death certificate to show the new place of burial.

Unfortunately for the researcher, the law does not always provide the help that one might wish. For example, a person exhumed from a family cemetery is recorded only by the receiving cemetery since there is no one at the disinterring cemetery to keep the records. (The family may not even own the property any more.) Further, in Sonoma County, the office that handles the permit procedure keeps its records for only a year. Finally, persons dying before 1906 may not have a death record to update. Thus, a body can be disinterred with almost no trace. The receiving cemetery has a record, but how can you seek information if you don't know which cemetery to check?

Such was the problem I faced when I researched Joseph and Anne Marie HOLIDAY, who were originally buried in the 1860s on their ranch in Rincon Valley. In 1991, the family had the bodies moved, but I didn't know to what location. The only records were in the hands of the new place of burial, the name of which I didn't know. It was only good luck that I found a sheriff's deputy who had been with the coroner's office when the disinterment was made. He suggested Santa Rosa Memorial Lawn and I was delighted to find that he was right.

Such good luck cannot happen every time. I was therefore happy to find an index to disinterment permits in the Sonoma County Supervisors' records. The records cover 1863 to 1905 with most in the period 1886-1904. The index lists the name, date of the permit application, a one-line statement, "Nature of Proceedings," and the book and page of the minutes in which the permit was granted. Copies of the complete permit record from the minutes may be obtained from the staff of the Board of Supervisors or from the Sonoma County Archivist.

Persons who can make a visit to Santa Rosa should contact the county archivist, Mr. Anthony Hoskins, at the Sonoma County Library, Local History and Genealogy Annex, Third and E Streets, Santa Rosa, CA, 95404. With appropriate notice, the archivist will be able to retrieve the relevant volume from the archives for you to see. Depending upon the fragility of the volume, copies may be made for a fee. (Telephone 707-545-0831, extension 562. Hours 10:00 am – 6:00 pm, Wednesday through Saturday. E-mail <Hoskins@sonoma.lib.ca.us>.)

Persons outside the county should contact the staff of the Board of Supervisors, who will be able to make copies for you copies. A fee may be charged. Sonoma County Board of Supervisors, 575 Administration Drive, Santa Rosa, CA 95403; telephone 707-565-2241.

The attached table of disinterments was prepared by scanning the typewritten originals, correcting the inevitable errors, sorting by the name of the deceased, and appending notes. In a few cases, several names are listed in one record; in a few other cases, the name in the table is that of the person applying for the permit. Some of the persons in the index were found alive in the 1880 US Census for Sonoma County.

A few additional disinterments were found in *Sonoma County Death Records 1873-1905*, second edition, by the Sonoma County Genealogical Society (Bowie, Maryland: Heritage Books, 2000). The book and page references here are to the death certificate.

- SESSIONS, Ida, died 23 Oct 1889, a. 30, female, removed from Laurel Hill Cem., S. F., to Son. Cem.; book 40 p.120.
- KLINE, Caroline Loisa [sic], died 28 May 1885, female, b. Guerneville, removed from Ridenour Cem. to Guerneville; book 40 p. 67. [Note: "Ridenour Cem." is unknown to me; probably a ranch cemetery.]
- FELT, Theodore D., died 18 May 1885; removed to Humboldt Co. from Guerneville; had a brother; book 40 p. 35. [Note: the 1880 US Census (NARA film T9-0084, p. 86D) shows him in Petaluma with his brother, Franklin FELT.]



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1870 Burials

In Petaluma's Oak Hill Cemetery

Transcribed by Jeremy Nichols

Original entries were made by Charles Blackburn. In July 2003, SCGS member Jeremy Nichols transcribed this material at the Petaluma Museum.

Oak Hill Cemetery was Petaluma's first large place of burial, predating both Cypress Hill and Calvary cemeteries. Charles BLACKBURN was an early Petaluma mortician who handled many Oak Hill burials. Today's PARENTS-SORENSEN Mortuary is the descendent of BLACKBURN 's early business. The following short list of burials, found in the files of the Petaluma Historical Museum, covers February through August 1870.

In 1900, the City of Petaluma ordered all bodies exhumed from *Oak* Hill Cemetery. Many bodies were moved to either Cypress Hill or Calvary cemeteries but compliance was incomplete. Consequently, some people in this list may still be buried in *Oak* Hill Cemetery, now called Oak Hill Park. Four burials were found in *Sonoma County Cemetery Records*, 1846-1921 and one person (who was poisoned) was in *Sonoma County Coroner's Inquests*, 1852-1898.

The deaths recorded here were too early to be included in *Sonoma County, California Death Records, 1873-1905. There is no* evidence in *Santa Rosa Rural Cemetery, 1853-1997* that any of the people were moved to Rural Cemetery.

The records in Sonoma County Cemetery Records, 1846-1921 should not be considered

complete. Consequently, more than the four persons listed here were probably moved to either Cypress Hill or Calvary cemeteries. Researchers are strongly advised to have the records at Cypress Hill and Calvary cemeteries checked before concluding that their subjects were not moved.
