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began his own seed business in Gilroy. The 3,000 acres of flat land on the old PAGE Ranch was purchased and became a satellite farm, run by ROHNERT's son Fred.

In May of 1955, 623 acres north of Cotati were sold and would become the City of Rohnert Park, today Sonoma County's third largest city with its 40,000-plus residents.

Sears Point, on the southern tip of the township, is farm land once owned by the SEARS family. In 1969 racing enthusiasts opened a track there, but it closed shortly thereafter and reopened again in 1973. It is now a favorite spot for racing fans.

Vallejo township's pastoral beauty is a constant reminder that men came here to live and prosper. And still they come.

Lewis and Olive WILLIAMS HERBERT married in Valparaiso, Indiana 4 August 1885, moved to Colorado Springs, Colorado in 1891 and in about 1893 to California. HERBERT was a streetcar conductor in San Francisco before moving to Sonoma County in 1894. The couple set up housekeeping in Cotati, later moving to a 12-acre poultry ranch in Penngrove. He was deputy postmaster for four years and a school trustee for seven, and also worked with the Rochdale Cooperative Store.

In Penngrove, they lived at 8617 Petaluma Hill Road. They raised seven children: Beulah or Betty, born in 1888, and Paul in 1890 were born in Nebraska. Mildred was born in 1893 in Colorado. Ruth arrived in 1898, and Florence in 1900, both in Penngrove. Walter and Lewis (Huck) HERBERT Jr., both born early in the 20th century.

Ruth HERBERT was for many years an executive secretary for Pacific Gas and Electric Co. in San Francisco. She married the widowed Peter TORLIATT Jr. of Petaluma in 1942.

Mildred HERBERT stayed in Vallejo Township and in 1914 married Neil McLAIN, who worked for many years at the Petaluma Cooperative Creamery. They moved down the road from Penngrove to 1632 Old Adobe Road. There they raised daughters Ruth McLAIN ANDERSON and Esther McLAIN TILLMAN. Esther's husband Art farmed in east Petaluma.

Several of the HERBERT children moved from the Petaluma-Penngrove area, but the one most remembered was Lewis (Huck) HERBERT, a gregarious man who operated a number of taverns in Sonoma County. He died in 1964 at age 61.

Lewis and Olive, with children and friends attending, celebrated their 50th anniversary with a party on the Penngrove ranch in August of 1935, at which time parents and children sat for a group portrait under the giant palm tree on the property. Lewis HERBERT suffered severe burns when a fire broke out on the property in December, 1935. He died two weeks later on Christmas Day. Olive Herbert died in a bay area sanitarium in 1939.

Who's Who

Santa Rosa was a bustling town in 1889 when this picture was taken. The Fourth of July celebration drew people from Santa Rosa, Petaluma, and surrounding countryside. The picture above was taken in Santa Rosa in front of the Sonoma County Courthouse on Fourth Street at Mendocino Avenue. Some years the celebration was held in Petaluma. I have a picture of my aunt, Adele **CONNOLLY**, draped in a flag and called "Miss Columbia." In the 1890s she was part of the celebration in Petaluma.

July was the time of year when ladies with sweeping skirts could cross streets without worrying about slushy mud. Dirt streets were kind to horses' hooves, but not to long skirts. We can see several ladies crossing Fourth Street on their way to the Sonoma County Courthouse, where speeches were presented. There is a horse-drawn rail car making its way to the east of town. Another is turning onto Exchange Avenue in the distance. One horse is pulling two cars without looking stressed. This

leads me to believe the wheels on the car must have been oiled well. Notice that the surry in the foreground has a doubletree with two horses hitched.

It appears that there are bleachers on or next to Mendocino Avenue. Bunting is hanging here and there. It is said that balloon ascensions were part of the celebrations in the 1880s and 1890s. Those of us who want to get up at sunrise still watch hot air balloons during this time. It is not uncommon to receive a Fourth of July weekend ride as a reward.

Although we can see no citizens with masks, they surely were present when this picture was taken. A group of them called *squeedunks* were on hand to spoof the orators, play band music, and clown around at Fourth of July festivities during the last part of the 1800s and early 1900s. The name "*squeedunk*" came to mean odd looking. A horse that was largely skin and bones was often referred to as a *squeedunk*.

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
